

Dear Parishioners,
"Happy New Year"

This weekend we not only celebrate the beginning of a new year, but we also celebrate one of the most ancient feasts of the liturgical year, "The Epiphany of the Lord". The church rejoices in the manifestation of Jesus Christ the Son of God. We recall the visit of the Magi that signifies the universal recognition of our Lord and Savior.

Since ancient times, on this Feast of the Epiphany there is the practice of the Epiphany Proclamation that alerts us to when in the coming new year, we will celebrate the movable feasts. This practice began in ancient times long before there were calendars. The liturgical year centers on the celebration of Easter. As you know, the date of Easter is different each year because it often coincides with the Jewish celebration of Passover. Easter is celebrated on the first Sunday after the Paschal full moon, which is the first full moon after the vernal equinox on or after March 21. It was the Epiphany proclamation that would announce to people when was the beginning of Lent, the date of Easter and the date of Pentecost.

I thought you might enjoy reading the official Epiphany Proclamation for 2022:

Know dear brothers and sisters,

*That, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy
we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection,
who is our Savior.*

*On the second day of March will fall Ash Wednesday, and
the beginning of the fast
of the most sacred Lenten season.*

*On the seventeenth day of April, you will celebrate with joy
Easter Day, the Paschal Feast
of Our Lord Jesus Christ.*

*On the twenty-ninth day of May will be the Ascension of our
Jesus Christ.*

On the fifth day of June, the feast of Pentecost.

*On the nineteenth day of June, the feast of the Most Holy
Body and Blood of Christ.*

*On the twenty-seventh day of November, the First Sunday of
the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and
glory for ever and ever.*

Amen.

The coming year will be marked by many moments of grace and challenge. There will be celebrations of achievements, life changing moments like baptisms, weddings and ordinations. There will be moments when we will struggle with disappointments, illness, and death. Through it all the Lord will be at our side.

Looking ahead, is always risky business because of the uncertainties of life that are real. We cannot control things the way we would like. The Epiphany proclamation reminds us that each year of our lives revolves around the dying and rising of our Lord. Through it all, God will lead us to an even deeper realization of his grace and presence.

As we begin anew, key to many of the most important events in our lives, is our parish community of Our Lady of Perpetual Help. It is the power of relationships formed and nurtured by the proclamation of the Word of God and the reception of the Eucharist that we build up the Kingdom of God.

This year we will be moving into the crucial phase of the Renew My Church process called, "Building the New Reality". Through the leadership of the PPC and others we will continue to forge deeper relationships with the faith communities of St. Catherine Labouré and St. Norbert. We will need to explore new and creative ways of reaching out and inviting people to become more significantly involved in the life of our parish and the larger church.

On a personal note, in light of my recent 40th anniversary of ordination, priests go a sabbatical for a period of theological, spiritual and personal renewal. As I write this letter, I am still not sure what I will be doing or where I will be going.

I was scheduled to begin February 1. Originally, I was set to participate in the Tantur Ecumenical Institute in Jerusalem, one of the great centers of biblical scholarship in the world. Israel has closed its borders because of COVID. So, I most likely cannot go there.

I have tentatively been accepted in the Institute of Continuing Theological Education at the Pontifical North American College in Rome. This program takes advantage of the tremendous theological resources of the Gregorian University. This program begins January 15. Europe is under a state of siege as a result of COVID so I will just have to wait and see if anything is possible. I can always postpone.

If I am able to go, **Fr. Patrick Kizza** will serve as temporary administrator in my absence. Like I said earlier, when it comes to planning the future, there are many things you simply can't control!






