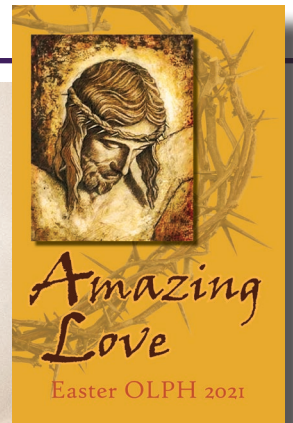

Dear Parishioners,

"Morning after morning, he opens my ears that I may hear"

The prophet Isaiah sets the stage as we celebrate Palm Sunday this weekend and begin our annual observance of Holy Week. The prophet challenges us to realize that God is anxious to speak to us. He is trying to open our ears so that we can hear. We will be invited in the coming week to reflect on the most sacred scenes captured in the scriptures that relate to the passion, death and resurrection of Our Lord.

We have heard these scriptures proclaimed many times in our lives. Every time they are presented to us, we should listen like we have never listened before. They draw us ever more deeply into the mystery of the events that

culminated in the Resurrection. They draw us into the mystery of the presence of the living Christ in our midst.

We continue our dealing with COVID-19 and in the midst of it all there is an invitation to hear more clearly the power of Christ's love for us. The interruption of our daily lives and isolation we have felt leads us to a renewed sense of how much we are loved. The past year has seemed like a long Lent. This Holy Week can be the best ever as we enter spring and the numbers of those vaccinated increases.

From our Lord's triumphal entrance into Jerusalem as he descended from the Mount of Olives to his Resurrection, we are invited to ponder his "Amazing Love" for us.

Please find time this week to hear the Word; please find time to hear how the Lord is being witnessed in your life; please hear again the words, "For God loved us so much, he sent us his only Son."

We have tried to provide as many opportunities to celebrate the liturgies of Holy Week and Easter. I am deeply grateful for the legion of people that will make this happen. We also will be live-streaming all of the services and they will be available on the web site.

Let us pray for one another! May your journey to Easter Sunday be blessed!

In keeping with Archdiocesan COVID guidelines, palms will be distributed by gloved ushers/greeters as parishioners enter the church.

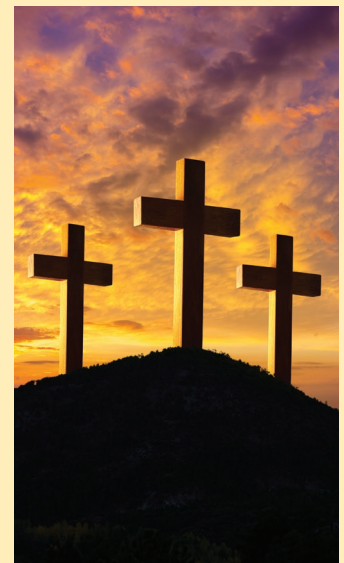
(There will be no procession outside.) Parishioners are asked to NOT leave palms behind in the pews.

- **Swieconka** (Blessing of Easter Foods), 11:30 am Holy Saturday, April 3, at the Parish Center porch. This will be a Drive-by event. Participants will stay in their cars as the priest does the blessing. No registration is required.
- In-Person **EASTER Mass**. A complete list of in-person events during the **Easter Triduum** can be accessed on our **olphglenview.org** website. To attend any of our Lenten or Easter services in-person, registration through Sign-up Genius is required.
- Our virtual **EASTER Mass** will be available for viewing from our **olphglenview.org** website and other social media all day on Easter Sunday, April 4. We encourage all families to view EASTER Mass together from your homes if you are not able to come to church.

Parish Updates

Drive-In Mass moving back outside!

As the seasons change, we adapt to what Mother Nature gives us. Now that the sun sets at a later time each week and as winter turns to spring, we will adjust our Saturday 5:00pm Drive-In Mass accordingly. Our priests will move down from the 3rd floor window and once again be saying Mass outside from the 2nd floor balcony of the Parish Center.

As always, we try to create the best experience possible for parishioners attending our Drive-In Mass and all of our liturgies.

Make sure to register on Sign-Up Genius and tune your radio to 95.7 FM.

Registration on Sign-Up Genius is still required for all liturgies.

As the weather gets better and more and more people get vaccinated, naturally there is a greater desire for parishioners to want to come to Mass in-person. However, we still must adhere to the Archdiocese guidelines. We are still limited in the number of people who can be in the church. Registration through Sign-Up Genius is still required.

Please note that not only are Sunday Masses filled to maximum capacity, but our weekday Mass are now filling up quickly. It is a very unfortunate situation when we have to turn someone away at the church door because they did not register online through Sign-Up Genius.

The Archdiocese bases the church protocols on the directives given by the State of Illinois. Until the Archdiocese eases up on restrictions, we will strictly follow the guidelines in place.

What is special about Divine Mercy Sunday?

In 1931, **Maria Faustina Kowalska**, a Polish nun, reported visions and visitations from Jesus and conversations with him. He asked her to paint the vision of his merciful divinity being poured from his Sacred Heart and specifically asked for a feast of Divine Mercy to be established on the first Sunday after Easter Sunday, so that mankind would take refuge in him



St. Faustina

Jesus spoke these words to St. Faustina:

My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a

refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners.

On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. (Diary, 699)

In April 30, 2000, then-Pope **John Paul II** declared that the second Sunday in the Easter season to be Divine Mercy Sunday. On the same day, he canonized Maria Faustina Kowalska as St. Faustina. You can join the OLPH Devotions Ministries to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy every Friday at 3:00 pm on Zoom by emailing heartsafireolph@gmail.com.

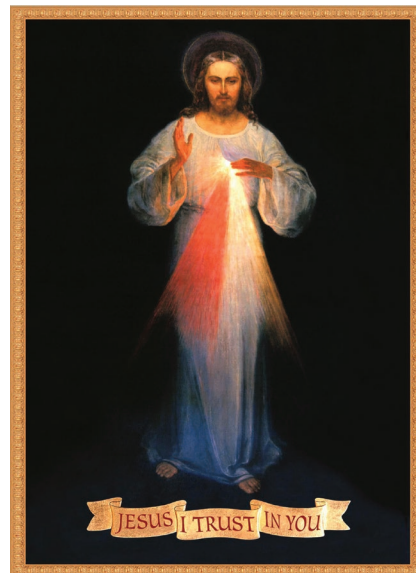
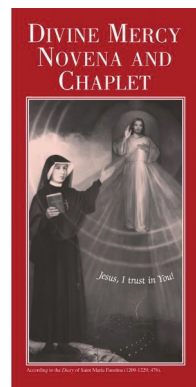


Image of Divine Mercy

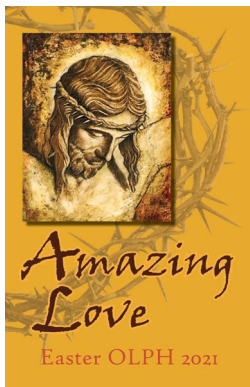

Come Down O Love Divine!

"How many Blessed Mothers do we have?" one of my students asked me. Before I could respond another student exclaimed, "As many as we need!" And we all laughed as we knew there was great truth in this young student's response.

This past week I have been preparing to participate in our *Lenten Mission – Amazing Love*. Fr. Jerry asked me to speak about the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord in connection with Amazing Love. I will give you a short summary here. When you read this, the Lenten Mission would have been released.

Images of Divine Love

I will share some images of divine love with you and images and titles of our Blessed Mother that helped me to grow faith and experience God's love. Most of the time our words fall short in trying to describe God's love. It is nearly impossible. Images and words help me to draw nearer to Christ and live out my faith more deeply.

Our image of *Amazing Love* is our Crucified Savior crowned with thorns. That image may seem strangely curious to non-Christians. But for those who believe in Christ, it is the way to salvation. And since we know Jesus' story, which gives us more hope? The Cross or the Resurrection?

We hear in Scripture that God is love and God's love for us is a covenant, a divine marriage covenant with His people. We also hear that Jesus is the Bridegroom, and our individual soul is the bride. Through the Incarnation, God passionately pursues us and desires for us to take part in his divine life. He wants us to imbibe and consume Him, so that we may become more and more like Him.

Images and titles of Mary

At the Annunciation, we hear that Mary is full of Grace. Full of God. Full of Love. Devotion to Mary is Devotion to Christ. Mary reflects Christ as the moon reflects the sun. Everything that Mary is and does is about her Son. It is not about her; it is about Him.

We cannot earn grace. It is a heavenly gift freely given. However, we may learn from Mary, how to be open to receive and conceive God's grace – to be Christ bearers in the world on a mission to participate in God's work of salvation. I will share three images of Mary that have touched my heart, have helped me to recognize divine love, and to discover my vocation and mission.

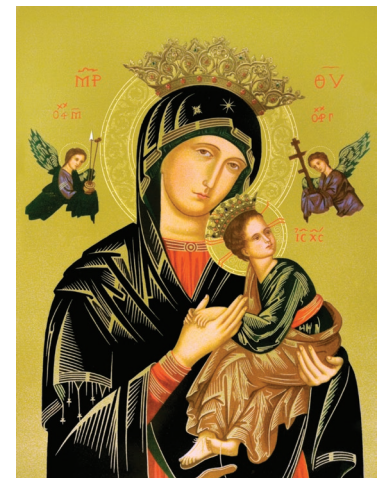

Mary Seat of Wisdom

I love Mary, Seat of Wisdom. God's love is revealed to us through Wisdom. I love to read, listen, and study Scripture and anything to do with Catholicism, the saints, liturgy, prayer, etc. I absolutely love the intelligence of all of it. I love that Wisdom is infinite – that we can never completely grasp it. The Our Lady of Perpetual Help icon is an example of this title, Mary Seat of Wisdom, in that she literally enthrones the Christ Child in her arms and directs our gaze to Him.

We learn through the Books of Wisdom that we are to imbibe Wisdom. We are to eat and drink Wisdom. Wisdom desires to become part of us. Imbibing Wisdom is like receiving the Eucharist. God wants to become part of us and remain with us through His holy Wisdom.

Our Lady of Sorrows

Our Lady of Sorrows

I love Our Lady of Sorrows. As strange and unappealing as sorrow and suffering may be, God's love is dramatically revealed through sorrow and suffering. Look to the Sorrowful Mysteries or the Seven Sorrows of Mary. Jesus transformed and sanctified sorrow, suffering and pain through His passion, death, and Resurrection.

St. Teresa of Calcutta expresses well the paradox of suffering and love – the meeting of the holiness of pain and divine love on the Cross, which result is the Eucharist.

"Nowhere on earth are we more welcomed or loved than by Jesus in the Eucharist. When you look at the crucifix, you understand how much Jesus loved you. When you look at the Eucharist you understand how much Jesus loves you now."

Mary, Mother of the Eucharist

I love Mary, Mother of the Eucharist. I love the Eucharist and I love Mass. God's love is revealed to us through the Eucharist.

The Eucharist is the greatest gift that we will ever receive and rightly orders our lives toward God if we allow Him.

Mary, Mother of the Eucharist is not a new idea. In the early Church, many Eucharistic images were applied to Mary as a tabernacle, a chalice, a ciborium, the Ark of the Covenant. St. Francis compares the Christ-carrying Virgin to the person who receives the Eucharist. We become Who we receive and conceive in our being. We allow Him to dwell within us.

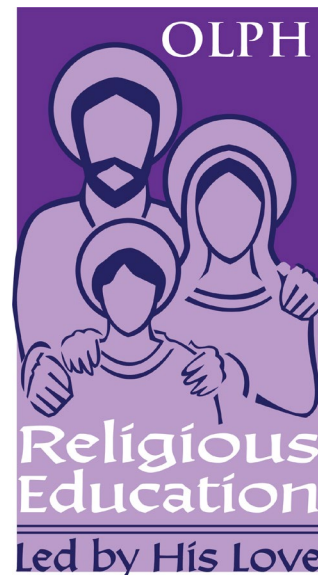
The Annunciation is also powerfully expressed in the consecration of the bread and wine to the Body and Blood of Christ on the altar.

When the priest invokes the Holy Spirit to consecrate the bread and wine, the Annunciation is mirrored, and the Lord is made present.

Let us sincerely pray that we may return the same radical love and humility to God that he gives to us in the Incarnation. May we allow Him to invade our very beings, so that we may become more and more like the One whom we imbibe, the One whom we have found; the One whom our soul loves and will not let Him go.

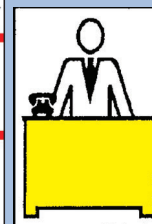
