Today, our Parish School Principal, **Dr. Amy Mills**, tells us about spiritual spring training happening now at our school. Dear Parishioners,

The Lenten season is a spiritual journey full of prayer, reflection and almsgiving. We are asked as Catholics to break away from our day-to-day routines and focus on our faith. At OLPH School, we are taking this Lenten Season as an opportunity to get "back into shape," spiritually speaking. Just as baseball players return to spring training each year to work on the fundamentals of baseball and the importance of team play, we're returning to the basics of following Jesus and the importance of being a part of the body of Christ.

This year, we've asked our students and families to help share their faith in fun, simple, and engaging ways. Each week in our classrooms and at home, students and families respectively, have been reading scriptures from the Bible and then talking about the different ways God's Word applies to our daily life. Through this activity, every family may experience a deeper connection to God and their faith.

Additionally, our students have been busy working on various ways to give alms. Through our Students of Service projects, we have donated time and resources to various organizations in our community – Bernie's

Book Bank, Cradles to Crayons, Feed our Starving Children, Share your Soles to name a few. We've also invited our children to collect coins for Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Puerto Rico during this Lenten season.

Through these acts of kindness and generosity, children live the Corporal Works of Mercy in response to the needs of the poor, overlooked, and vulnerable as they experience firsthand the challenges and rewards of caring for those in need. Our goal is to make service a habit of the heart. Our children quickly learn life is a gift from God and we are called to make a difference in other's lives.

Before Easter break, our students will gather one final time for a Holy Week Prayer Service. It will be the first time Grade 1 – 8 will be able to gather in one space this school year. With music featured by our choir, we'll reenact Jesus washing the feet of his disciples. This act of humility and service to others is a clear example for us to follow. I am so looking forward to the moment we're all together in God's house!

Then taste the pain of death it holds."


And, then he folds his hands and asks.

### What is the OLPH Parish Pastoral Council?

The OLPH Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) is an advisory body that supports the Church's concept of shared responsibility among laity, religious, and clergy. The PPC is made up of 15 parishioners and our pastor, Fr. Jerry Boland. Its purpose is to:

- Listen to, identify, and examine the needs, ideas, and hopes of our faith community;
- Engage with over sixty OLPH ministries to understand and affirm their work and help them address their needs and challenges;
- Create a "culture of involvement" within the parish that welcomes and embraces others and encourages the development of leaders across the parish
- Help envision, shape, and implement the future goals of our parish and monitor our ongoing success as we strive to fulfill the Church's teachings.

The PPC meets throughout the year on the third Monday of every month according to its bylaws. Meetings follow an established agenda defined in advance based on input from Fr. Boland and PPC members. Members also organize and plan the annual Summit and Ministry Appreciation Mass and Reception. PPC members serve a three-year term beginning each July.

## **Hearing Assistance** available in OLPH Church

### and McDonnell Hall



**OLPH** has a hearing loop installed. Users with a t-coil in their hearing aids can listen to the sound system directly. Check with your hearing care professional to determine whether your hearing aid or cochlear implant has a t-coil.

Please note that while the hearing loop can be accessed in both the main church and McDonnell Hall, both spaces cannot access the hearing loop at the same time. For example, at the 9:30am Sunday Mass when services are held concurrently in the main church and McDonnell Hall, the hearing loop can only be accessed in the main church.

For best results in the church, please sit in the front half of the church. The hearing loop may not be effective in the the back of the church, in the side pews, or in the Lady Chapel.

For those with a hearing device that does not have a t-coil, or if you simply would like to hear the service better, FM based Assistive Listening Devices (ALD's) are available to borrow. Please plan to arrive for Mass a few minutes early to find Sr. Paulanne or an usher to access an ALD.

Note: An FM based ALD uses radio waves to conduct sound that is broadcast through the microphone.

#### Instructions for an FM based ALD

- 1. Remove any hearing aid that you may be wearing
- 2. Turn on the ALD device
- 3. Place the ALD ear piece in your ear
- 4. Adjust volume as necessary

#### Return all borrowed equipment to Sr. Paulanne after Mass.




