## seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...

Dear Parishioners,

*"And his disciples began to believe in him"*

This weekend's gospel tells the famous moment when Jesus turned the water into wine at the wedding feast at Cana. This was the first of his signs that would reveal his glory.

In the journey of faith, there are many signs that the Lord performs to reveal his glory and power, some signs heal, others are transforming, others cause us to marvel. Like those first disciples, we find our faith deepening as we encounter more signs of Christ's presence in our lives. As we move into the heart of winter there is a certain starkness to the world as much of what we see is covered in a blanket of snow.

The invitation of winter is to go beneath the surface of things. As the world of nature is going through a deep process of dying so that the new life of spring can happen, so too spiritually, we can explore more deeply the foundations of our spiritual life. What needs to die for new life to be born?

Dying and rising is the cycle of the spiritual life. During a lifetime, we will encounter many "dying and risings". When we gather at Eucharist, explore the scriptures, share our faith, reach to another person in need, we encounter Christ.

Having recently recovered from COVID, I have found myself deeply effected by the generosity of others. COVID has forced us to realize how much we need each other, from the selfless health care person to the faithful friend who "checks in" to the countless acts of kindness that anyone of us who has been sick has experienced. Even the act of wearing a mask is an expression of

concern for the well being of others. In a self-centered world that can get trapped in theoretical conversations about personal rights, COVID has challenged us to think in terms of "we" not "me". Nothing is perfect, no one thing will solve the pandemic, but together we will prevail against this challenge. As **Pope Francis** has said on many occasions, the pandemic presents us with a great opportunity to demonstrate the very premise of Christian Charity, "to love one another as I have loved you". In Italy their national theme has been, "we are not safe until we all are safe".

On behalf of **Fr. Barrett**, myself, **Fr. Patrick** and **Fr. Larry** we are so grateful for your prayers and concern as we have faced COVID. Your concern for us has touched us deeply. Thank you!

Speaking of Italy, I am scheduled to begin my sabbatical this week at the Pontifical North American College. In order to board a plane, I must test negative for Covid. Some people continue to test positive days after they are no longer sick, so I have my "fingers crossed".

While I am away, Fr. Kizza will keep things moving as the temporary administrator. With a reduction in the number of priests from Feb. 1 to July 1 we will have communion services at the 6:30 Mass on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. We will maintain all our other sacramental ministries.

Congratulations to **Char Sparrow** who will chair the Continuation Committee of Christ Renews His Parish. I am so grateful for her willingness to serve and grateful to **Chris Conroy** who has done an amazing job as the current chair.

Arrivederci! See you in July, I will miss you but from time to time you will be hearing from me!
