

Dear Parishioners,

"Christ will appear a second time to bring salvation to those who eagerly await him". (Heb 9: 27)

These final weeks of the liturgical year invite us to take a view of the big picture, the direction we hope to head ultimately. As the Feast of Christ the King approaches, we will hear many biblical references to the end times. How are we positioning ourselves to receive the Lord at his second coming.

November begins with such power as we venerate the memory of the communion of saints and the memory of our beloved dead on the Feast of All Souls. These feasts remind us that the saints did not descend on the earth from a planet from a distant galaxy. They have emerged in our midst and grounded their lives in witnessing to God's mercy and love. As we recall the memory of our beloved dead, we are reminded that our time on earth is fleeting. We must make the most of the blessing of every day.

The readings this weekend are so rich, our acts of kindness, generosity and charity return a thousand-fold in blessings. The witness of the widows in this weekend's readings reminds us that in God's eyes we all matter.

"Vita brevis, via est longa"

I came back this week from my annual retreat which was three years off schedule because of COVID. I was visiting in Rome and retreating in Assisi.

One of my favorite pastimes in Rome is getting lost in the labyrinth of ancient streets. Even lifelong Romans lose their way. Every street reveals another secret, another treasure. I know just enough Latin to get in trouble! I like to translate the Latin inscriptions on these ancient buildings. I came across one afternoon a profound inscription I discovered on an old temple. The Latin phrase as best as I can translate means, "Life is short, the journey is long".

As I find myself marking the 40th anniversary of my priesthood, this saying has relevance. In one sense, the 40 years have flown by in the twinkling of an eye, in another sense I get overwhelmed recalling the myriad of experiences and people I have shared the journey with.

About every 25 years the Pope declares a year of jubilee, a year of celebration, of being on pilgrimage, of being spiritually healed. My spiritual director suggested I celebrate a jubilee year of thanksgiving for my priesthood. And so, I have! I still am deeply moved by the celebration in October. I thank all of you for your encouragement, your affirmation, your presence in my life. I will never forget this kindness.

I planned a "Jubilee Retreat". I started out with a bang! Many years ago I visited the Zugspitze, which is the highest peak in the Austrian/German Alps. You feel like you are about as close to heaven this side of the ledger. I discovered a chapel there that was consecrated by **Pope Benedict** when he was the Archbishop of Munich in May of 1981, the month and year of my ordination 40 years

ago. I decided I would celebrate a mass of thanksgiving here if I made it to my 40th. Well, I did and in my mass of thanksgiving, I prayed for all of you!

Assisi has captivated my spiritual imagination for many years. Francis in the eyes of many is the most consequential Christian since the Apostolic Era. He came to live at a time of violence, corruption on all levels, a spiritually bankrupt church. From this hilltop town in the 1100's he would lead a purification of the Church. In just a few years after his death, hundreds and hundreds would leave everything to form Franciscan communities everywhere. I had a moving experience praying in the place he wrote, "Laudato Si" his canticle of praise for creation.

It was a retreat of long walks, beautiful liturgies. I was able to zoom my spiritual director and visit with English speaking Friars at the Basilica. It was a great experience, and I was blessed to be there.

When I was in Rome, I had a wonderful dinner with some priests at the North American College. Had a great visit with **Fr. Edward Linton OSB**, who is the director of the sabbatical program. Many of you may remember him when he was the pastor of our Sharing Parish, Old St. James. He shared with me his gratitude for the enormous support he felt from OLPH through our outreach. He mentioned how much he appreciated **Tom and Linda Rinella**.

Well back to reality! I heard wonderful things about The Solemn Vespers with **Cardinal Cupich**. The Trunk or Treat event was sensational. Not even the rain could stop this celebration of Halloween.

Please review the many options in the bulletin to reach out to others. Like everything, supply chains are interrupted that effect everyone. Guild 30's Food Drive, the Men's Club coat drive, the Befriend a family program are just a few of the ways we can help those who suffer so much.

I am always grateful for the financial support that the parish receives especially considering the pandemic that has had such an impact on our community. We are running behind in our budget for collections. If you can "catch up" we will bridge the gap!

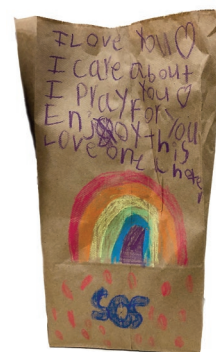

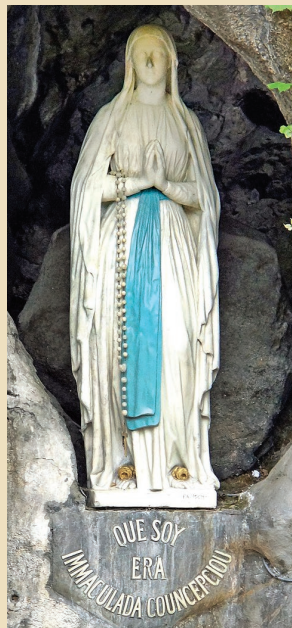

Drive-In Mass Update: Safety Issues

Now that that seasons are changing, our priests and lectors will be moving inside for the Saturday evening Drive-In Mass. Parishioners will be able to view them from the third floor windows in the Parish Center.

The darkness will also mean that car drivers must be extra mindful of our priest and Eucharistic Ministers as they walk through the parking lot and deliver communion.

To all drivers, please:

- 1) Be mindful of priests/ministers on both sides of the car.
- 2) Put the car in PARK while receiving communion.
- 3) Check to make sure everyone in the car has finished receiving communion and be especially aware of anyone receiving communion in the back seat.
- 4) Look and see that the priest/minister has stepped back and away from your car before putting your car back in gear.
- 5) Only then, proceed forward and exit the parking lot.

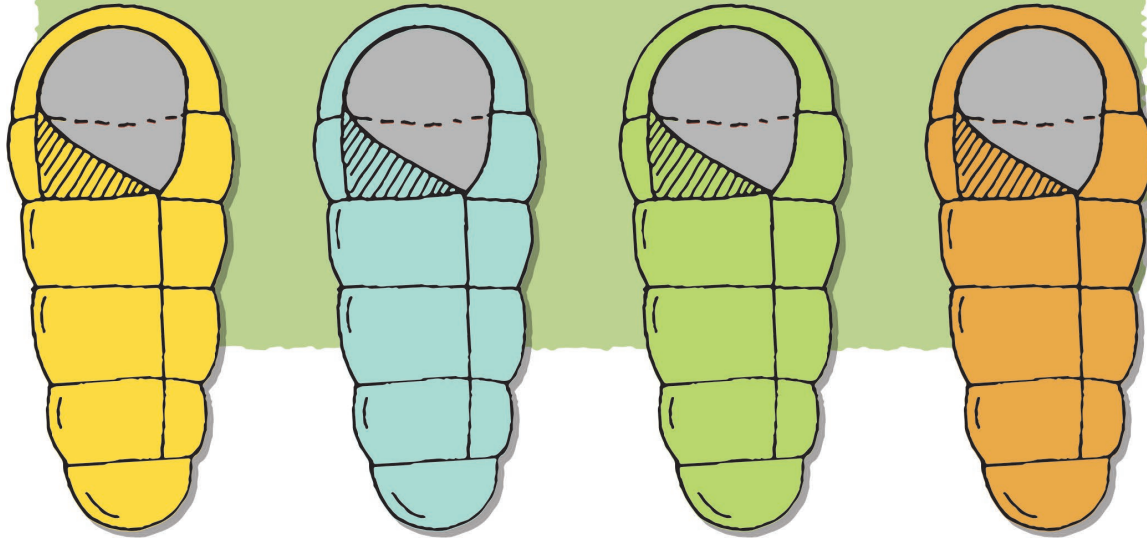

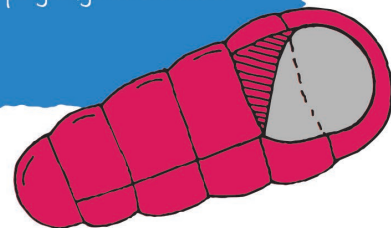

End of Year Giving

Please consider making a QCD gift to our parish

Making a gift from your IRA can benefit you and our parish. An IRA charitable rollover, also known as a qualified charitable distribution (QCD), allows individuals age 70½ or older to authorize their IRA administrator to

make a direct transfer of funds from their IRA to qualified charities, tax-free.

There are three main benefits of giving with a QCD:

- (1) If you are 72 years old or older, the amount you transfer can satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution.
- (2) The amount transferred directly to charity does not generate taxable income, which may reduce your annual income level. This may help lower your Medicare premiums and decrease the amount of Social Security that is subject to tax.
- (3) Your gift will be immediately used, allowing you to see the impact of your gift now.

If you wish to have your QCD gift qualify for the current tax year, we recommend submitting your request to your IRA administrator by December 1st.
