Dear Parishioners,

"For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be."

This weekend's Gospel is so poignant. We are called to be faithful stewards of the treasures that have been entrusted to us. If we are to be faithful stewards, we need to know what our treasures are.

At first glance, that would seem

easy to determine. The list is legion though of people taking for granted or not fully appreciating their most precious gifts. I suppose you don't fully realize what a gift your health is until you are sick.

My sabbatical experience helped put many things in perspective. I found out that it is amazing on how little you need in terms of possessions. For six months, the only clothes I had were in my suitcase. My phone served most of my technological and communication needs. I found myself much more in tune with what was happening around me than I normally observe. One of the major learnings for me was the relationships in my life were far more important than any of my earthly possessions.

The Gospel challenges us to get our priorities in line with the real treasures we hold in our hearts. Making time to be more present to our family and friends, to cherish the beauty God has surrounded us with, to be generous stewards of our treasures can only deepen our faith.

One of the great treasures in my life is being your pastor. As I enter my ninth year, I hope to give my all to this community of faith. The words of the Lord this weekend speak loudly to me, "Much will be required of the person entrusted with much".

One of my top priorities has been doing whatever I can to ensure the public health and safety of our community. During the pandemic I have taken a very conservative approach to protocols. With your cooperation and support we have navigated this very challenging time quite well. I know some have been frustrated with me who have a much higher risk tolerance, but I feel we must always keep in front of us the common good.

Violence continues to plague our society and it requires constant vigilance. We have arguably one of the most beautiful parish complexes. It poses many challenges though from a public safety point of view. With 10 buildings we have many doors, stairwells and corridors. There are days we can have as many as 2,000 people on campus, attending school, religious education, parish programs and services in the Church.

A few years back I asked **Judge Michael Hood** to head a committee to develop an Emergency Action Plan. This plan has been a tremendous blessing. As we developed the plan, we forged even deeper connections with the Glenview Police and Fire Departments. The Plan calls for us each year to review our public safety and security procedures. And Yearly, we upgrade our video surveillance of the campus and address concerns.

This year we felt we needed to have a more substantive audit of our public safety and security procedures. I am particularly grateful to **Mary Lynne Januszewski** our Director of Operations, **Mike Hrvojevic** our Director of Facilities, **Dr. Amy Mills** our Principal and **Angela Romano** our Director of Religious Education, who along with others have participated in a thorough professional review of our parish campus. We will soon be receiving a formal report with recommendations on how we can improve public safety and security issues. As soon as the report has been reviewed, we will make the appropriate changes.

We are all creatures of habit and the simplest of changes can be challenging. As I mentioned earlier the common good demands, we sometimes must change ways we are doing things. In general, we have a safe and wonderful campus for the myriad of activities we host. As technology changes and new threats emerge, we must be nimble in addressing them.

From time to time I do receive anonymous letters and voicemails that I find threatening. I always turn those over to the police. They have an amazing ability to connect dots to get to the bottom of a situation that could pose a safety risk. Our police department is terrific and so supportive. If you ever have concerns about safety issues on campus, please don't hesitate to contact me.

The summer is flying by! Make sure you take time to enjoy this beautiful time of year.



Everything you wanted to know about R. E. (but were afraid to ask).

Each week, in the summer Bulletins, our Director of Religious Education & Youth Ministry, **Angela Romero** will answer questions and help parish families understand the benefits and importance of our Religious Education program here at OLPH.

What is Religious Education?

The OLPH Religious Education Program helps families guide their children in our Catholic faith, completely grounded in Jesus Christ. In the Gospel of Matthew, we hear Jesus say, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you" (Mt 28:19-20). The Religious Education program is one way that we respond to this directive as a parish. Religious Education is about encountering Christ and having an ongoing relationship with Him and His Church. The goal of our Catholic faith is to be a saint in heaven. We strive to accompany our students and their families on their journeys towards sainthood.

The OLPH Religious Education program offers a variety of classes to students in PreK through eighth grades. Families have the option to send their children to weekly classes: a more traditional model with a Catechist, a member of the

parish who has volunteered to share their faith with our children; or to join us for the Family Catechesis program which invites families with students in Pre-K through fifth grades to meet monthly and grow in faith together. These classes allow students to learn about the fundamentals of our faith such as the 10 Commandments, the Sacraments, the Mass, prayer, and so much more. The Religious Education program also prepares students to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion in second grade and Confirmation in eighth grade. Children are prepared for these Sacraments over a period of two to three years alongside their family and our community. Religious Education is a vital part of OLPH!


