## seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...

Dear Parishioners,

"We are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses"

One of the major themes of my sabbatical was studying the Letters of St. Paul and the birth of Christianity in the early Church. While the author of this weekend's Letter to the Hebrews is a source of debate, there are many themes of the Letter that were common to St. Paul's theology.

Paul believed that the greatest tool of evangelization was witnessing the power of our faith to others, sort of in line with the words of St. Francis, "preach the Gospel, if necessary, use words".

The explosive growth of Christianity was a result of the powerful witness of the faith of believers to their pagan culture. Caring for the sick, providing for the poor, praying to God on behalf of the needs of the community was so foreign to a culture that abandoned the poor, was afraid of God, self-centered in terms of one's needs.

The readings this weekend compel us to deepen our public witness of our faith. In a world becoming less religious, we can make a great case for the critical importance of community grounded in the teachings of Jesus Christ by what we say and do.

As we begin to look to the beginning of the program year in a few weeks, I encourage you to consider deepening your own witness of faith. We have so many opportunities to encourage and foster your witness of faith!

One of the great blessings has been our friendship with Sts. Peter and Paul Greek Orthodox Church on Lake. We have bonded over our common concerns on the environment as they were expressed in Pope Francis' landmark encyclical, "Laudato Si". Each year we join to celebrate the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. This year we will celebrate the Solemn Vespers at Sts. Peter and Paul on Wed., Aug. 31 at 7:00 pm. Please join us!

COVID update: Covid continues to impact our lives. As I write this letter, several parishioners are recovering from recent exposure. We are learning how to live with this virus. Most of the protocols have been relaxed but

there are still some precautions we observe. I have been asked about some specific practices:

**Communion in the cup:** I do not see this practice coming back in the foreseeable future. The Archdiocesan Covid Task Force finds this practice too risky currently.

**Confession in the confessionals:** Given the air born reality of transmission, the confessionals do not have proper ventilation and are too compact of a space between the penitent and the confessor. We have turned the former baptistry into a reconciliation room. This is working quite well. **Fr. Larry** and **Fr. Jim** are exploring plans to enhance the room for the purpose of celebrating the sacrament.

**Communion on the tongue:**

The Archdiocesan Covid Task Force finds this practice risky but does not forbid the practice. They recommend some precautions out of an abundance of concern. If you would prefer to receive the Eucharist on the tongue, they recommend you go to the back of the communion line, the minister will follow hand sanitizing measures and will distribute the eucharist. We have some clergy and eucharistic ministers who have been advised by their physicians not to participate in this practice but given the number of ministers who can, there should not be a problem. Thank you for your patience.

Over the years we have provided pilgrimage and travel opportunities for parishioners. We recently had a great journey to Oberammergau in Germany to witness the Passion Play. There is information on an upcoming trip led by **Fr. Larry** to the Christmas Markets in Europe in late November. I will be leading a trip to Sicily in October of 2023. These trips go to great places, organize all the details and provide a great time to travel.

Welcome back to our faculty who begin a week of meetings preparing for the beginning of the school year.

## Ask Angela

Everything you wanted to know about R. E. (*but were afraid to ask*).

Each week, in the summer Bulletins, our Director of Religious Education & Youth Ministry, **Angela Romero** will answer questions and help parish families understand the benefits and importance of our Religious Education program here at OLPH.



### What is Family Catechesis?

Family Catechesis is a learning model that allows families to walk their faith journey together as a family alongside others in our community. The program is designed to help children in Pre-K through fifth grades and their parents to grow together in faith. "Family-centered catechetical programs are opportunities for parents to catechize their children directly, for spouses to catechize each other and for children to catechize one another and their parents" (National Directory for Catechesis #61.2). Family Catechesis is a program that allows families to learn and pray together. It includes monthly in-person sessions for both parents and their children from October to May, and supported learning at home during the rest of the month.

Here at OLPH, Family Catechesis takes place on site the first Saturday of each month from 9:30am to 11:30am. The remainder of the month families will work through the material assigned at home together. This model can help accommodate the busy schedules our families juggle and allow parents to become involved in new ways in the faith lives of their children. Family Catechesis at OLPH is open to families with students in PreK through fifth grades. If your

family has children in sixth, seventh, or eighth grades they are welcome to participate in the program alongside their family, but will need to enroll in weekly Religious Education classes in order to receive specific preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation. Family Catechesis is a wonderful option for families who wish to explore their Catholic faith together while also getting to know other families in our community!

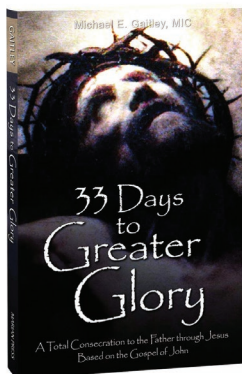

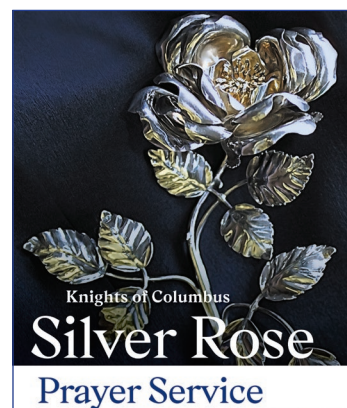

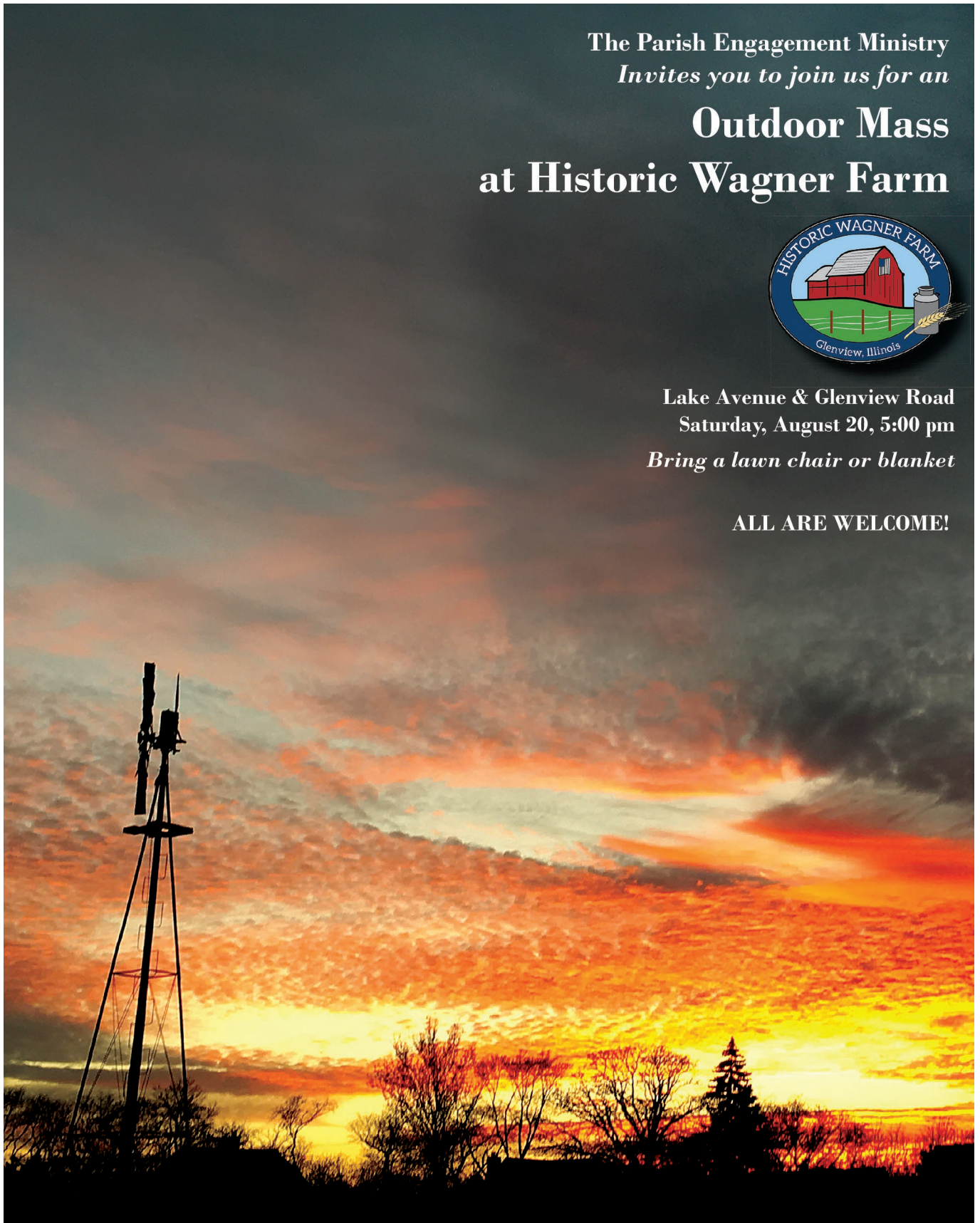

As the summer rolls on and the fires rage out West and in Europe and Asia and the temperature soar everywhere, none of us can sit on our hands and hope someone else will do something. While there are some hopeful signs in Washington DC recently, we all still need to do what we can do.



In our Bulletin articles over the past few years, we have tried to give some ideas of what you and your family can do to help reduce your carbon footprint. We hope these articles have been helpful and that you have been able to put into practice some of the ideas we have described.

Many of these ideas have involved reducing energy usage and hopefully in that way reducing consumption of fossil fuels and the related effect on climate change. 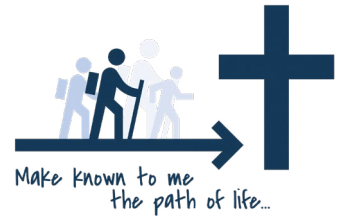
