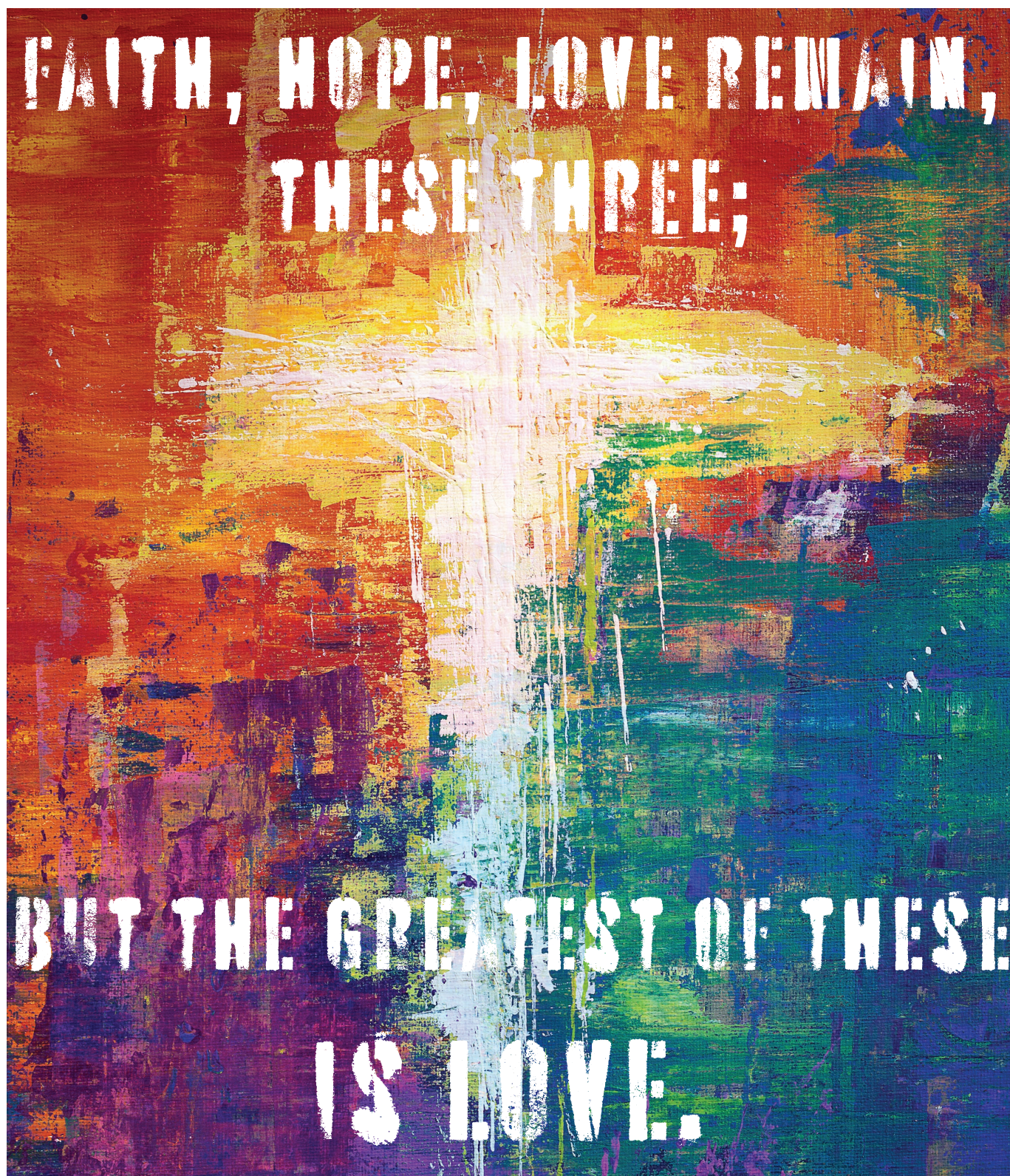

Upcoming Special Feast Day Celebrations

Candlemas, February 2

On Wednesday, Feb. 2, we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. It commemorates the day Jesus's mother Mary presented Jesus to God at the Temple in Jerusalem after observing the traditional 40-day period of purification (of mothers). This day is also known as Candlemas. Therefore, it has been a tradition in the Church to bless candles on this day. We invite all parishioners, wishing to attend the 8:30am Mass on February 2, to bring their candles from home to be blessed.

Feast of St. Blaise, February 3

The following day, Thursday, Feb. 3, is the Feast of St. Blaise, a 4th century bishop and martyr from Turkey & Armenia. It is believed that St. Blaise saved the life of a boy who was choking on a fish bone. On his feast, we celebrate the blessing of the throats with candles. Blessing will take place immediately after Mass.

Scripture Study

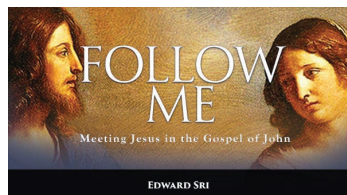
Winter Study: The Gospel of John

Stewardship Report

To all parishioners:

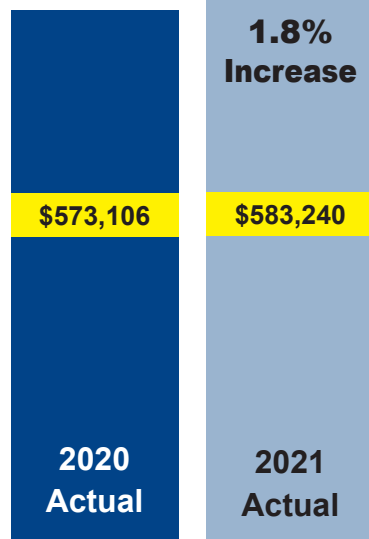
We would like to take a moment to thank you for your on-going generosity and continued support during the year. As a Parish Community, you have contributed \$1,388,312 in the General Offertory Sunday collections for the six months ended December 31, 2021. In addition, our Christmas collection stands at \$211,722 through this same period, although we have continued to receive additional gifts into January. You can see from the charts below that we are in a slightly better position than we were in the month of December 2020, however, still under our cumulative budget for the six months of this fiscal year.

As a reminder, we have moved our Planned Offertory Program (POP) mailing and Parish-wide focus on annual planned giving to the Spring, to better align with our fiscal year budget process, rather than calendar year. We ask and hope that those of you who have made pledges in the past continue to give according to the schedule you have previously set up, either through weekly or monthly envelopes, GiveCentral, or other timelines and methods you have chosen. The months of January and February, historically, produce lower collection results and we ask for your continued support, especially during these months. Please refer to GiveCentral information found in this bulletin for an easy way to donate on-line, should you be interested in that method of donating to OLPH.

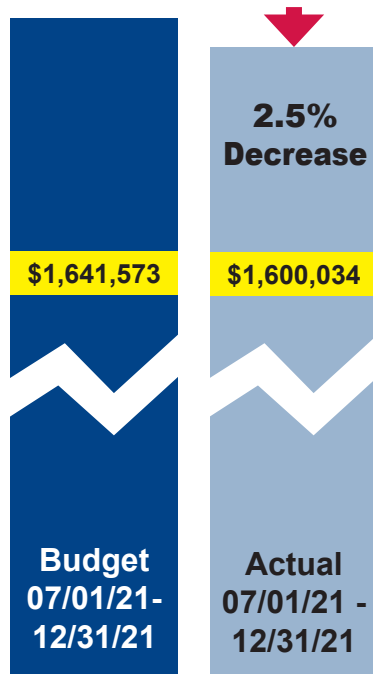
Once again, thank you for your very generous and continued commitment to support OLPH and its many ministries and activities.

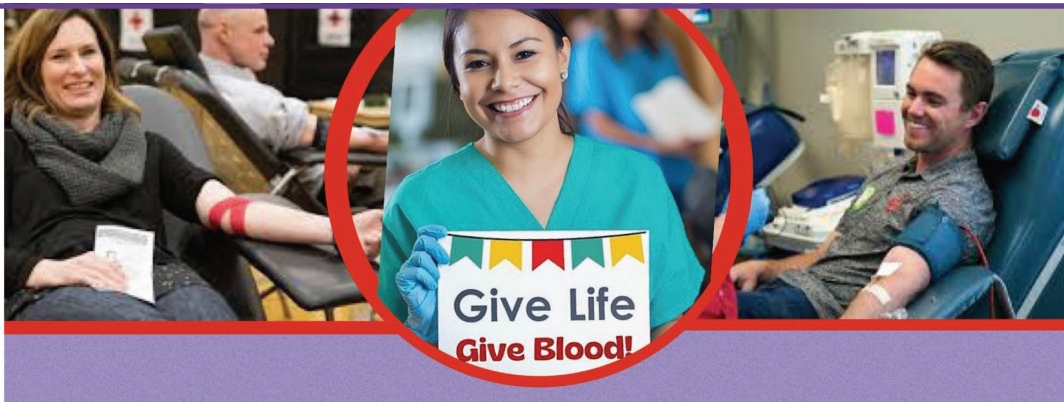
