#### **New COVID Guidelines**

New guidelines from the Archdiocese regarding gatherings on campus in light of the latest Omicron virus surge are now in effect. Here are some of the highlights of the communication from the Arch:

To further mitigate the potential spread of COVID, within all archdiocesan locations please refrain from including food and beverage in any events or meetings, or shared food trays around offices, until further notice.

As our in-person instruction continues in our schools, so, too, do our religious education programs. Parishes and Pastoral Center supervisors should continue to report any COVID cases using the appropriate intake form for the Case Management Team.

Remain prudent about hosting any large gatherings; if you can move an event until mid- to late-February please do. While there is no certainty as to when the current surge will peak, pushing out any non-essential events is best.

Wear a mask at all times while indoors and do not ignore seemingly minor symptoms such as a sore throat, runny nose, congestion, etc. These can be signs of COVID, so if you experience any of these please remove yourself from inperson work and get tested as soon as possible




