Today, our **Sr. Paulanne** shares her thoughts on Confirmation Sunday and her prayers and wishes for our Confirmandi.

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday, 85 eighth graders from our school will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation from Bishop Perry. We certainly want to keep these young men and women who move into the next phase of their Sacramental program at our Parish School in our prayers. It is a very special day for them as they have been learning about the Sacrament of Confirmation and of the Holy Spirit in their lives.

As we reflect on the Mystery of God and look at the Creation of a great world by God the Father, we marvel at His Creation. We know that God the Son came as a human being to teach us about God's incredible love. Jesus showed us by His life how to love, suffer, die, and rise from the dead so we would be able to enter heaven and share in His everlasting love with us.

Until the time of preparation for Confirmation, we might not think about the Holy Spirit and His role in our lives. At the Last Supper, Jesus promised the Apostles that he would not leave them as orphans. On Pentecost morning, the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles. They were no longer frightened but were empowered to build the community of Disciples and renew the earth in God's love.

During Confirmation, at the laying on of hands, the Bishop prays that each candidate will receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit in a special way. We pray that the Holy Spirit will

give each candidate the spirit of Wisdom to help them see and follow God's will in their lives. We pray that they receive the gift of understanding to open their hearts to be more loving and compassionate toward others. We pray that they receive the gift of right judgement to make good choices as they live each day to the best of their ability. We pray that they receive the gift of courage to do the right thing even when it is difficult. We pray that they receive the gift of reverence to become more prayerful and to have respect for everyone and everything. We pray that they may receive the gift of wonder and awe to deepen their reverence for God and His Creation.

The gifts of the Holy Spirit are life-giving qualities that help us become the person God calls us to be. Our birth in the Holy Spirit through Baptism is strengthened in Confirmation. By receiving the Holy Spirit anew in Confirmation, we are helped to become a more loving person, a kinder person, a more understanding person.

In Confirmation, we accept a more responsible role in the Church. We are called to service both in the Church and in other aspects of our lives. We pray for our Confirmandi that they may grow in their love of the Holy Spirit and of His work in the Church. May Confirmation be a very special day for each child receiving it.

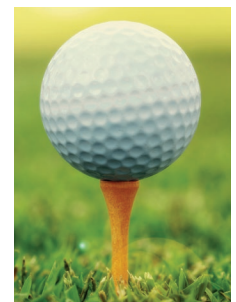
