Dear Parishioners,

"Blessed are those who have not seen but believe."

I am still very much in the afterglow of Easter. What a celebration it was, the liturgies of Holy Week and of course Easter Sunday. Every year the commemoration of the events of Our Lord's passion, death and resurrection never fail to move me and renew my sense of what it means to be a believer.

What does it all mean? The implications and consequences of Our Lord's Resurrection still reveal new power, new meaning, new implications to those of us who believe.

My favorite Easter painting is entitled, "The Disciples Peter and John Running to the Sepulchre" by the Swiss painter **Eugene Burnand**. It was painted in 1898 and is on display at the Musee d'Orsay in Paris. Burnand was acclaimed for the realism he captures in his pieces.

One cannot help but be taken by the sheer look of astonishment and wonder on the faces of Peter and John as they race to the tomb of Our Lord after they heard the incredible testimony of the women who found the tomb was empty.

The Greeks made a distinction between Chronos time and Kairos time. Chronos time is a way of describing the passing of time in a

chronological or sequential manner, i.e., 60 seconds to a minute, 60 minutes to an hour, 7 days to a week and so on. This way of looking at time sees it in terms of equal units in a category, No unit no more meaningful than the other.

Kairos time is about the experience of a moment which is deep in meaning, deep in its influence, profound in its impact, often life changing; the experience of surviving a heart attack, the healing of a relationship, the birth of a child, the achievement of something for which we have worked so hard.

The Easter Season is about Kairos time. We have no idea how many days, weeks, or months it took for the first disciples to wrap their heads around what it meant that Jesus had risen. Jeus did not escape from the tomb, he rose from the tomb!

The next several weeks we will hear the accounts of the Kairos moments when his first disciples came to the conviction that the Lord had risen. These experiences were of course life changing for them, in terms of Chronos time we don't how much time passed from the discovery of the empty tomb to the realization that Jesus had Risen. What we do know is that the accounts of the four evangelists, the Acts of the Apostles, the writings of St. Paul and the testimony of the first martyrs and Fathers of the Church were one Kairos moment after another.

This brings me to the remarkable words of the Risen Christ in this weekend's gospel, "Blessed are those who

have not seen but believe." He is talking about you and me! Our faith has been formed by countless generations of those "who have not seen but believe." It is from the faith of those before us that we have been blessed and now must take the responsibility to hand our faith on to the future.

One of the great challenges is the forces of indifference. Incredulity to the religious experience and contempt for experiences that point to something greater than just the present.

May the Easter season be full of Kairos moments for all of us.

I am grateful to everyone who contributed to the celebration of Holy Week and Easter. Is there a more beautiful church than ours at Easter? The music and

### What is special about Divine Mercy Sunday?



St. Faustina

In 1931, Maria Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, reported visions and visitations from Jesus and conversations with him. He asked her to paint the vision of his merciful divinity being poured from his Sacred Heart and specifically asked for a Feast of Divine Mercy to be established on the first Sunday after Easter Sunday, so that

mankind would take refuge in him

Jesus spoke these words to St. Faustina:

My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners.

On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. (Diary, 699)

On April 30, 2000, then-Pope John Paul II declared the second Sunday in the Easter season to be Divine Mercy Sunday. On the same day, he canonized Maria Faustina Kowalska as St. Faustina.

#### **Volunteers Needed**



The Living Stations brought Christ's passion to life through His beloved children, right here in our church. It was a humbling and powerful morning for all who participated and attended.



- Help envision, shape, and implement the future goals of our parish and monitor our ongoing success as we strive to fulfill the Church's teachings.

The PPC meets throughout the year on the third Monday of every month according to its bylaws. Meetings follow an established agenda defined in advance based on input from Fr. Boland and PPC members. Members also organize and plan the annual Summit and Ministry Appreciation Mass and Reception. PPC members serve a three-year term beginning each July.

### Fr. Paul is leaving Chicago

After five unforgettable years in Chicago, I am returning to Eastern Africa in July. I will be based in Nairobi, Kenya, to continue the work of establishing Hekima University in Molo, Kenya (the first four-year Jesuit University in East Africa). I am sad to leave Chicago and the United States, but excited for the opportunity to be on the ground, equipping young Africans with the skills that will transform their lives and bring hope for generations to come.

My time in Chicago has been truly fulfilling. I spent two wonderful years at Saint Ignatius College Prep, fundraising under President John Chandler's mentorship, as well as teaching economics and theology. I then worked with colleagues of the Midwest Jesuits to raise muchneeded funds toward building Hekima University. That work continues with Fr. Endashaw Debrework, SJ, an Ethiopian Jesuit who was regional director of the Jesuit Refugee Service in Eastern Africa.

It has been a grace to serve at OLPH. I am always touched by your devotion as parishioners, your charity to many causes and your hospitality to international priests like me. I



am grateful that I have come to know many of you as friends in the Lord. None of this would have been possible without the kindness and generosity of the pastoral team: Fr. Jerry Boland, my countryman Fr. Patrick Kizza, Fr. Jim Barrett, Fr. Larry Basbas, Deacon Jim Revord, Deacon Christopher Weiland, and our dearest Sr. Paulanne Held. We can all agree that they are exceptional leaders and disciples.

To mark these five years and to say farewell,


