Dear Parishioners,

“Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.”

Today we celebrate, “The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King”. This weekend ends the liturgical year that began with the First Sunday of Advent last November.

We recall the many celebrations and feasts that marked this past year of grace. We celebrated Advent and Lent, Christmas and Easter. We marked great moments in the life of our community and the larger Church. We also pause to acknowledge those moments when we have personally encountered God’s grace and blessings.

This weekend we rejoice in the sovereignty of Jesus Christ in our lives. He should reign in our minds and in our hearts. This solemnity encourages us to celebrate and live out our faith in public. The world we live in is trying to marginalize our faith and worship.

I think of the joys and sorrows, the high points and low points, the blessings and challenges we have all encountered. Our parish continues to be a place that is forming and encouraging all of us! Thank you for your support and participation. We have had to face many headwinds as a result of the pandemic, but we have become stronger and more committed to our mission as a community of believers.

As the magnitude of the pandemic became a major threat to public safety in March of 2020, the Cardinal issued a dispensation from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass. This dispensation was deemed necessary because of how contagious COVID was. We implemented all the protocols and provisions to ensure the safety of everyone. I will be forever grateful for your cooperation and encouragement during those long months when we all had to change our behaviors for the common good. This is what community is all about. I know there were tremendous sacrifices we all had to make.

The Cardinal has determined that now is the time to lift the dispensation and encourage as many as possible to return to the public celebration of the Eucharist. He feels with

the number of people vaccinated and the effectiveness of other measures it is now safe to return to the normal obligation to attend the weekly celebration of the Eucharist.

There are still vulnerable people who may continue to absent themselves because of their health situation. We will continue to live stream the Mass, but the general obligation to attend weekly liturgy begins next Sunday, the First Sunday of Advent. Please read the Cardinal’s letter in this Bulletin. Next weekend after the homily we will have a renewal of baptismal vows to mark the lifting of the dispensation and our commitment to participate in the Eucharistic celebration.

Next Saturday, Nov. 26, at the 5:00pm Mass, we will mark the 40th Anniversary of the Sharing Program. What a moment to celebrate and thank God for all that has been achieved through the relationships established through the Sharing Program. This remarkable outreach to our Sharing Parishes has had a tremendous impact as how we see our parish and how we understand our mission.

I am overwhelmed at the many ways our parish responds to the needs of others. This time of year, I think of the coat drive, the food drive, the Befriend a Family Program, the turkey Thanksgiving dinners and Christmas ham dinners that meet the needs of hundreds of people in our metropolitan community.

Thank you for your support of last weeks special appeal to support the refugee outreach to the growing numbers coming to Chicago.

I call your attention to considering supporting the Tax Credit Scholarship Program. You can receive 75% state income tax credit on your gift. Since 2018, over 28,000 scholarships worth \$200 million dollars have been awarded to private schools. There is information in the Bulletin and the website for more information and who to contact for assistance.

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

In so many ways—large and small—the pandemic has upended our lives together. Families and, in a special way, young people, have faced distressing struggles. The pandemic made our connections with one another challenging and difficult. Exactly in that moment when we truly needed supportive relationships with one another, we found ourselves separated. Sadly, this included the relationships and connections that we have in and through the Church.


We did our best to move forward and I am proud of our collective response to the challenges of the pandemic. When I announced a general dispensation from the obligation to participate in Sunday Mass, many parishes offered on-line Sunday Masses, and went even further and established prayer lines and reached out to those in need. The TV Mass that I celebrated helped to keep us connected as a community of faith in Chicagoland. So many of you have told me how healing and comforting those Masses have been.

In the meanwhile, we are in a new moment. With vaccinations and boosters, restrictions on public gatherings have eased up. Many people feel more comfortable returning to Church. Yet, we know there are some elderly and immuno-comprised persons who are still not ready to return. And they should not return. These vulnerable brothers and sisters have an excusing cause for being absent and for this reason I will continue the TV Mass on ABC for the present time. But for the rest of us, I have decided, in consultation with my advisors, to lift the general dispensation from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass as we begin a new Church year on the First Sunday of Advent, November 26-27.

My hope is that the First Sunday of Advent will provide us with a fresh start to take up again our life together as a community of faith that gathers to worship God. I have asked our pastors to begin the Masses on November 26-27 with the traditional lighting of the Advent wreath. After the homily your pastor will lead the community in a renewal of baptismal promises, acknowledging that we owe our obligation to participate in Sunday Mass to God but also to each other. Our common profession of faith and of our desire to turn away from sin, will be concluded by a sprinkling rite with the waters of baptism.

Let this occasion of our renewal of faith and life, which we all so much want, provide us with a fresh start as we recommit ourselves to worship God and to be supportive of each other week after week as we gather around the Table of the Lord to be nourished and renewed.




## Parish Summit



# The Sharing Ministry - The Fourth Decade

The evolution of the Sharing Ministry in the 4th decade was guided strategically by a Winter Retreat. The goal was to discern our future and to be responsive to the example and vision of **Sr. Paulanne**. Each of us listened closely as Sr. Paulanne discussed her amazing history and shared her mission of tenderly meeting those on the margins at her

back door. Her words sent a powerful current through our collective group, and the following Sharing Ministry Mission Statement became our foundation:

“In response to Christ’s call to love one another, our mission is to offer financial, physical and spiritual support to those in need while promoting dignity, respect, and justice for all.”

Sharing inherited many legacy programs, events, and views on what our community should do. Many of us remember the sage wisdom of **Patricia Marohn** as she stated, “We need to KISS!” (Keep it Simple Sister). That philosophy helped to craft our future direction and realize that Sharing was truly a platform for the larger OLPH parish. Innovative and forward-thinking ideas became a reality. At the same time, an extensive parish-wide survey was underway. According to **Fr. Hickey** (our pastor at the time), “The overriding theme was that Sharing represented ‘faith in action,’ and the singular importance of Sharing was clear to our parishioners.” It was a powerful reminder of our collective identity, and that we viewed Sr. Paulanne as the foundation of OLPH. Sr. Paulanne never sought the spotlight, yet she has been recognized by a multitude of organizations.

During the past 10 years, Sharing has engaged the parish using multiple tools.

- An open house showcasing the active and bustling Sharing Room
- Stellar video & marketing pieces showcasing Sr. Paulanne in action
- Engagement & communication with the PPC, Men’s Club, Women’s Club, etc. to put ideas into actions
- Onboarding volunteers from all walks of life

The consistent force of Sharing touched all aspects of OLPH & the larger Glenview community. Many amazing and organic ideas came to the forefront and were led to dynamic outcomes by a multi-generational cross section of parishioners. The results have been magnificent! We invited our parishioners to go “outside”

of Glenview and engage with our Sharing parishes in fun, productive, and engaging ways. The love and good will, and the depth of relationships formed have created stronger communities and brought forth multiple generations of our neighbors.

Millions of dollars were donated for food, housing, and emergencies; people knew they were loved by OLPH’s generosity. Others became board members, started mentoring programs, and painted the classrooms of Our Lady of Tepeyac side-by-side with our sharing friends in Pilsen. The countless hours of work helped build God’s Kingdom.

A Winter Retreat was held in February 2020, but the best laid plans came to a screeching halt as Covid became a reality. During this time of isolation, another chapter unfolded as the wisdom of our community led us to reassess our procedures. As a result, we simplified some things and went back to what we do best. Today’s “Sharing Resource Center” is new and improved, a testament to our vision of being perpetual and keeping the roots strong for the future.

We cannot talk about the Sharing Ministry without recognizing the gift of **Betty Collins’** deep commitment and her superlative organizational and leadership skills. Betty has been at the Sharing table for 40 years, and she has left her mark in so many extraordinary ways.

As I reflect on my time in this Ministry, I see a number of seeds planted in 1982 that flowered like the Hellerman Gardens. The countless volunteers folding, driving, lifting, communicating, and sending checks have followed Jesus’ call to help the least of my brothers.

Sr. Paulanne, we give thanks for the foundation you built and your consummate example of being a Disciple of Jesus.

### Reflection from Paul Michellini

I have lived in OLPH Parish for 50 years and retired as the Covid situation began. I became bored and started questioning my worth until I met a number of individuals who donate their time at the Sharing Room. I was very familiar with **Sister Paulanne**, who was always my inspiration, but I am also inspired by the members of the great group I work with who are dedicated to helping those in need. When I make deliveries, I am complemented and thanked, but I always reply that I am only the delivery person; the thanks belong to the OLPH Parishioners for all they donate. Also, a tremendous thanks to **Sister Paulanne**, **Betty Collins**, **Bill Lynch**, and the number of volunteers who make the program a continual success. I am proud to be part of this magnificent group.

### Reflection from Amy White

I'm a newcomer to Sharing compared with my esteemed comrades, but in these first few years I've already reaped decades of blessings. From coordinating donation drives for essential items to mentoring Our Lady of Tepeyac students, each encounter fills me up and feeds my soul. Through this ministry, I'm not only serving but also receiving, learning, growing, and making wonderful friends. I'm grateful to be a small part of this 40-year tradition. Congratulations OLPH Sharing Ministry!

### Reflection from Mary Lou Jarvis

I don't recall if I found the Sharing Room or it found me. It was a very sad time in my life as I had just lost my dearest friend of 66 yrs. During her last few months, we spent hours going over her clothes, shoes, etc. Each piece had a story attached to

it. After her passing, her family asked me to donate her things. At least three car-loads were taken to the Sharing Room, and I somehow couldn't leave her stuff there without seeing where it was going. And, thus, I now work Sunday mornings in the Sharing room from 8:00 to 12:00 noon.

### Reflection from Janis Moylan

To share God's love with others is to help those who are in need. OLPH Sharing Ministry is the core of our belief to care for one another and has been instrumental to our parish for over 40 years. I am grateful and blessed to be a part of this ministry that provides food, shelter, and warmth for those in need. Sharing is the heart of OLPH!

### Reflection from Lisa Berens

Having grown up in OLPH parish, when I moved back to Glenview, it seemed an obvious place to get involved. I knew about the Sharing Room as my mom has been "sorting" there for decades. When I asked **Sister Paulanne** where help was needed, she pointed me in **Betty Collins'** direction. Turns out my talents could be utilized as a liaison between OLPH and an organization out of Deerfield working with refugee families. Through the generosity of the parish and the overflow of donations, we have been able to help many Ukrainian and Afghan families set up their new homes.

### Reflection from Ellen Kieffer

I have been part of Sharing in a small way by sorting clothing and household items in the Sharing Resource Center. I am there on Wednesdays with a friendly group of volunteers, and we direct the clothing to where the need is greatest.

There is so much going on there. Food is sorted, special drives are going on, volunteers pick up and drop off food, others drive food where it is needed. This is just a very small part of what is being accomplished, and I am impressed with all the generous people at OLPH.

### Reflection from Fr. Edmund, St. James Parish

The term to describe the decades-long relationship between OLPH and St. James is that we are "sharing parishes." While there certainly is sharing, the relationship is much more organic than that. An example from nature to describe our relationship is an image of symbiosis: "a long-term interaction between members of different species that often benefits both organisms." Our relationship is symbiotic in that OLPH is given the opportunity to extend their hands in Charity, and St. James provides the location where those in need find that the Church cares for them. We could not run our food pantry without the generosity of OLPH.

In the truest sense, it is not our parishes which benefit – it is the poor. Our relationship is for others, "the least" as Jesus called them who bear a family resemblance to him. We can be grateful for the opportunity to make the works of charity a concrete reality in the lives of so many hurting people.


