seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...



Dear Parishioners,

"I am the living bread."

This weekend we rejoice in the annual celebration of Corpus Christi, The Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. We renew our belief in the centrality of the Eucharist in the life of the Church.

The pandemic has left a lot of collateral damage in its wake. After 2 years of serious restrictions to counter the devastating consequences of Covid 19, churches were closed, and the reception of the Eucharist was limited. Preceding the pandemic, weekly attendance has been in a serious decline for many years. Several polls of Catholics indicate the loss of belief in the Real Presence, many Catholics having no idea what transubstantiation means, many not seeing the point of going to Mass.

The Bishops of the United States have invited the Church to enter a period of Eucharistic Revival. Now is the time to renew our eucharistic life. Now is the time to form ourselves in the redemptive gift of the Body and Blood of Our Lord.

This past year, dioceses all over the country have been preparing programs and resources. The Revival this weekend moves to the parish level. We will have several events, liturgies and presentations to celebrate the coming year of Eucharistic Revival. The year will conclude next July with a Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis. It will be the first Eucharistic Congress on US soil in 40 years.

If you go to the bishop's web site; www.usccb.org you can read their wonderful pastoral letter on the Year of Eucharistic Revival, entitled; "The Mystery of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church". There are also many resources recommended. I would also highly recommend Bishop Barron's book; 'This is my Body, A call to Eucharistic Revival". Bishop Barron writes clearly and passionately about the theological and biblical foundations for the Eucharist.

In the coming months we are planning, a teaching mass, theological and pastoral presentations on the

eucharist, special liturgies celebrating the mass and opportunities to expand participation in the Eucharistic ministries of ministers of communion, greeter/ushers and lectors. We will be training several of our teens in Youth Ministry to serve as liturgical ministers. As I continue my neighborhood Meet and Greets, I will offer to celebrate Mass. We have a rich treasury of Eucharistic devotions but if we are not regularly receiving the Eucharist at Mass, those devotions have little meaning.

I am grateful to Guild 9 who presented college gift baskets to all the students from Our Lady of Tepeyac who graduated from their high school. Over \$10,000 was raised to present these young women with many of the things they will need as they prepare to move to college.

Thanks to the students of OLPH School who raised over \$5000 for Our Lady of Perpetual Help School in Puerto Rico. This money was raised as part of their Lenten Alms giving project in which they collected coins. This gift will help this very poor school upgrade their technological and curriculum needs. The kids just love that both our schools are under the patronage of Our Lady of Perpetual Help. All that change sure adds up! Thank you for the sacrifices for our sister school in Puerto Rico.

I am grateful to you for your support in our efforts to receive and support refugees and asylum seekers. We have received three families from Ukraine. Recently **Sr. Paulanne**, **Tom Hart**, and I were deeply touched by a plaque of gratitude from the Valko family who are beyond grateful for the support they have received (see page 3 of this Bulletin). They have a special needs child and had to desperately get her to a place a safety. They are all doing well and adjusting given the trauma they have had to deal with since the war broke out.

Just a reminder the 5:00pm Sunday evening Mass concludes on Sunday, June 25 and will resume on Sunday, September 17.



OLPH supports the health and well-being of our priests by contributing to the Priests' Health and Retirement/PRMAA collection for the benefit of their healthcare and retirement needs. We do this as part of our parish First Fruits Program, instead of taking up a second collection.




