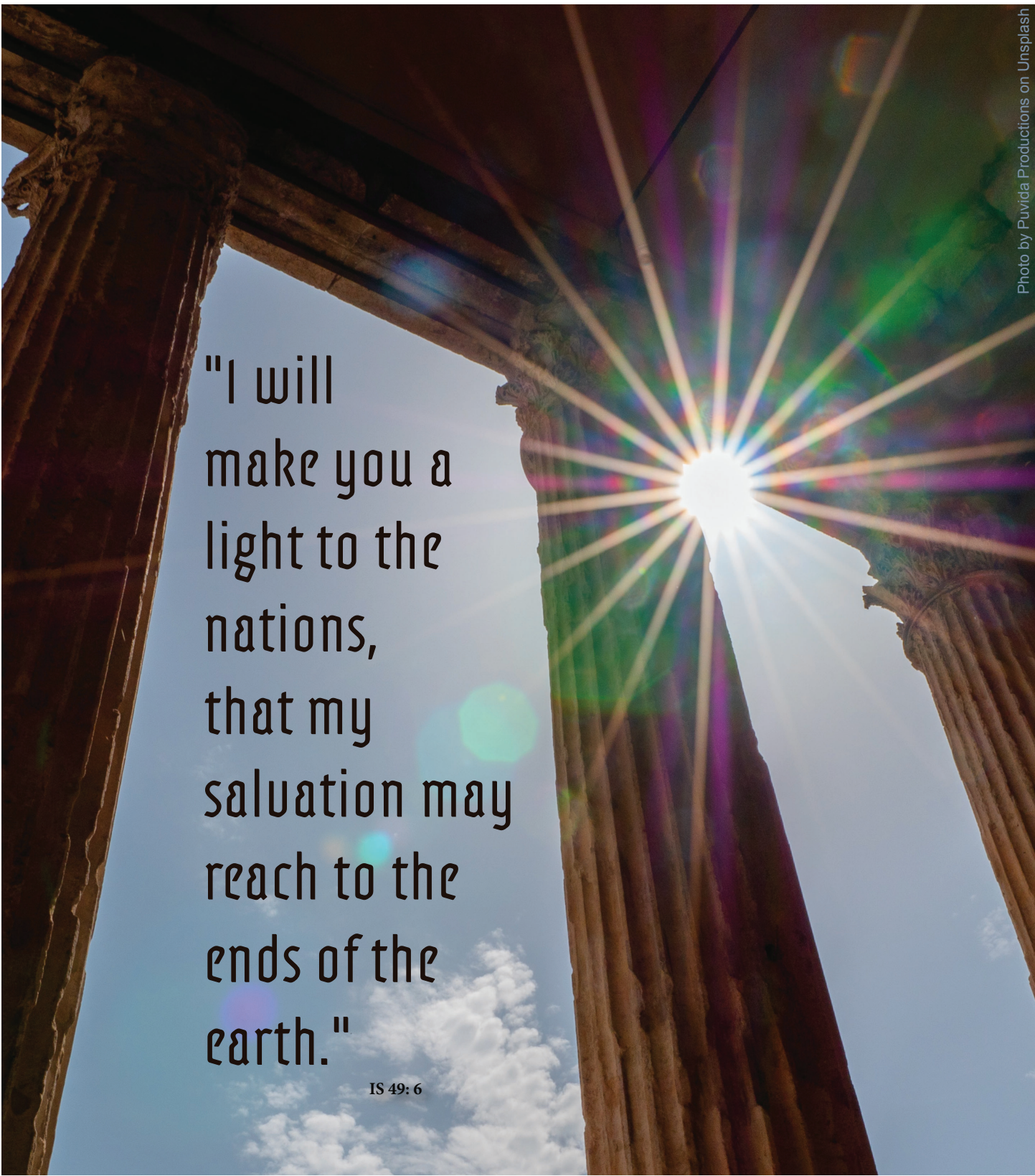

SUNDAY SCRIPTURES

In today's Gospel, John the Baptist shows us how what we do and say reveals to others what we really believe. He has a clear sense of who he is and who he is not, and by his life's work he gives testimony to God's active presence in people's lives. He challenges us to examine how our actions reveal our attitudes, testify to our beliefs and show how those beliefs reveal our true selves to others. Good stewards of their faith are aware of the sort of God they reveal to the world by their words and actions.

Do our acts witness to a God who takes away that which alienates people from God and each other? Do our actions truly reveal God's presence in the world today?

Dear Parishioners,

"I will make you a light to the nations."

The scriptures of these early weeks of the New Year are filled with hope. They assure us that if we live out our mission, guided by the Good News, we will become a beacon of hope to others. The power of God's Word can counter the winter doldrums that can impact us.

Pursuing the light is a noble task these wintery days which are often gray and cold. How can I resist the forces of darkness that can be manifested in negativity? The spiritual masters often spoke of the evil of the "Via Negativa", the negative way. The tendency to be impatient, unduly critical of others, contributing to gossip, always finding fault in others.

The way of the Lord is the "Via Positiva", the way of mercy, compassion and love. This is the path that leads us to build up rather than tear down, to encourage rather than discourage. The scriptures this weekend invite us to reflect on the ways that God is our strength. Paul's letter this weekend reminds us that we have been "sanctified in Christ Jesus and are called to be holy". The Gospel this weekend continues the account of Jesus' baptism. John the Baptist acknowledges Jesus as the Christ when he proclaims, "Behold the Lamb of God!"

This time of year, the parish provides several opportunities to "pursue the light". These are events that seek to build us up, to deepen our spiritual life, to help us better understand our faith and our community of faith.

One of the forces of darkness that plagues every school is bullying. It is critical that parents, teachers, coaches, all those that are in academic or athletic environments with young people, to be as aware as possible of the possibility that a child is not safe. I am delighted that our school is sponsoring an evening, Jan. 21, on this subject. **Jodee Blanco** is a nationally renowned expert and New York Times best seller on this subject. This event is open to everyone and is designed for families to participate. It begins at 6:30 in McDonnell Hall. Please come!

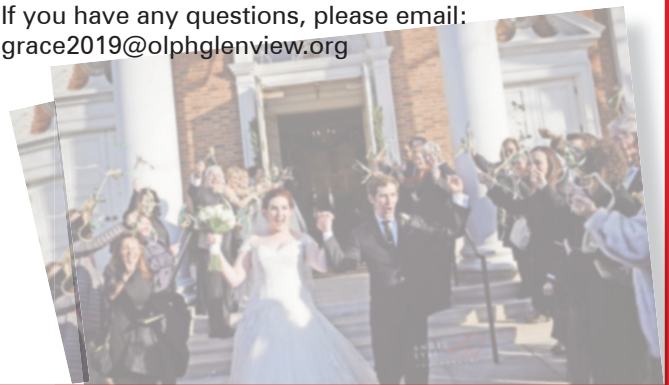

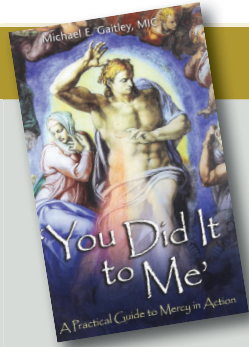

He will forgive and forget as we struggle and strive. Praise be to God for his goodness and his merciful heart! Let us end our retreat with Father Gaitley's closing words in "You Did It to Me" and by remembering St. Teresa of Calcutta's lesson on the **5 Finger Gospel**:

"At the end of each day, look at your hand and remember these words—You Did It To Me. Ask yourself whether or not you've reached out to perform at least one work of mercy during the day. If you have, thank God.



If not, tell the Lord you're sorry for this sin of omission, resolve to do better the next day, and conclude with a work of mercy that is always within your grasp: Prayer. Pray for someone who is suffering and ask the Lord to console that person with his grace."

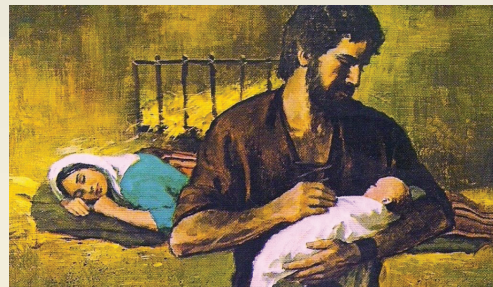

Ministry of Care Training

Ministers of Care bring Holy Communion to parishioners who are homebound, living in nursing homes, or in the hospital. They share with them the word of God in scripture, pray with them for the Church and the world, and offer them companionship. Through the Ministry of Care we are able to keep long-time parishioners of OLPH connected and active in our faith community.

The work of the Ministry of Care is open to all members of our parish community, and a basic training course for new Ministers of Care will begin on Tue., Jan. 28. The training will take place on five successive Tuesday evenings. Each session will focus on a particular aspect of the Ministry of Care; however, the unifying thread woven through all is a commitment to helping you develop the skills and confidence needed to be a source of comfort to those who are sick. Each weekly session will last two hours and will be facilitated by Rick Nash and retired priests who live at Presence St. Benedict Home in Niles. Completion of this course qualifies you to receive the Archdiocesan mandate to bring Communion to the sick, homebound and hospitalized of our parish.

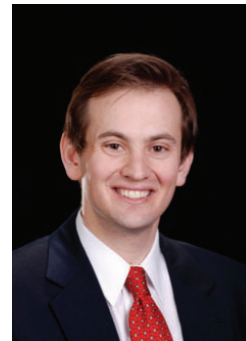

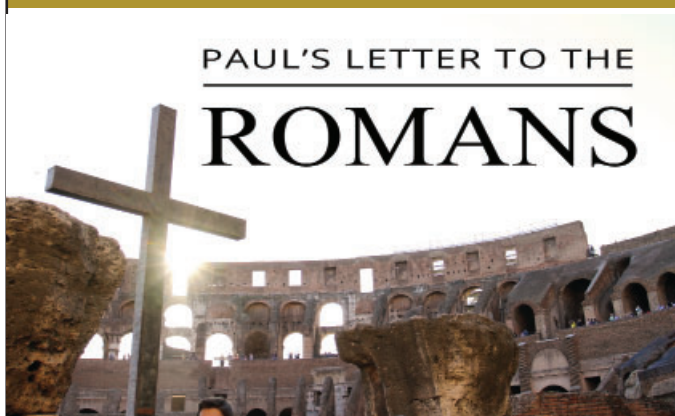
