Dear Parishioners,

"They abandoned their nets and followed him."

I suppose from time to time we are invited to take stock of where we are in life. We get into certain patterns of behavior, we have priorities, we have goals or life plans and then something happens, and we find ourselves at ground zero.

These moments of spiritual or emotional upheaval are never easy but remind us that nothing in life is cast in stone; the circumstances and realities of life keep us moving at times in uncharted waters. A devastating job loss leads us to a major change in our career and we look back and see it as one of the best things to happen. We have a serious health challenge that demands we make changes in our lifestyle, and we find ourselves never feeling better. A crisis in the lives of a son or daughter results in a new level of how we relate to them, a breakthrough. We face a personal struggle and realize we can get through this.

We are creatures of habit, but life keeps finding a way to move us forward. The blessing of being a person of faith is we are reminded over and over that we are not in this alone. God works in our lives and surrounds us with a community, and we feel the impossible, possible.

The first reading tells us the story of the prophet Jonah. He followed a great tradition of being an extremely reluctant prophet, he felt neither the desire nor the skills for such a role. God pursues him, gives him a plan and within 40 days he saves the repenting Ninevites from destruction.

St. Paul reminds that time is a fragile commodity. There is the urgency of now to embrace the Word of God.

Andrew, Simon, James, and John were about the ordinary tasks of being fishermen and an encounter with the Lord challenges them to leave everything behind and to follow him. These first apostles had no idea what they were getting into. Their "life plans" were torn asunder by the reality of Jesus Christ entering their lives. Amid the ordinary, extraordinary things happen.

I see the evidence of the Lord working in people's lives all the time. The heroic efforts to recover from serious illness, dealing with sorrow of grief, overcoming the burden of family resentments, and courageously facing

disappointments that can happen when we are forced to move in a new direction.

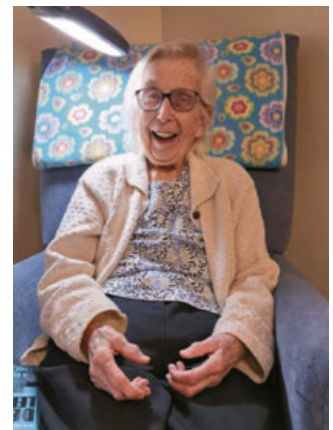


