Dear Parishioners,

"Seek the Lord where he may be found"

The Prophet Isaiah challenges us to keep searching and seeking the Lord. This is a lifelong task. At every stage of our life, the Lord is revealing his power and love for us. We will never know the Lord in His entirety until we enter immortality.

This process of seeking the Lord takes on special meaning as we find ourselves in the midst of this pandemic. The pandemic, along with the civil strife in our cities and the fires, floods and hurricanes can't help but intensify our desire to find the Lord and manage all this uncertainty,

The scriptures this weekend assure us that the Lord is close to us even when we are trying to cope with so many things. The Covid crises has opened my eyes to the profound generosity and courage of so many going above and beyond to keep us safe and to minimize disruptions for our vital needs.

The civil unrest is a moment for us as a society to embrace the wisdom of Jesus' message; "love one another as I have loved you". The racial, economic and social divisions reveal deep fractures in our society that are complex, but demand all of us to reflect more deeply on the prejudices we harbor and the selfishness that contributes to a divided world. This requires us to enter a process of dialog with those who come at life from a different perspective or a different culture. America has been the place of dreams and progress. There is no division that cannot be healed when we are guided by the teachings of Our Lord.

All the disasters that are afflicting various parts of our country and the world remind us of how beautiful yet how fragile our environment is. **Pope Francis'** encyclical, *Laudato Si'*, speaks to the profound interconnectedness of creation. The smallest fraction of the smallest fraction of nature is connected. We need to transcend many barriers to create a mutual commitment to protect this precious gift, the planet we all live on. The Holy Father's subtitle to his encyclical is, "on care of our common home".

The Covid 19 crises has revealed that this virus does not distinguish the wealthy from the poor, the West from the East, the young from the old, the northern hemisphere from the southern hemisphere. It reveals that on a human level we share in the same vulnerabilities that can impact every human being. Covid may be the occasion of bringing us altogether to fight this universal threat.

Parish life invites all of us to "seek the Lord". While our manner of coming together is altered for the time being, much is happening. Scripture Study is in full swing, our school is entering its fourth week, soon religious education will begin the year. The Women's Club and Men's Club have been planning for the coming year in this uncharted time. The Boy Scouts raised \$500 for **Sr. Paulanne**. The Girl Scouts had a wonderful meeting last Sunday under the safety of the big tent on the rectory lawn. Project Linus continues to do so much. Many of our Sharing Volunteers have shifted to the Northfield Food Depository to continue to assist the growing numbers of food insecure people in our larger community. The Sister Paulanne Needy Family Fund continues to be a lifeline for people facing severe economic hardship. The OLPHun Run this year will be so creative!

One of the more difficult challenges of our liturgical life is to continue the slow process of reopening. This requires flexibility and patience from us all. We are creatures of habit and while the timing of masses would be on the lower end of things we must deal with, it is another challenge to our routines. We have all, in recent months, had to adapt to constant changes as to when stores are open or when we can make appointments to see a doctor and so on.

October will bring more changes to our mass schedule as we keep trying to expand the number of masses while implementing the protocols for public safety.

Starting the first weekend of October we will restore the 8:30 a.m. Saturday morning mass as we have accommodated several of the funeral masses that were postponed because of the shutdown. We will continue the 5:00 "Drive in Mass" on Saturday evenings that has become somewhat of a sensation. Sunday mornings we will have a 9:00 mass in the Church, 9:30 mass in the Playdium, 10:30 Mass in the Church and a 12:00 mass in the Church. This schedule will be evaluated towards the end of the month and any necessary additions or subtractions will take place. It will be some time before we will approach what was the former schedule, but we are moving forward!

I know it is far off, but I also know as the holidays approach people are making plans and are concerned about how families will honor family traditions like the celebration of Christmas. In preliminary planning, my hope is to accommodate as many as possible to celebrate the Christmas liturgy. Over the days of Dec. 23rd, 24th and 25th, we will be providing a marathon of Christmas masses, from the "Eve to the Eve to Christmas Day there will be several masses in the Church and the Playdium that will safely provide many opportunities for you and your loved ones to celebrate the Christmas liturgy. More to come on this.

Dear OLPH Parishioners;

May the grace and peace of the Holy Spirit be with us forever.

I am writing to inform you that this year's Jazzin' to Feed fundraiser has been cancelled. We had originally rescheduled Jazzin' to Feed from the spring to October in hopes that the restrictions of the pandemic would be eased enough to allow us to gather. Unfortunately, in order to keep everyone safe we will be unable to gather in person this year. Apart from this event being one of the spring highlights in the Bronzeville neighborhood, Jazzin' to Feed is the main fundraiser for our food pantry. We have relied on this event to raise much needed funds for over 15 years.

Despite the numerous challenges presented by the pandemic, I want to assure you that we are committed to keeping the food pantry open; **however, we need your help.** For nearly 50 years, St. James Food Pantry has been a beacon of hope for many struggling families, most especially, families and individuals living in near-by public housing and the elderly living in several of the Chicago Housing Authority Senior Buildings. Today the pantry is at the front line providing food to families in need and those impacted by the pandemic. All the pantry programs are running with the exception of the nutrition classes which have been postponed until further notice. We have made adjustments in the way we serve our clients to ensure the safety of our staff, volunteers and clients through social distancing. In addition, we expanded the food delivery program for seniors and people with disabilities to ensure that they have access to food during the pandemic. With God's grace, we haven't closed our doors since the onset of the pandemic. Saint James will continue to do this important work. I hope you will consider my plea for help.

Let me thank you in advance for your contribution which makes it possible for Saint James to care for the less fortunate. Here at St. James, feeding the hungry is our ordinary practice year in and year out. Your generosity makes it possible for us to bring the love of God into the lives of God's beloved children.

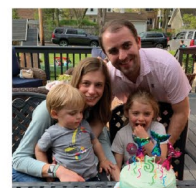

- **Catechetical Sunday Sept 20** - Come pray with us and celebrate our RE and SPRED Catechists as Fr. Larry commissions and blesses them to serve our OLPH families in 2020-2021 at 9:30 am Mass in the Playdium this Sunday, Sept. 20. Sign up for Mass on Sign-up Genius. The link can be accessed from the homepage of our olphglenview.org website.
- **We need more new courageous Catechists with a heart for Jesus' mission!** With the additional program times offered and many catechists having left the RE program, we need new catechists. Please contact me if you are willing to serve these families and our Church: mwaldron@olphglenview.org
- **RE Classes with 3 or less children enrolled:** Families have been contacted with options to move to another catechist class or remote learning model. Thank you for your flexibility and understanding.
- **Class Assignments will be revealed next week.** Registration process is manual and complex, and we are still recruiting catechists. Thanks for your patience.
- **RE Hard Copy Materials Pick up next week:** Materials have been ordered and will arrive next week. Once materials arrive, many times will be offered for families to pick up RE materials in front of the Parish Center. Know that all children will also receive e-books in grades PK thru 6 and online materials for grades 7 and 8.
- **Consistent Structure for Remote Learning:** Each weekly class will have the same structure during the 40-minute session: 1. Welcome and Opening Prayer; 2. Review and Reflect Upcoming Sunday Gospel; 3. Lesson Content; 4. Student Assessment; 5. Student Homework Assignment; and 6. Closing Prayer. Amen!
- **Needy Family Gift Cards needed.** Please consider donating gift cards for needy families. You may drop them off when you pick up your RE materials next week.
- **Zoom RE Parent Information Meetings:** Beginning next week on Wed., Sept 23, many RE Parent Information Meetings will be offered to explain the RE Program under my DRE leadership and remote learning environment. All good stuff! Meeting times will be offered morning, afternoon and evening over several days. Stay tuned for exact times. One parent from each family is required to attend.
- **RE Program Family and Catechist Handbook** will be released in the upcoming week. Handbook sets guidelines and expectations for everyone in RE.
