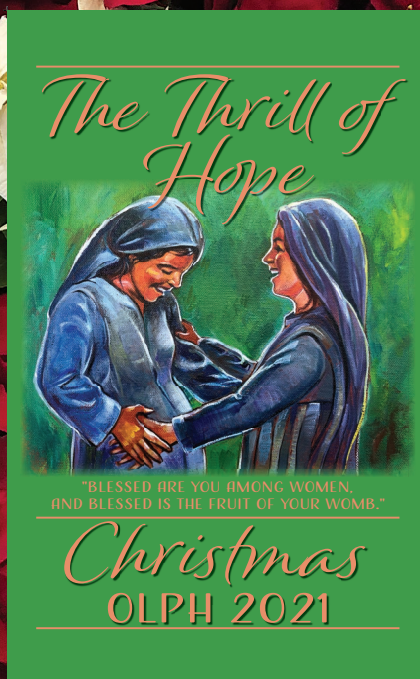

Dear Parishioners,

"Blessed are you among women and blessed is the fruit of your womb."

These final days of Advent focus on the events leading to the birth of Our Lord. All around us are the sights and sounds of the impending Feast of Christmas. We have entered the days when many of the gospels we hear focus on Mary. This weekend recalls the Visitation of Mary and Elizabeth. Their offspring would change the world forever. John the Baptist would prepare the way.

Our spiritual journey might be described as a series of "visitations". These encounters with the sacred, these moments of illumination, these invitations to draw closer to the Lord.

Advent calls us to listen, to recognize, to embrace the Word of God which is constantly being revealed. I see the power that is released when we forgive. I see the power released when we choose good over evil. I see the power released when we are grateful and generous with our blessings.

As the Lord "visits" you, what might he find? What would he see in your heart? What would hear you saying?

Mary and Elizabeth's visitation was a pivotal moment in salvation history as these two women would say yes to the uncertain in order for the plan of God to be fulfilled. God seeks to lead us and guide us but we must be willing and open. We can be so consumed with ourselves and the demands of the present that we have little time or energy to look beyond the present to get a sense of the bigger picture.

Advent is a great affirmation of the desire of the Lord to "visit" us with his dreams and hopes. As Christmas approaches can we be drawn to these deeper levels of awareness? What great words of encouragement we hear in this weekend's gospel, "Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled."

In just a few days, we will enter the Christmas Season. I pray this Christmas will be a time of encountering the power of Christ's love for you. These months of dealing with COVID has taken its toll. Being grounded in faith we have faced many challenges. This Christmas invites us to allow the Lord to be born anew in our lives. Make room for Him. Let his promise of peace wash over you.

As Christmas approaches I feel a profound sense of gratitude for all of you. Your resilience, your courage, your kindness has meant the world to me. I feel that the past year has been filled with many "visitations" of God's power be revealed to me by you!

In the Bulletin you will find our schedule of services. I welcome you all to "Come Home for Christmas!" We need each other! We need to worship together!

May your celebration of Christmas be blessed!

A CHRISTMAS MESSAGE FROM SISTER PAULANNE

The Christmas Season reminds us of God's Infinite Love and Mercy in our lives. May our hearts be open to His gifts during these troubled times.

Each one of us must hear the call Jesus gave us to feed the hungry, clothe the naked, and shelter the homeless. Each one of us has the responsibility to respond. The more we can work together to bring respect to all people, empower people to move forward, the better our communities will become.

We are the greatest nation with the most resources and yet do not provide the basic necessities of food, clothing, and shelter to help people survive. Mothers come from our community in need of food, clothing, hygiene products, and more, because they have so little. Senior citizens, who have worked hard all their lives, live on a very limited budget and frequently go without important things such as medication. People who have suffered from COVID and who have been unable to work for several months are threatened with eviction. Lights and gas are turned off. People live in fear and feel helpless because there is nowhere to turn.

God needs to be the center of our lives every day. We need to give strength and hope to those who have none. We need to go to Mass as family. Eucharist must be key in our faith. We cannot empower people if God is not first in our lives.

We must do all we can to change our society, our government, our communities. We need to use our inner strength, talent, and vision to build a better world. Our communities are better when we have strong family values and respect for one another, when we educate and motivate our children in a strong educational environment, when we create sufficient job opportunities and provide basic necessities for one another. We know this is the answer to building great communities which, in turn, build a great nation.

We need to live the Message of the Gospel by feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, housing the homeless and educating our children. Christ told us: "What you do to the least of my people, you do to me."

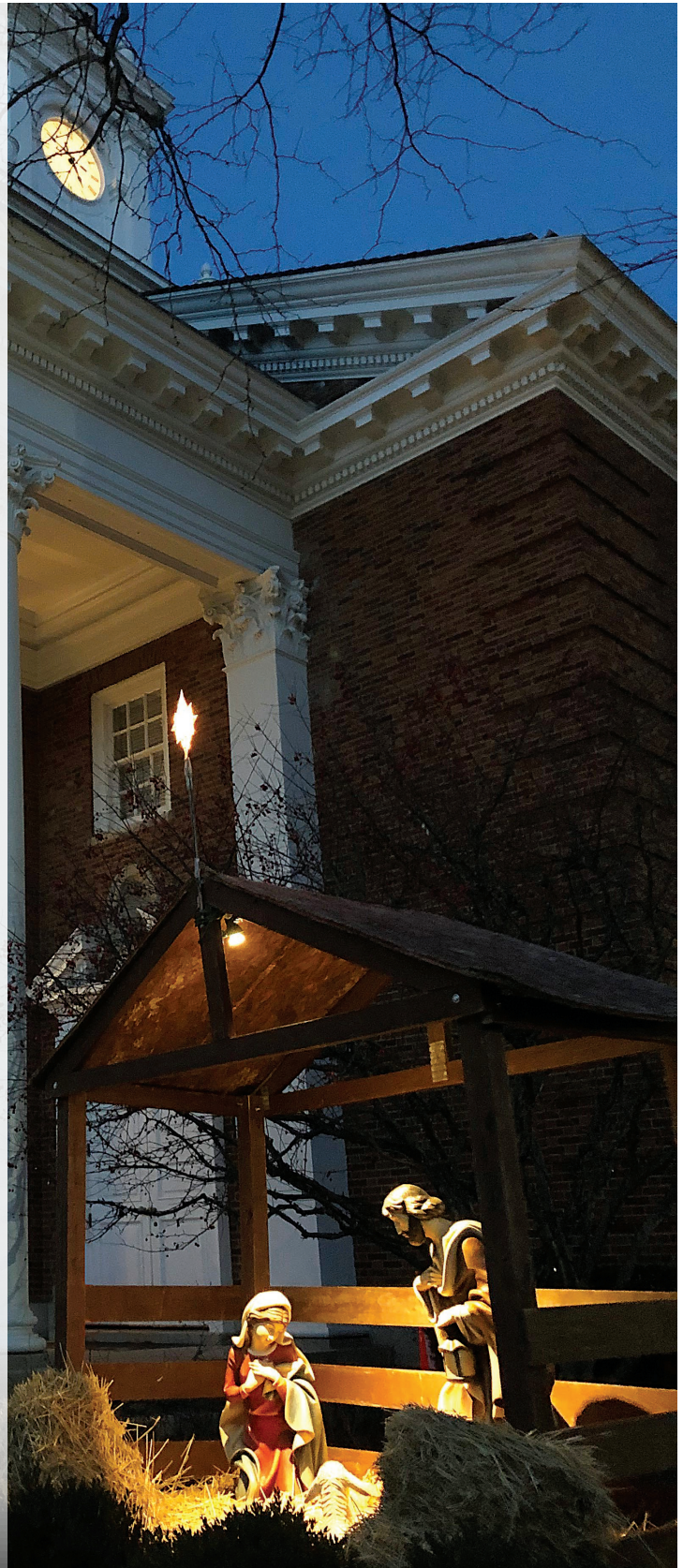

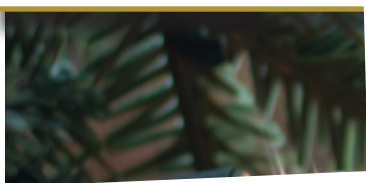
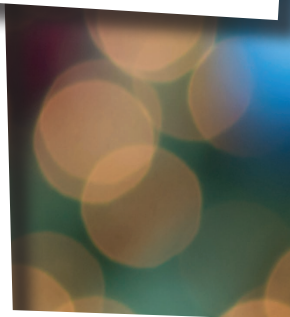
Christmas Celebration 2021

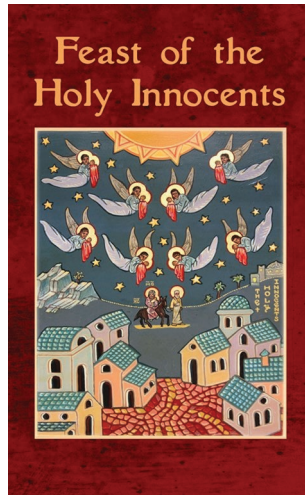
Hope and Healing Mass

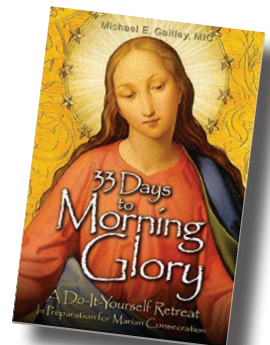

We are currently only accepting non-perishable food, but will also be taking in gently used, *in-season* clothing.
