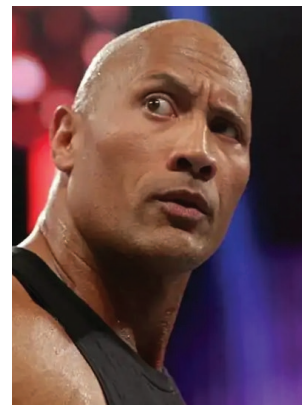
## Scripture Study Ministry
