Dear Parishioners,

"Be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving one another as God has forgiven you in Christ"

This weekend's passage from St. Paul's Letter to the Ephesians is chock full of wisdom on how to live an authentic Christian life. The Christian call to mercy, compassion and love runs so counter to the culture of criticism, self-righteousness and self-centeredness.

In the "my way or the highway" world, there is no room for the opinions or needs of others. I often wonder what wound or brokenness lies beneath the surface of a person who is overbearing, argumentative or self-centered. The pandemic has contributed as we know to a "fraying of nerves" as some lash out.

The vision of the Lord calls us to a very different place. The psalmist this weekend invites us to "taste and see the goodness of the Lord". We don't have to prove anything in the eyes of the Lord, we are all sacred vessels of his spirit and mission. Leave resentments and criticisms behind and embrace the peace and mercy that the Lord so generously bestows upon us.

We continue this marvelous reflection of the Eucharist this week, as the Lord explores the power of the Eucharist in the Gospel of John. "I am the bread of life." Receiving the Eucharist is the gift of God's love and mercy. It is not a reward for following the rules. Everyone of us is a sinner in need of God's mercy and love. What a power would be unleashed in the world if we could embrace the fact that we have been forgiven of our mistakes, our foibles, our poor choices.

Next Sunday, after the 9:00 a.m. Mass, we will dedicate our beautiful statue of the Blessed Mother in the Hellerman Garden. One of the great graces that was a source of such comfort was the ability to sit in that beautiful garden and to seek the intercession of the Blessed Mother as we all faced the challenges of the pandemic. I am always moved by the number of people who come to the garden each day. Some just park in front of the garden and pray as they gaze upon the Blessed Mother. During those months when the church was closed, the garden and image of Mary helped us to be connected.

We celebrate the generosity of all those who have made this beautiful place possible. Special thanks to **Terry Luc, Jen Farber, and Sally Corbett** that helped plan this celebration. There are many others who have helped make this celebration happen. Terry Luc has prepared a special booklet of prayers

to assist you in your visits to the Garden. We hope to update it annually given the treasure trove of appropriate prayers and devotions. The booklet will fit easily in a purse or pocket.

One of my favorite musicals is "Ragtime". One of the lyrics is, "we can never go back to before" I keep thinking this may be the theme of COVID. We just need to keep making adaptations to the virus as it continues to ravage the world. Considering recommendations from the Illinois Dept of Health, the CDC and the Cardinal's COVID task force; we are implementing measures to keep us all safe. We need for everyone to wear masks inside of any of our parish facilities. I know how frustrating this is but hopefully these measures will be effective. With school and fall programs right around the corner, I will keep you informed of any additional precautions. Thank you for your patience!

As we close the books on the recent fiscal year, I am grateful to so many that were of special assistance in helping us navigate the uncertainty of it all. Sun., Aug. 15, 2021

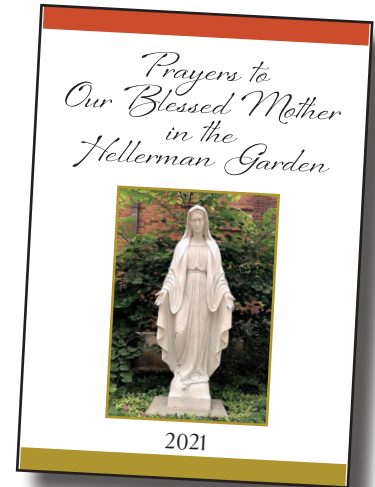
After 9:00 am Mass

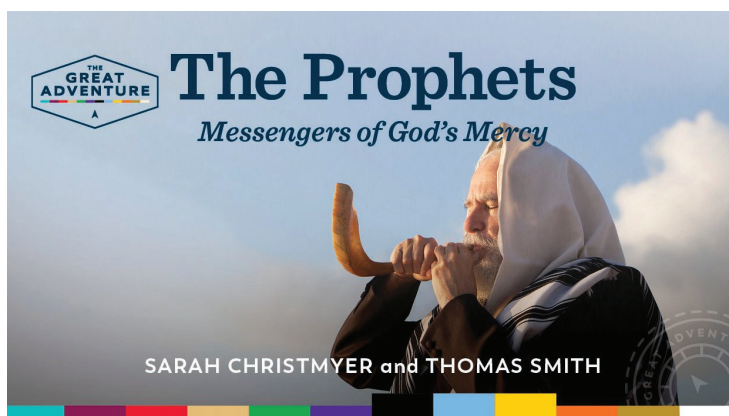

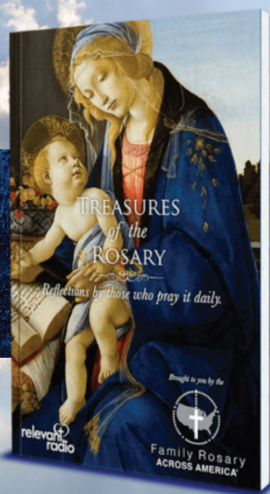
