"Walking on the road with Jesus"

I recently read **Paul Cousineau's** classic book, "The Art of the Pilgrimage." A marvelous spiritual reflection on the reality that from the moment of our birth we begin a journey. A journey that will take us to places we never imagined or planned. A journey of encounter as we grow and evolve out of the experiences of life.

This journey must be marked by the desire to keep moving forward despite our inner resistance to change. In the book the author quotes St. Augustine, "Solvitur ambulando. It is solved by walking." The challenges and blessings of life can be faced with vigor and resolve if we keep walking forward in faith. This journey is deeply influenced by the grace we encounter.

Pope Francis has called the entire Church to become "synodal", that is to journey together with the Lord prompted by the Holy Spirit. We are all together on a journey with the Lord. Whether we live in the South Sudan where he recently visited or Glenview, we share a common desire to "walk on the road with Jesus." Our circumstances are different but on a deeper level we are sojourners.

For the past few weeks we have been reflecting on the Sermon on the Mount, considered by many scholars to be Jesus greatest homily. From the presentation of the Beatitudes, to his reflection on the power of light to miracle of the loaves and fishes, we are instructed to be generous in being bearers of the light. This witness takes many forms over the journey of life, a lifetime of walking with the Lord.

One of the greatest threats to the proclamation of the Good news is the reality of isolation. The vulnerability of being isolated is overwhelming and disheartening. The recent experience of the pandemic has taught me how essential it is that we need to walk together in mutually supportive ways.

I think of a day in the life of OLPH as a case statement on this point. In the course of any day, we celebrate the Eucharist, our children are being formed in our Religious Education program or in our school. The hungry are fed, the homebound visited, the spiritual lives of our community attended to.

This weekend is Commitment Weekend for the Annual Catholic Appeal. This year's theme is appropriately, "Walking on the Road with Jesus." As a Catholic community many needs and concerns are brought to us on many levels, from those here in Glenview to the larger Church. This weekend we are being ask to consider our support for the church of the Archdiocese of Chicago. We are asked to share our resources in supporting the larger outreach of the church into the larger metropolitan community and beyond.

This weekend we are invited to consider supporting financially the mission of the larger church. Your support of the Appeal supports low income parishes in the Archdiocese, the formation of future priests, Catholic Relief Services, the spiritual and faith formation initiatives that benefit us all and many diocesan wide ministries.

All of these investments result in insuring a "walk" with the Lord that will spread the power and influence of the Good News of Jesus Christ. This weekend we will have the opportunity to participate in an in-pew process to consider supporting the Appeal. I know many of you have received materials in the mail and may have already participated.

This year's goal for OLPH is \$193,403. The goal is based on a percentage of our annual Sunday offerings. In recent years we have not only met our goal but have exceeded it. Excess money raised stays in the parish. We have pooled the past few years surplus funds to replace our Church carpet that has been long overdue for replacement. We will be able to pay for this out of our Appeal income without having to go into our savings. Thank you!! You can imagine how expensive a commercial grade carpet for the size of the Church costs.

If we surpass this year's goal, we would like to replace the Church Bells. Our current system is obsolete, and we cannot find parts to repair it. A new system will allow us to ring the bells at noon and at 6:00 pm for the Angelus, mark the hours, there are special bells that are rung for weddings, funerals, and Church feast days. The new system has bluetooth technology and could for instance be used by the police to warn our neighbors of a weather related disaster or other crises through the public speakers.






