Dear Parishioners,

"Remain faithful to what you have learned and believed."

This weekend I am speaking at all the masses on stewardship. This weekend's readings speak of the gift of faith that has been entrusted to us. We need to be faithful stewards of this great gift.

The passage I quoted above comes from Paul's Second Letter to Timothy. We are compelled to proclaim the Word,

whether it is convenient or not. We must be persistent in our journey of faith.

The pandemic has placed enormous challenges on all of us. No one has escaped being impacted by months of isolation, unprecedented interruptions to our daily lives and significant anxieties as the pandemic has evolved.

Through it all, OLPH has been a place of refuge, encouragement, and hope. I reflected during my sabbatical on the extraordinary efforts, you the parishioners undertook to stay connected, to reach out to family and friends and to make great sacrifices to keep our parish financially stable.

I have seen firsthand that not even a global pandemic could stop us. We have explored such creative and heart-felt ways of meeting the challenges of the pandemic. That being said, the pandemic has taken its toll, and many are still sorting things out. Sociologists and psychologists will be studying for years the cumulative impact the pandemic has had.

Some months ago, the Archdiocese conducted an extensive survey and study entitled, "Faith Engagement in the Age of COVID." The survey was sent to a wide sample of Catholics and several intensive one on one conversations with people who have not yet returned to regular worship. Many of these were weekly attendees pre-pandemic and have yet to return. These conversations were helpful because we often talk to people who go to Church trying to understand those that do not.

The results confirmed a lot of my perceptions. Declining church attendance did not start with COVID. From 1990 to 2019 our October Counts revealed a 35% decline in weekly attendance at Mass among Catholics in the Archdiocese of Chicago. Since the pandemic and the reopening, Church attendance has declined 41% from the pre-pandemic levels.

The study determined there were three main reasons

people described for why they have not returned: continuing health concerns, getting out of the habit, and worship attendance not being convenient.

I also think that a lingering impact of the pandemic has been a malaise that affects a lot of people. When they say they are not ready to come back, there may be something deeper going on. Where is God, what is the point of community, I do not feel connected any more. As a wise person shared at a meeting recently, "people don't want to go back to work let alone go back to church." This malaise is affecting a lot of areas of our lives.

Here at the parish, we are exploring several ways to invite anyone who feels distant and has yet to come "home." We will be convening many kinds of events, many more social in nature to renew friendships. I will be attending a number of neighborhood "meet and greets" to celebrate our love of OLPH and to listen to your experiences and concerns.

In the survey the one powerful insight that came from the conversations with the disconnected is many people are searching to feel centered spiritually during this tumultuous time. They are just trying to sort out many feelings and experiences that have impacted their pre-covid life. They are not rejecting God or their faith.

Our Summit is in a few weeks; the theme will be "we are better together!"

If you have any thoughts or reflections on all this, I would love to hear from you.

All of this has impacted our financial health. We have experienced a decline in our offertory collections. As we rebuild our community, we must also stabilize our financial health.

Stewardship challenges us to reflect on how we share our time, talent, and treasure. OLPH's vitality has been built on generations of parishioners who faced many challenges to generously share their time, talent, and treasure.

We can look back at our past and see a parish that embraced the words of St. Paul, "Remain faithful to what you have learned and believed."

I have no doubt that people will look back at this time and celebrate the legacy of so many of you who have helped rebuild our parish.

Thank you from the bottom of my heart for your stewardship of this blessed parish.

Befriend a Family 2022-2023

Befriend-a-Family provides support to needy families at holiday times, with OLPH donors anonymously matched up with families in need within our four Sharing parish communities, St. Sabina's, St. Josephine Bakhita, St. James and Mother of the Americas. Support is also extended to local families and a more limited number of refugee families. Sponsors can be individuals, families or groups and choose the size family that works for them.



Our goal is to help close to 200 needy families through the program this year with gift cards for food at Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter and additionally providing gifts, or gift cards for gifts, at Christmas.

We ask donors to give careful consideration to the size family they wish to take on. We suggest donations of \$50 - \$100 per person for food for each holiday and additionally suggest donations of \$75 - \$200 for gifts per person at Christmas. Sponsor a family of one, two, three, or more. We'll match you with the family size you choose. We will provide you with a limited profile of the family we match to you.

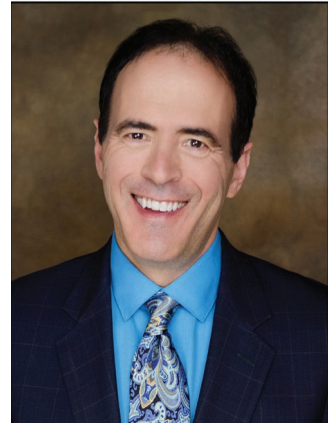

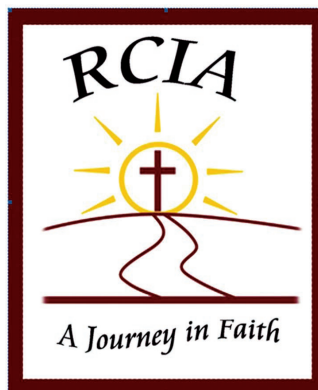
