Dear Parishioners, "Live by the Spirit!"

"Come Holy Spirit, Renew the Face of the Earth." Christians throughout the world acknowledge the birth of the Church on that first Pentecost. Every Pentecost recalls our need for constant renewal as a person and as a community of faith.

As the Archdiocese has been going through the process of "Renew My Church", it has been challenging reimagining a vital, energizing, and life-giving Church.

Every parish has had to take a comprehensive and thorough look at its history, its current status and its future needs. This has been very painful for communities that have been overwhelmed by demographic changes, deteriorating facilities and declining memberships. We come from such a strong tradition of parishes but sometimes that has been a hindrance to reengaging the world as it exists, not what it once was.

The word Pentecost comes from the Greek word *pentekost*, which means 50th. The feast day, 50 days after Passover, was called Pentecost. The Christians adapted the tradition to the 50th day after the resurrection. It recalls that day in which the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples gathered in the Upper Room. It is often described as that moment when the mission of the Church to proclaim the Good News was inaugurated.

As Christians, we recall in our lives, Pentecost moments when we have a sense to begin anew, to renew our lives, to set out in a new and invigorated way.

The Church is in ever need of embracing the "spirit" of Pentecost. We are divided, we are confused, we can all too easily become lethargic in our zeal to be authentic witnesses of Jesus Christ.

I pray for the continued descent of the Holy Spirit in the lives of all of us here at OLPH. God has blest us with a wonderful parish. We must follow in the footsteps of those before us who were not afraid of change, not reluctant to rethink priorities, not resistant to where the Spirit may call us.

We need to continue to build on the emerging foundation of our Youth Ministry program, we must reach out to parents of young children to establish strong faith traditions of worship

and formation in their family life. We must strive to be an inclusive Church that sees every member as a child of God, to truly be prolife. We need to build bridges of respect and dialogue with other faith traditions. We must challenge the culture of death as St. John Paul II described evil in our world.

The agenda of a church emboldened by a new Pentecost is profound, but inspired by the Holy Spirit, we can do it!


