Dear Parishioners,

"Brothers and Sisters: Put on, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another"

One of my favorite things about setting up for Christmas is the Nativity Scene or the creche. As the oldest of five, it was my responsibility each year to set up the family nativity set which was given to us by my grandmother who brought it with her from Ireland when she immigrated.

I have developed quite a devotion to the Nativity Scene first popularized by St. Francis of Assisi after he visited the Holy Land and wanted to acquaint Christians with the circumstances of Jesus' birth in Bethlehem. I have a very modest collection of Nativity Scenes.

This past year I acquired a real treasure. One of the sorrowful moments for us as a parish last year was the death of our pastor emeritus, **Fr. John Flavin**. Given the circumstances, only 10 people could attend his funeral. One of the powerful moments of last year were the hundreds of people that drove by the front of the Church after the funeral to pay their respects as his casket was placed on the front

steps of the Church with an honor guard of the Fr. Dussman Council of the Knights of Columbus.

When I would visit him at St. Benedicts, I would often comment on his beautiful Nativity Set that He displayed all year. Fr. Flavin was a man of few possessions, so it was prominent. Father Flavin was one of our first Anglo priests to learn Spanish to minister to the ever-growing number of Hispanic immigrants arriving in Chicago. He received a beautiful creche I am sharing with you that was given to him by a Mexican family that he had come to love. The last time I saw him before the quarantine he wanted me to have it because he knew how much I admired it. God Bless you Fr. Flavin, may you rest in peace! (See the front cover of this Bulletin for an image of this beautiful creche.)

A few months ago, I was part of a virtual pilgrimage to Naples, Italy, sponsored by the Shrine of Our Lady of Pompeii, in Little Italy here in Chicago, to observe the Feast Day of St. Gennario. Many parishioners participated in that Zoom pilgrimage. There is another Virtual Pilgrimage that I will be participating in on Jan. 2. This pilgrimage will invite us to return to Naples to explore the special place the Nativity Scene, or the "Presepio" as the Italian's call it, has on Italian culture. For centuries, the most spectacular nativity scenes are crafted in Naples by artisans who carry on their family's tradition of creating these beautiful images of the birth of Our Lord. (There is information on how to join the pilgrimage on page 3 of this Bulletin. It is a free event.)

The nativity scenes crafted in Naples go from the simple to the elaborate. There is a beautiful Neapolitan Creche at the Art Institute here in Chicago. They go from classic 18th century settings to the very contemporary. This year's most popular and I must add powerful is a crèche in which Joseph is a doctor and Mary is a Nurse, both cradling the flag of Italy to honor health care workers who have courageously attended to the Italian people during the pandemic. (Our health care workers here are needed to be honored as well!) 257 Italian doctors and 56 nurses have died from COVID-19 which they contracted from the patients to whom they were attending.

As we honor the Holy Family this weekend, we also honor and pray for our families. I began this weekly letter with a quote from this weekend's second reading. I think it should be clipped and affixed to a place like the refrigerator door, so everyone sees it.

Family life has been under so much stress this past year as families have had to cope with remote learning; parents and young adults working at home; illness and financial challenges. St. Paul offers such great wisdom as to how we should relate to one another. This passage could provide a powerful occasion for a family to meditate and reflect on how this past year has impacted them.

Our Christmas liturgies were a great blessing, both in person and virtually. Thank you for your patience, we all have had to adapt to so much.

I know many are dealing with end of the year tax issues. There are notable changes to IRS regulations due to COVID-19 and the CARES Act. You can take up to a \$300 charitable deduction for cash contributions. There are also other changes this year as a result of the CARES Act that impact other forms of giving. It is well worth looking into. (See page 8 of this Bulletin for more information.)

One of the wonderful moments of the Christmas celebration was the wonderful rendition of Silent Night by our choir. The rendition began with the singing of Silent Night in German to recall that very first Christmas here at OLPH when the parishioners sang "Stille Nacht, Heilige Nacht".

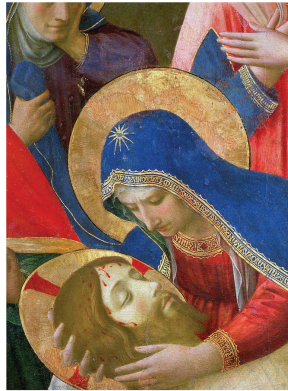

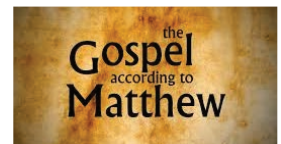

End of the Year Giving

Did you know that making a donation to OLPH before 12/31/20 may help lower your tax bill?

CARES Act changes for deducting charitable contributions made in 2020:

Taxpayers **who do not itemize their deductions** may take a charitable deduction of **up to \$300** in 2020 for donations made to qualifying organizations. OLPH is a qualifying organization, as it is a religious institution.

Taxpayers **who itemize their deductions**, in a normal year would be allowed to deduct donations of up to 60% of adjusted gross income (AGI); for 2020, a taxpayer can deduct donations **up to 100% of AGI**.

QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTIONS (QCDs):

Money from an individual retirement account (IRA) can be donated to OLPH. Normally a distribution from a traditional IRA incurs taxes since the account holder did not pay taxes on the money when they put it into the IRA. However, account holders 70 ½ or older who make a contribution directly from a traditional IRA to a qualified charity (OLPH) can donate up to \$100,000 without it being a taxable distribution. The QCD effectively lowers the donor's adjusted gross income (AGI).

In a normal year, such a transaction would satisfy the required minimum distribution (RMD) for someone 70 ½ or older. While the RMD requirement is waived for 2020, a QCD still offers the same tax benefits.

To avoid paying taxes on the donation, the donor must follow specific IRS tax rules for QCDs. This includes making the

distribution directly to OLPH, not the owner or beneficiary, with the check made payable to OLPH. If all the tax rules are not followed, the distribution will be counted as a taxable distribution.

OLPH must receive the donation by December 31 for the amount to be applied to your 2020 return.

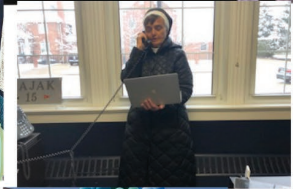

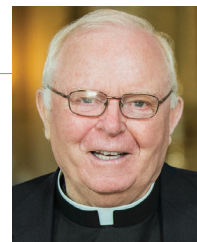

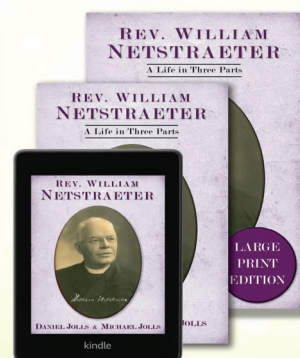
