"Overshadowed by death, light has arisen."

Moving from the Christmas season into the early weeks of the New Year, we continue to meditate on the power of light. We can easily be overshadowed by the forces of death and darkness.

Every morning we awaken to the latest atrocities of the war

in Ukraine. The horrific loss of innocent life and the devastation that results from the unrelenting bombing is heartbreaking. During my sabbatical, I spent time in the beautiful country Croatia. That part of the world suffered in the early 90's from a catastrophic war that left much of the countries involved in ruins. Now, over 30 years later there are remnants of the war that still affect the survivors emotionally and wreckage that has yet to be removed.

The issues surrounding the southern border and the teaming numbers of migrants and refugees is a complex issue with many layers of political and ethical concerns. We go to our "political" corners and in a sense shout at each other, we seem incapable of looking together at the root causes of such immense suffering. I guess I am naïve but this reality, which does not simply affect our Southern border, is a reality faced in Europe, the Middle East, Africa, and Asia. This crisis requires a more global response. The dictatorships and authoritarian regimes that wreak such havoc threaten the security of us all.

Gun violence plagues American society. Every day the death toll of innocent victims increases and the inability of our society to address this violence grows.

There is the reality that we can be overshadowed by the reality of death.

"The people who sit in darkness have seen a great light."

The words of the prophet Isaiah are so inspiring this weekend. Matthew recalls them in this weekend's gospel passage because people at the time of Our Lord were no strangers to the forces of darkness and death. The

Jews lived in an occupied country, Jesus himself was a political refugee as a child, Jesus himself would be a victim of outrageous violence and humiliation.

We together are children of the light by virtue of our baptism. There are no easy solutions to the "overshadowing" forces of darkness and death. Roman occupation did not just disappear, the hopelessness of poverty and discouragement were ever present. The followers of Jesus have sought, in each generation, the forces of light and hope. Each generation since the birth of Our Lord have sought a more peaceful, merciful and loving world.

While dwelling on the forces of darkness and death are real, we are surrounded also by the forces of light and hope. Our efforts to sponsor a family from Ukraine, supporting the efforts of Catholic Charities to respond to the growing numbers of refuges in our metropolitan community from the Southern Border, encouraging efforts to respond to urban violence that afflicts our sharing parishes are tangible ways of being bearers "of the great light".

The Gospel always challenges us to leave our comfort zones. We must continually be open to the ways the Gospel is asking us to look honestly at the religious implications our faith have on real issues. Some would like to keep a wall around the gospel but we know that never works. Jesus from the get-go was immersed in the world he lived in.

The light of Jesus has arisen!

Next weekend begins Catholic Schools Week. We will have special celebrations at the 9:00 and 10:30 Masses. There will be an open house at the school next weekend and a week of wonderful activities.

Please remember in your prayers the father-in-law of our Director of Facilities, **Mike Hrvojevic**, **Milan Bravac**. May he rest in peace.

May your week be filled with light!

Stewardship Report

To all parishioners:

We cannot thank you enough for your on-going generosity and continued support during the year!!! As a Parish Community, you have contributed \$1,402,327 in the General Offertory Sunday collections for the six months ending December 31, 2022. In addition, our Christmas collection stands at \$257,744 through this same period, although we have continued to receive additional gifts into January.

You can see from the charts presented below that we are in a slightly better position than we were in the six month period through December 2021, and very close to our cumulative budget for the six months of this fiscal year. Our Catch Up Sunday appeal, which is part of the cumulative Sunday figures, has generated \$166,765, thus far.

The months of January and February, historically, produce lower collection results and we ask for your continued support, especially during these months. Please refer to GiveCentral information found in this bulletin for an easy way to donate on-line, should you be interested in that method of donating to OLPH. Also, it is never too late to fill out the Planned Offertory Commitment Form which you can find on our newly refreshed and updated Website or simply click the QR code following this article.

There is another bit of good news to share – The 2022 Annual Catholic Appeal is close to completion and funds raised over the parish goal will be rebated back to parishes during March. While we lagged a bit during the year, as we approached November, we finally reached and exceeded our goal of \$215,690. The report through December 19 indicates amounts paid to date of \$250,000. The funds we

expect to receive will go a long way towards funding the recarpeting of our Church! Thank you also for your generosity in this very important Archdiocesan fundraising effort.


As one year's Appeal ends, another is set to begin. The theme of the Archdiocesan Annual Catholic Appeal for 2023 is **Walking On The Road With Jesus**. The goal for OLPH this year is slightly lower than last year's, as our offertory income was lower in FY22 than in FY21. Our goal is \$193,403, which is 7% of our FY22 offertory income, and, as in years past, anything received over our goal will be forwarded to the parish.

You may have already received a pledge envelope in the mail – please be generous. Proceeds from this campaign are used for many Archdiocesan services from which parishes can benefit in various ways. Watch for further information coming up over the next few weeks, as we near Commitment Weekend of February 11-12.




