




## seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...

Dear Parishioners,

*"Take away the stone."*

There are few more compelling stories recounted in the scriptures than the raising of Lazarus. A miracle that has captivated Christians since the time it was first retold. This is a miracle with many layers of meaning and a great Gospel to meditate on during this Lenten season.

The tomb of Lazarus is to this day a place of pilgrimage. The tomb and church are just outside of Jerusalem. You enter the tomb and walk down a very narrow, steep stairwell to the place where Lazarus had been buried. After being there, I was struck that there are really two miracles, he being raised from the dead and how he got up the stairs of the tomb before having the burial cloths removed! Standing in front of the tomb you get the chills as the passage of the raising of Lazarus is proclaimed and you hear the words, "Take away the Stone."

One of the best sellers in the Catholic publishing world these days is **James Martin's** book, "Come Forth," a beautiful meditation on the raising of Lazarus. He recounts the experience of leading pilgrims to the tomb, and as the pilgrims pray at the place Lazarus was buried, he invites people to leave behind in the tomb, their burdens, their sorrows, their sin. As they climb the stairs to leave the tomb, he invites them to embrace the redemptive love of Jesus Christ that seeks to liberate us. Leave behind all that ties you up as the Lord commands, take away the stone that keeps you from moving forward in life, untie the bands of the burial cloths that hold you back.

One of the great privileges I have as a priest is to celebrate the sacrament of Reconciliation. There is no greater blessing for me than to witness someone who feels they have been unburdened by God's merciful love; to feel you can leave behind the sorrows or consequences of sin. The stone has been taken away! Come Forth to the lifegiving power of redemption. This is what Lent is all about.

I feel the power of faith in a parish is its ability to create a community of love and friendship. A place where we can walk together on the road of discipleship, walking as brothers and sisters all in need of redemption and mercy.

Thank you for your witness of faith. I see repeatedly the power of your faith, your willingness to continue to build on

the foundation of faith. We all mess up, but the merciful love of God keeps calling us to begin anew!

Last Saturday our Lenten Mission was about as good as it gets. Thank you to: **Sara Carsten, Mark Vogel, Therese Evans, Kaylee Lentino, Geoff Lutz, Sue Walsh, Margie André, Fr. Larry, and Russel Stern** for all your efforts to invite us to a sacred place of dialogue. There is nothing more powerful than the witness a person can give to the presence of God in their lives, especially at times of challenge and turmoil. The Mission was livestreamed and is available for viewing.

Thank you to **Dave and Molly Kuhn** for all they do for our marriage prep program. We recently had a Precana session with 5 couples that was terrific. Thanks!

Our Youth Ministry program has had quite a Lenten outreach. On Sunday, March 24, there will be a viewing of the "Passion of the Christ" in our Youth Room. I really appreciate **Zoe Sundstrom's** leadership. Our outreach to our young people is critical to our future.

Last weekend's Laetare Lenten Concert was so wonderful. Russel Stern, our Festival Choir, and the Children's Choir outdid themselves. We are so blessed by the talent and generosity of all those involved in our music ministry.

I extend heartfelt wishes to all of you for a joyous St. Patrick's Day. St. Patrick was the apostle to the Celtic people. One of the great pilgrimage places in Ireland is Croagh Patrick, a mountain in County Mayo. As one climbs the mountain you follow in the footsteps of pilgrims from the fifth century. It was on this mountain that St. Patrick fasted for 40 days. There is a glorious statue of St. Patrick that overlooks Clew Bay at the summit and the breathtaking landscape of Ireland. It is from here that tradition has it that St. Patrick chased all the snakes out of Ireland and sent them to England (only kidding!).

This week is also the Feast Day of St. Joseph. When I served in Little Italy on the near west side of Chicago, there would be these elaborate St. Joseph tables of glorious Italian foods. The donations collected all went to the poor. San Giuseppe, Ora Pro Nobis! St. Joseph, pray for us! St. Joseph, protector of the Church. Watch over us!

As we enter the final weeks of Lent, may you have the courage to seek the Lord's help to "take away the stone."



## Holy Saturday Blessing of Easter Foods

11:30am Holy Saturday, March 30

We invite you to join in **Swieconka**, the Slavic Easter celebration.

In this service, foods traditionally eaten for breakfast on Easter Sunday are blessed. Choose your favorite basket to fill with:

**Eggs** - a symbol of new life and the resurrected Christ

**Ham** - an acknowledgement of the New Law, putting aside the Old Law which forbade the eating of pork

**Lamb** - made of butter or cake dough, symbolizing Christ as the Sacrificial Lamb

**Horseradish** - a reminder of Christ's suffering and the bitter herbs offered Him on the cross

**Salt** - symbolizing wisdom needed in our daily lives

**Bread** - the essence of nourishment for our bodies and the appearance under which Christ is present

This joyful celebration draws people from all over the area and it is a great way to kick off the Easter Celebration following the solemn observance of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday.

Much in need of your abiding care.


I picture God in his sacred space.
