Dear Parishioners,

"Master, to whom shall we go?

Our annual journey through "Bread of Life Discourse" in the Gospel of John concludes this weekend. Every year we are drawn more deeply into the mystery of the Eucharist.

As Jesus taught about the essence of the Eucharist, the bread becoming his body, the wine becoming his blood, many could not accept this teaching

and as the Gospel reports, they left his company. Jesus asks the twelve, "Do you want to leave?" Peter speaks for all of us, "Master to whom shall we go?"

Helping our next generation of young Catholics and families

Our Lady of Good Help - Champion, WI. USA

Lourdes, Fatima, Guadalupe and Champion, Wisconsin all are part of a select group of places worldwide where the Blessed Virgin Mary is believed to have appeared. She identified herself as "The Queen of Heaven who prays for the conversion of sinners." She appeared in October 1859 to a Belgian immigrant woman, Adele Brise, on the grounds of the

Champion Shrine. Adele became a catechist and Mary's words to Adele apply to us today.

"Gather the children in this wild country to teach them what they needed to know for their salvation: teach them their catechism and how to approach the sacraments. That is what I wish you to do. Go and fear nothing, I will help you." Our Lady of Good Help to Adele Brise, Catechist - Champion WI 1859.

Each year we continue to seek catechists to teach our parish children. We need catechists to teach our children for three different sessions for grades 4-year old Preschool through 8th grades: Tuesdays at 4:30 and 6:30pm and Saturdays at 9:00am for 75-minute sessions.

We provide comprehensive catechist training and ongoing formation, tools, and resources for all catechists. We also provide you the opportunity to grow in your own faith and sharing your faith with the children and families. You need only provide a willing heart and commit to teach for one year. Will you please join us?

OLPH parish provides religious education and sacramental preparation for children in grades 4-year-old preschool through 8th grade. OLPH RE Learning Models 2021-2022 In-Person Learning – Offering in-person and online instruction

1) In-Person Catechist Led-Student Classroom Model – Classes are led by a Catechist for the students in a classroom. Classes will be held on the days of the week set forth below for 75-minute sessions. Classes will be held onsite at OLPH Parish for 75-minute sessions beginning Tuesday, September 21 at 4:30 and 6:30pm and Sat., September 25 at 9:00am.

- Tuesdays at 4:30pm to 5:45pm
- Tuesdays 6:30pm to 7:45pm
- Saturdays at 9:00am to 10:15am
- In-Person Family Catechesis Model Groups of OLPH RE Families meet monthly on site for 75-minute sessions beginning Sun. Oct 3 at 10:30am and Fri. Oct 15 at 6:30pm. Parents are committed to work with their children to complete the student weekly lessons and submit assessments on the RE website.
- 3) NEW! RE Digital Ministry At-Home Family Catechesis Model - Parents are committed to teach their children at home with the tools and support of the RE Program under the guidance of the Director of Religious Education, Margaret Waldron. This is basically an online RE class for families. Children learn the same weekly lessons as the in-person students.

Parents are responsible to view the weekly video instructions and written instructions from Margaret Waldron, facilitate teaching their children the weekly lessons, and ensure that their children submit weekly homework and assessments thru the OLPH RE website. Students, who are also preparing for First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation, will be required to do the same additional study, assignments, meetings, retreats, and rehearsals as the in-person students.


