Dear Parishioners,

"The Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve."

The mandate to serve in the footsteps of the Lord is a challenge that is often put before us. True servanthood demands that we continually move beyond our selves and reach out to others.

Our culture feeds into selfcenteredness all the time. Most

advertising has a pleasure/reward message that we deserve the very best. Our political discourse dissolves into people screaming at each other rather than listening. We can't conceive that there might be another viewpoint worth listening to.

Some time ago I had a rather heated conversation with a person who was basing their anger on wrong information. Every time I attempted to point out the misinformation, I was continually dismissed by the phrase, "I don't want to hear about that". Nothing like letting the facts get in the way of a good argument!

To be willing to be a true servant we must see life in terms of we and us rather than they and them. One of the great blessings of a parish is it keeps calling us to see beyond our own world to the larger world.

I remember studying the great psychoanalyst Eric Fromm who described developing the skill of empathy as essential to our emotional well being. The ability to understand and share the feelings of another.

Empathy is also essential to being a servant of the Lord. One of my mentors was Cardinal Bernardin whose episcopal motto was, "As those who serve". By the way this November will mark the 25th anniversary of his death.

One of the great sources of our parish's commitment to empathy is our Sharing Room. It has been closed because of COVID but will soon be reopening. Watch the Bulletin for details.

Another opportunity to exercise empathy is in our appreciation of the environment. When Pope Francis issued his encyclical, "Laudato Si", our care for our common home, he addressed the encyclical to the whole world. We all have a responsibility to care for creation

and to have empathy for those who suffer so profoundly because of the greed and recklessness of some that is puting us all at risk.

This coming Friday we are really looking forward to the visit of Cardinal Cupich and His Eminence Metropolitan Nathanael of the Greek Orthodox of Chicago to lead us in the solemn vespers to pray for the care of creation. The prayer begins at 7 p.m. This will be an historic meeting of the leaders of the Catholic and Orthodox communities of Chicago. Pope Francis and the Ecumenical Patriarch **Bartholomew** have worked very closely in their advocacy of protecting our environment.

If you would like to do something practical to clean up the environment, why not join, "The Fall River Cleanup" to clear trash and invasive plant life in the area around the Techny Basin. I have been on cloud nine all week trying to process all the energy around my 40th celebrations last weekend. To Mike Hrvojevic and our maintenance staff I am deeply grateful. To several of our students from the school who helped, thank you! To the Men's Club you are always there! Sr Paulanne as always holds the whole thing together! I will be forever grateful. I will be leaving for retreat this week and hold all of you in prayer.





Aid for Women and The Women's Center, who counsel and support mothers considering abortion. Financial and material support for these women has continued without interruption throughout the Covid crisis.




