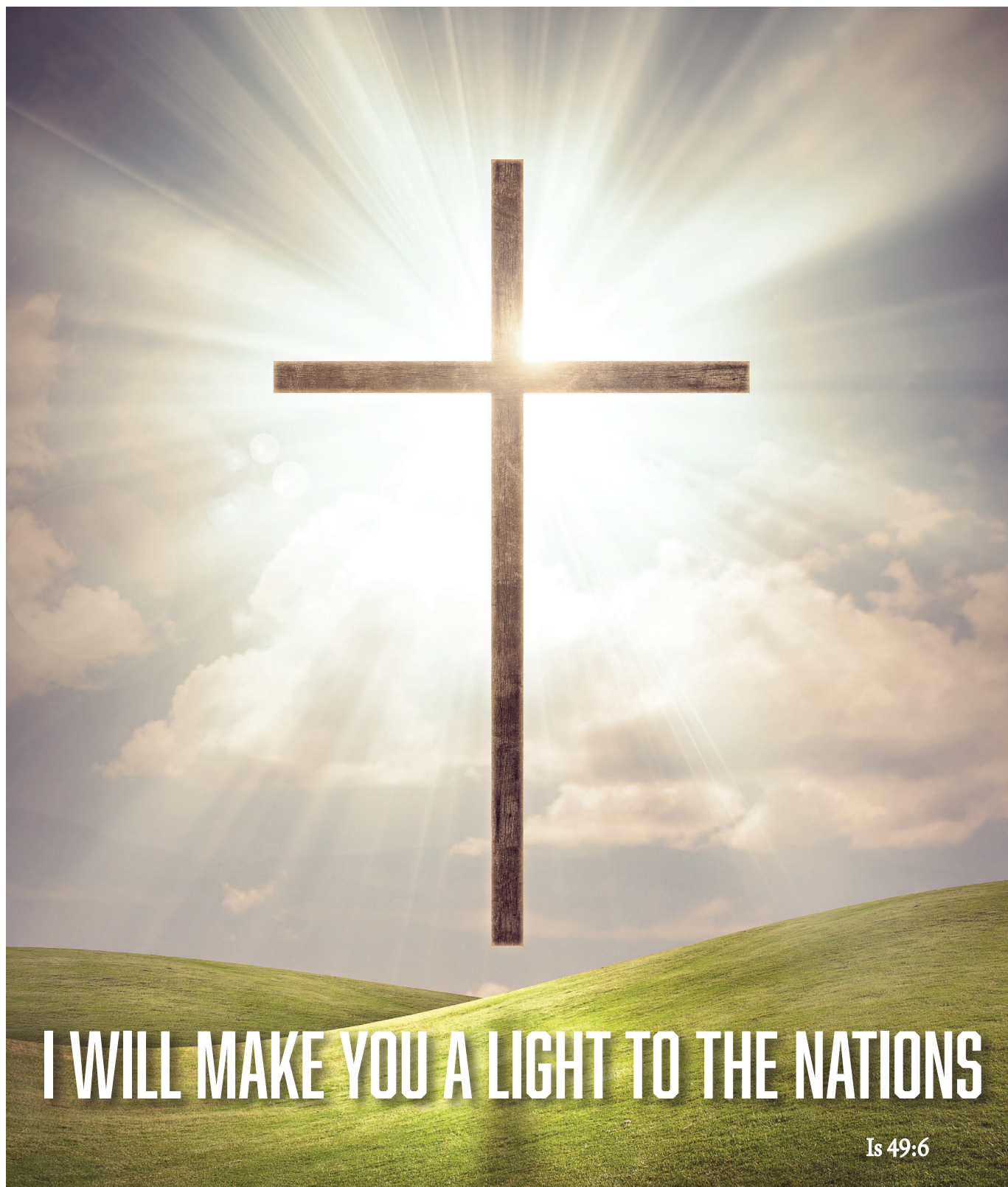

"I will make you a light to the nations"

The early weeks of a new year are always filled with hope and anticipation. We all wonder, what lies ahead?

Other than Jesus getting lost and being found in the temple, there is nothing in the gospels from his childhood to the beginning of his public ministry. It is John the Baptist in this weekend's

gospel that recognizes and testifies that Jesus is the Son of God, the long awaited Messiah. Those around John the Baptist must have wondered, what lies ahead for Jesus?

We now begin the annual journey of better understanding what was in store for the Lord. We will follow him through the Judean countryside, the Sea of Galilee and eventually to Jerusalem. What will lie ahead for us spiritually as we meditate again on his teachings, his miracles his witness to the love and mercy of God.

"I will make you a light to the nations" is the prophecy we hear from Isaiah this weekend. We need to be reminded of the power of the Lord's light, his challenge to testify to the good and to avoid the grip of sinfulness and negative thinking.

We are bearers of the light! We testify to hope, to those who witness to love, to seek mercy and affirm. These are counter cultural values in a culture that thrives on gossip and criticism.

As the Christmas Season concluded last week, I couldn't help but see the impact of the power of "being a light". It was reflected in the beautiful liturgies, the amazing crowds, the amazing generosity that brought light and hope to many people in need.

There are many challenges facing the church in this time of Covid. The pandemic has left in its tracks many emotional and spiritual questions. We see many people reviewing their life choices, the implications of situations in their past, reassessing priorities. These are critical sources of reflection. I hope in the coming months through our many efforts here at OLPH we will be a supportive force in your life.

What was so wonderful has been to see the large

numbers of people attending mass these past several weeks. We are seeing numbers that assure me that the Eucharist feeds us like nothing else! When we physically worship together, we indeed become, "a light to the nations". We will continue to invite everyone, come join us at the Lord's table.

OLPH has such a great history of being a light to others. I recently received a wonderful letter from **Fr. Tom Belanger**, the pastor of St. Josephine Bakhita parish. We have been in a sharing parish relationship with that community for almost 40 years. He was so grateful for the many ways we support them. We have been blessed over the years by that community.

In recent years we have been supporting several refugee families in collaboration with Catholic Charities. Talk about being a "light to the nations"! Each family we have supported has become self sufficient and thriving in the possibilities this country can offer. We will soon be sponsoring a family from Ukraine. I am grateful to **Tom Hart** who coordinates our parish outreach.

One way to be a brighter "light", is to better appreciate the scripture. We will soon be launching another semester of Scripture Study. This coming semester will study the Letters of Peter, James and Jude.

We are always looking for candidates for the Permanent Diaconate. We have been blessed by many deacons and their wives over the years. If you would like to explore this possibility, please give me a call. I would also encourage you to reach out to Deacon **Jim Revord** and his wife **Pat**. They exemplify the rewarding impact this ministry can have. Please continue to pray for Deacon **Dave Kalina** who has faced many health struggles in the past few years. **Deacon Christopher** ministers at Benet Academy in Lisle as well as here.

Another source of hope are our seminarians. It was terrific to have our parishioner **Luke Lato** spend part of his Christmas holidays at the Rectory and assisting us. He is a student at Mundelein. Our teaching parish seminarians, **Charlie Leidel** and **Matthew Makarewicz** have been such a blessing.

Our liturgies have really been growing and this puts new challenges on us having enough lectors, Eucharistic ministers and greeter/ushers.
