Dear Parishioners,

"Alleluia!"

From one corner of the earth to another, Christians are proclaiming the ancient word Alleluia! The word means, "Praise the Lord." We rejoice in the resurrection of Our Lord.

Beginning at the Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday, the word Alleluia is restored to the liturgy after having

been silenced during the Lenten season.

The ancient Easter greeting during this wonderful season is, "The Lord is Risen, and the response is He is risen indeed" Alleluia!

The celebration of the Feast of Easter and coming Season of Easter is a wonderful opportunity for the community of the faithful. Purified by our Lenten journey, we now focus on the renewal of the Church. Dear Parishioners, Happy Easter

Thank you for your wonderful support of the Needy Family Fund during during a year of great turmoil in our world. Your support is amazing. Know that my prayers are with you.

People struggle every day. They live in fear and feel helpless. Rents have tripled in the past six months.

Jobs continue to be cut to part-time with no benefits. Homelessness continues to grow. Children suffer a great deal when they are homeless. How do they learn, feel good about themselves, when they live in the car, the woods, or in a shelter, sometimes separated from their family? They become isolated, angry, and live in fear.

Mothers continue to come from our community in need of food, warm clothing for their children, hygiene products, laundry detergent, and more, because they have so little. Seniors who have worked hard all of their lives and live on a limited budget frequently go without important things such as medication.

People who have suffered from COVID and have been unable to work for several months are threatened with

eviction. Lights and gas are turned off.People live in fear and feel helpless because there is nowhere to turn.

God needs to be the center of our lives each day. We need to give strength and hope to those who have none. We need to go to Mass as family. The Eucharist must be key in our Faith. We cannot empower others if God is not first in our lives.

We must work together to change society, our government, and our communities. We need to build strong family values and respect for one another. We need to educate and motivate our children in a strong educational environment. When we create sufficient job opportunities and provide basic necessities for one another, we know this is the answer to building strong communities which, in turn, build a great nation!

We need to live the message of the Gospel, by feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, housing the homeless, and educating our children. Christ told us: "What you do to the least of my people, you do to ME."



What is special about Divine Mercy Sunday?

In 1931, Maria Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, reported visions and visitations from Jesus and conversations with him. He asked her to paint the vision of his merciful divinity being poured from his Sacred Heart and specifically asked for a feast of Divine Mercy to be established on the first Sunday after Easter Sunday, so that mankind would take refuge in him

Jesus spoke these words to St. Faustina:



St. Faustina

My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners.

On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. (Diary, 699)

On April 30, 2000, then-Pope John Paul II declared the second Sunday in the Easter season to be Divine Mercy Sunday.



On the same day, he Pope John Paul II canonized Maria Faustina Kowalska as St. Faustina.

Fr. Paul is leaving Chicago

After five unforgettable years in Chicago, I am returning to Eastern Africa in July. I will be based in Nairobi, Kenya, to continue the work of establishing Hekima University in Molo, Kenya (the first four-year Jesuit University in East Africa). I am sad to leave Chicago and the United States, but excited for the opportunity to be on the ground, equipping young Africans with the skills that will transform their lives and bring hope for generations to come.

My time in Chicago has been truly fulfilling. I spent two wonderful years at Saint Ignatius College Prep, fundraising under President John Chandler's mentorship, as well as teaching economics and theology. I then worked with colleagues of the Midwest Jesuits to raise muchneeded funds toward building Hekima University. That work continues with Fr. Endashaw Debrework, SJ, an Ethiopian Jesuit who was regional director of the Jesuit Refugee Service in Eastern Africa.

It has been a grace to serve at OLPH. I am always touched by your devotion as parishioners, your charity to many causes and your hospitality to international priests like me. I



am grateful that I have come to know many of you as friends in the Lord. None of this would have been possible without the kindness and generosity of the pastoral team: Fr. Jerry Boland, my countryman Fr. Patrick Kizza, Fr. Jim Barrett, Fr. Larry Basbas, Deacon Jim Revord, Deacon Christopher Weiland, and our dearest Sr. Paulanne Held. We can all agree that they are exceptional leaders and disciples.

To mark these five years and to say farewell,




