Dear Parishioners,

"The people were filled with expectation"

The beginning of every New Year finds us "filled with expectation". There are some things we know will happen; babies will be born, couples will get married, graduations, first communions will be celebrated. The coming year will have its blessings and challenges.

The beginning of a New Year can invite us to begin anew, to explore new possibilities, to change directions. It can be a time to press the reset button if we want to change the tone of certain relationships, to move in new directions in terms of our larger life.

No one has a crystal ball, but we do know that through it all Our Lord will be there at our side, guiding us, leading us, encouraging us. This will be a year of rebuilding aspects of our lives that have been impacted by COVID. I hope that over the coming months more and more parishioners will find their way back to regular worship. I know that COVID is continuing to wreak havoc as infections continue to surge and we have had to return to some practices to ensure public safety.

Several days ago, I tested positive for COVID and while I had a mild form it was none the less disruptive as I had to self-isolate and hope for the best. During those long days I couldn't help but feel blest by you, my ministry, the people I get to serve with. **Fr. Jim** also got sick, so we

I still must express my profound admiration for first responders, essential workers and health care professionals. They are heroic. This week I will be able to leave "house arrest" and return to the world!

I was sharing with you last week the complications that have surrounded my sabbatical as a result of COVID. Sometimes I am not sure God wants me to go on sabbatical! I have had so many obstacles, but this is the latest. I will be attending the Institute for Continuing Theological Education at the Pontifical North American College in Rome. In my absence, Fr. Patrick will serve as temporary administrator. He told me I won't recognize the place when I return! He will do a great job.

The goal of a sabbatical is one of personal, professional and spiritual renewal aimed at priest marking special milestones in their lives, in my case my 40th anniversary of priestly ordination. I am blessed by this opportunity and to mark it the context of being the pastor of OLPH.

This weekend ends the Christmas Season. What a celebration it has been. The Church was beautiful, the liturgies uplifting the time together one of grace. Thank you to all of the ministries that worked so well together to make it all happen. Not even the Omicron variant could stop us! It has been wonderful, and I can't wait for what the New Year has in store!

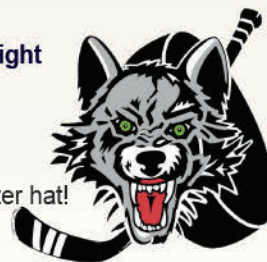

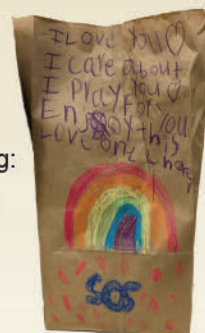

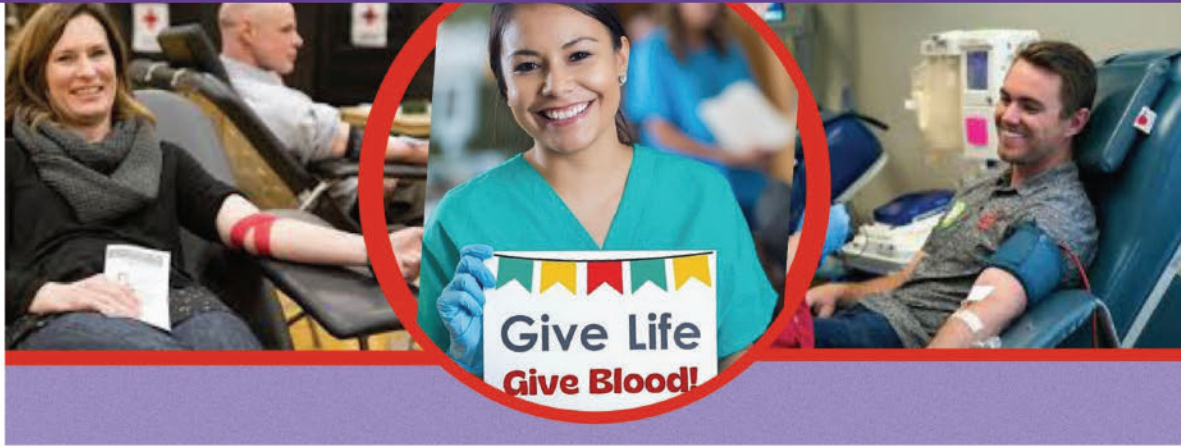
