Blessing of Easter Foods (Swieconka) 11:30 am

We invite you to join in **Swieconka**, the Slavic Easter celebration. In this service, foods traditionally eaten for breakfast on Easter Sunday are blessed.

Choose your favorite basket to fill with:

Eggs - a symbol of new life and the resurrected Christ

Ham - an acknowledgement of the New Law, putting aside the Old Law which forbade the eating of pork

Lamb - made of butter or cake dough, symbolizing Christ as the Sacrificial Lamb

Horseradish - a reminder of Christ's suffering and the bitter herbs offered Him on the cross

Salt - symbolizing wisdom needed in our daily lives

Bread - the essence of nourishment for our bodies and the appearance under which Christ is present
