Dear Parishioners,

Mother's Day Reflection

When I was little, I thought there was nothing my mom could not do, nothing she could not fix, nothing she could not make better. Of course, as I got older, I realized that even mothers have their limitations. And, it was when I gave birth to my own children that I found out mothers really don't have super powers after-all; instead, the force that drives us is the love we feel for our children—a love, I believe, that is closest to the love of God—unconditional and all-encompassing.

My mom passed away in October, so today I celebrate the first Mother's Day without her. There were times I felt that the world would cease to turn when my mother died and wondered how I would bear it. Yet, God gives us the strength we need even in our grief, and I know that my mom would want me to rejoice in each new day.

I remember the joy in giving birth to each of my children as well as the profound sense of responsibility I felt for this new little life I held in my arms. As mothers, we not only watch our children grow up, but we also watch them day-by-day grow away from us; we work so hard to give them strong roots, but they still have a way of sprouting wings and one day taking flight. Yet, that is the order of things, and it only means we did our job well.

Even Jesus told his mother, when she was beside herself with worry, that He had to be "about his Father's business." We are told that Mary pondered these things in her heart the way all mothers ponder, our hearts filled with worries, fears, expectations, and dreams for our children.

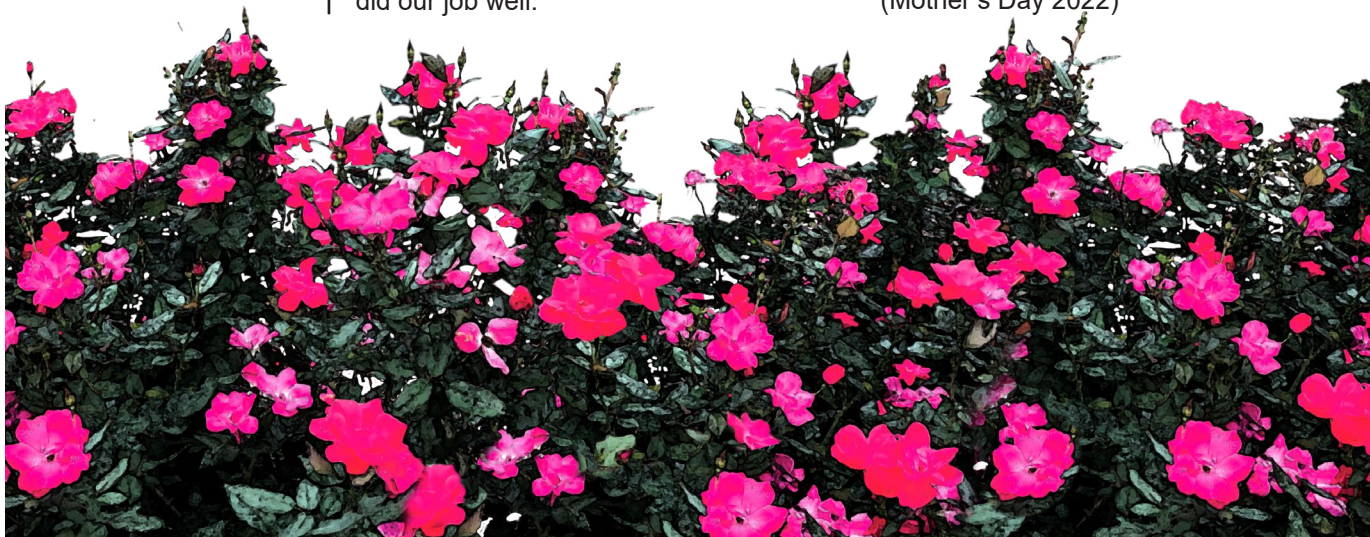
How frightened Mary must have been when Jesus left home to begin His ministry, so determined to set the world on fire with new ideas that many did not understand and would not accept. Despite her fears, however, she had to let Him go to fulfill his mission, to suffer humiliation, and to die on a cross. And it was Mary, His mother, who held her son in her arms for the first time in that stable in Bethlehem and for the last time beneath the cross on Calvary.

Mothers are the roses in God's garden.

Their love is limitless. Remember your Mom today in a special way. Even if she is no longer physically present, remember that spiritually she is still looking after you. And, mothers, treasure those hand-made cards with their drawings and poems, the breakfasts in bed even if the toast is burnt, and any and all surprises big and small that await you today. Honor and love your mothers everyone; for no one loves you like your mother.

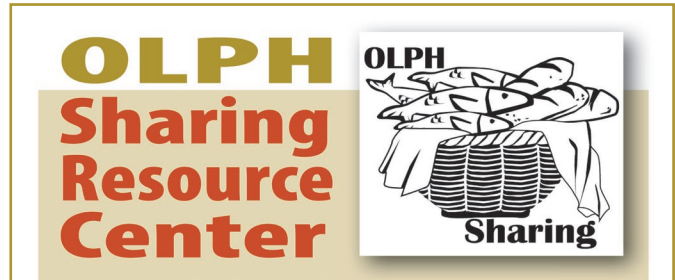

Volunteer Opportunity at St. James

Mobile Pantry at St. James The Sharing Ministry at OLPH is sponsoring a sharing project at our sharing parish St. James on Wabash. On Saturday, June 11 we are seeking volunteers to work at the St. James Food Pantry for assisting in the distribution of food from the Greater Chicago Food Depository.

Pantry clients have said that the foods they need the most are fresh fruits and vegetables. The Mobile Pantry is one way we respond to this need by distributing over 5000 lbs. of fresh produce to an average of 220 households in a span of two hours. The "mobile pantry" is set up in the parking lot adjacent to the St. James Parish Hall.

We plan to meet at St. James about 8:00 am.

You may drive on your own (2907 S Wabash Ave, Chicago), or meet at the OLPH parking lot by 7:15 am to carpool. Activities consist of packaging food items and distributing food bags to pantry clients.

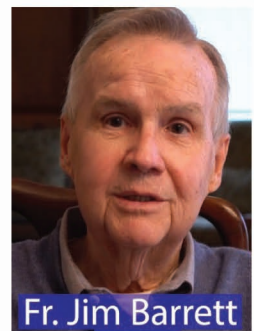
