Dear Parishioners,

"Jesus, Master, have pity on us!"

This weekend, we hear the Gospel story of the healing of the ten lepers and only one returned to give thanks, the Samaritan.

During Jesus' time, Jews and Samaritans shared mutual contempt for one another. The diagnosis of leprosy transcended their hostility for

one another. They found common ground in that they were both marginalized by their cultures. No matter what our differences may be, we often share the same tears. "Jesus, Master, have pity on us."

Only one of the cured lepers returns to express gratitude, the one who was the most outcast in a group of outcasts.

Does our prayer ever lead us to joyful gratitude or exuberant thanksgiving? Gratitude is a gift we give God. Gratitude can be a response to the gift of God's healing. This weekend's stories of healing can help us to better appreciate the "cleansing" we receive when we experience the forgiveness and mercy that only God can bestow.

Who are the "lepers" in our midst that need to be healed, restored, or included.? We all have a list of those who we have in a sense banished from our sight, people who have hurt us, judged us, or mistreated us. The Gospel challenges us to have pity, to make the overture, to forgive or be forgiven. St. Ignatius taught that gratitude should always be our response to our encounters with the Lord.

We can find ourselves being a leper or defining someone else as a leper.

"Jesus, Master, have pity on us!"

We continue our observance of "Respect Life Month. I am grateful for the many initiatives the Women's and Men's Club undertake to assist people in need. The people who benefit from many of our drives are often ignored and marginalized. Your support of the Baby Bottle Project, The Coat Drive, the Befriend a Family Program, The Sharing Program, just to name a few of

the initiatives we undertake, express our conviction to see every human life as sacred.

We are continuing to implement recommendations that came from our recent security audit. The school has employed a security service that will have a security guard on campus from 6:30 am to 6:30 pm

Congratulations to **Fr. Isaac Lara**, and the community of St. Catherine Labouré on the 60th anniversary of the founding of their parish school.

Congratulations to our parishioner, **Dianne Donnelly Stone** on being inducted into the National Collegiate Tennis Hall of Fame. What an achievement!

Congratulations to OLPH Grad, **Cam Morales** who was named as a recipient of the prestigious Batten Family Scholarship to the Frank Batten School of Leadership and Public Policy at the University of Virginia.

Plans have been finalized for our next parish trip. We will be headed to Rome, the Amalfi Coast and Sicily from September 24, 2023, to October 6, 2023. More specifics will be forthcoming. Befriend a Family 2022-2023

Befriend a family provides support to needy families at holiday times, with OLPH donors anonymously matched up with families in need within our four Sharing parish communities, St. Sabina's, St. Josephine Bakhita, St. James and Mother of the Americas. Support is also extended to local families and a more limited number of refugee families. Sponsors can be individuals, families or groups and choose the size family that works for them.

Our goal is to help close to 200 needy families through the program this year with gift cards for food at Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter and additionally providing gifts, or gift cards for gifts, at Christmas.

We ask donors to give careful consideration to the size family they wish to take on. We suggest donations of \$50 - \$100 per person for food for each holiday and additionally suggest donations of \$75 - \$200 for gifts per person at Christmas. A family of two, for example, could receive \$250 or more in total gift cards for food and gifts at Christmas. Sponsor a family of one, two three or more. We'll match you with the family size you choose. We will provide you with a limited profile of the family we match to you.
