"Your light has come"

As the Christmas season draws to a close, we are left to reflect on the power of light. The light that only Jesus can bestow. The Magi followed the Star of Bethlehem to pay him homage, the prophet Isaiah speaks of the radiant light of the glory of the Lord.

We all must contend with various forces of darkness. We have the physical reality of less daylight and longer nights.

There are spiritual and emotional sources of darkness that can be quite challenging. We have setbacks and disappointments. We need to face the reality of chronic illness or the death of a loved one. In life stuff happens that can be hard to navigate and accept.

The promise of Christmas is the reassurance of Christ's presence and love for us. Christ walks with us because he is Emmanuel, God with us! Our God does not sit in a lofty throne somewhere far away. He is right there to reach out to us, to comfort and to walk with us. In the coming year, we will follow again his earthly journey that will culminate with his passion, death and resurrection.

Each year on the Feast of Epiphany there is a proclamation of the coming feasts of the liturgical year because, Easter is a movable feast that effects many celebrations. I have included this proclamation below:

Know, dear brothers and sisters, that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior.

On the twenty-second day of February will fall Ash Wednesday. And the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.

On the ninth day of April, you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ.
On the twenty first day of Maywill be the Assention of

On the twenty-first day of May will be the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the twenty-eighth day of May, the feast of Pentecost. On the eleventh day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On the third day of December, the First Sunday of the Advent of Our Lord Jesus Christ. To whom is honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen!

We have much to look forward to!

This past week marked the death of **Pope Emeritus Benedict**. He spent much of his life in Rome. He was the Prefect of the Congregation of Faith under **St. John Paul II**. He was a brilliant theologian and one of the great influences on the study and formation of theology. He was a noted theologian and author. He spent much of his theological study on the implications of the Second Vatican Council that recently marked its 60th anniversary.

Pope Benedict followed gregarious and formable John Paul the Second. Pope Benedict was a scholar and very introspective. He was a prayerful and humble person. During his reign he had to face the scourge of the sexual abuse scandal. The Vatican itself had several financial scandals and other problems.

Probably his greatest act of humility was to resign from the papacy realizing he could not keep up with it all. This act of love for the larger good of the Church has had a profound impact. I was blessed to meet him several times and attended audiences and liturgies he presided over. He was an exceptional homilist and brought a real love to the celebration of the eucharist. He was born in Bavaria, and like me, he had a brother who was a priest. As a young person he had to endure the devastation of World War II. May he rest in peace.

We have been extremely pleased with the results. Some of the features include:


- · A much cleaner and more modern 2-column layout.
