

seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...



Dear Parishioners,

"Jesus' heart was moved with compassion."

The gospel this weekend is rich in its implications for us as believers. The mission that we are being called to serve has not a theoretical but very practical focus.

Fr. Jerry Boland, Pastor The word compassion means to go where it hurts. Most of us avoid going where it hurts at all costs! At the root of many addictions is the desperate efforts a person may undertake to avoid pain or suffering in their lives. The source of this pain can be physical, but it can also be emotional and spiritual.

Jesus saw firsthand the suffering that is caused by being abandoned or troubled. He saw the needs as immense and the "laborers" to face this challenge as few. He sent the twelve apostles out into the field to proclaim the Good News and to plant a rich harvest of future disciples.

A parish has a tremendous mission to follow in the footsteps of those who have gone before us proclaiming the Good News and healing those who are in pain. **Pope Francis** often uses the image of the Church as a field hospital, reaching out to those whose burdens and sufferings are great.

Many of our ministries are intended to bring hope and healing. Recently at the Masses we encouraged people to connect homebound or infirm parishioners with our Ministry of Care. We have several Ministers of Care who would love to visit, bring the Eucharist and connect with parishioners. Please contact the office if you know of someone who is interested in a visit.

We are blessed to have a social worker on campus three days a week. **Sr. Anna Thottunkal** who is on the staff of Catholic Charities. She has many resources and can help connect people with from Catholic Charities and Sr. Paulanne's Needy Family Fund. Anything from mental health concerns to personal struggles to financial challenges she can be a great help in referring people.

Please remember the repose of the soul of Sr. Anna's father who passed away this week in India.

Sr. Paulanne's Needy Family Fund is a great tribute

to her and the generosity of our parishioners to assist families in need. Our Sharing Ministry is in its 41st year of building bridges of compassion and care for our four Sharing Parishes. Every week, a tremendous amount of food and other items go to food pantries and social centers.

Every year, the Women's Club and the Men's Club sponsor drives that collect everything from winter coats to diapers. Our Respect Life committee does so much to support new mom's who are in need. We have in recent years sponsored several refugee families. We also have a parish outreach to those dealing with domestic violence concerns.

A reminder, construction begins this week on the repairs and renovation of the Playdium. The Playdium will not be open for any activities during the renovation.

The 5:00pm Sunday evening congregation has been slowly rebuilding. We have been very encouraged to see this Mass gain in popularity. However, in order for us to continue to keep this Mass on the schedule throughout the summer, we need volunteers to participate in the Mass. We are in desperate need of lectors, greeters, ushers, and Eucharist Ministers, not only for this Mass, but for all Masses. Please contact **Margie André** at mandre@olphglenview.org if you would like to volunteer. Volunteering at Mass is a very rewarding experience. Both adults and teens can volunteer. We need you!

We are gradually returning to the practice of offering the precious blood on Sunday liturgies. We will expand it eventually to all Masses when we have enough Eucharistic Ministers comfortable in ministering the cup.

With graduations completed and schools closed, let summer begin! I look forward to days beginning with a cappuccino at the Glenview Grind, great walks on the Cook County bike trail, dinners at Gusto's and Grandpa's and a "night cap" at the Dairy Bar! Make time in the coming weeks to chill out!

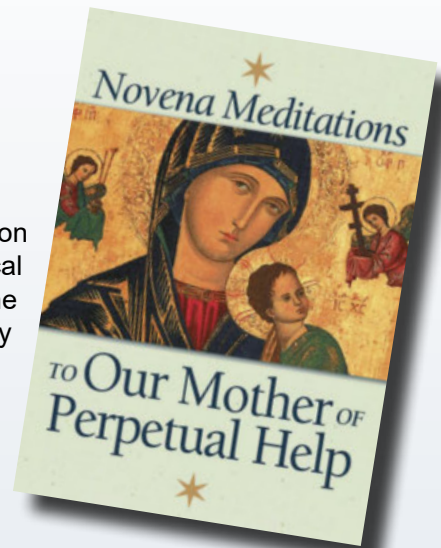

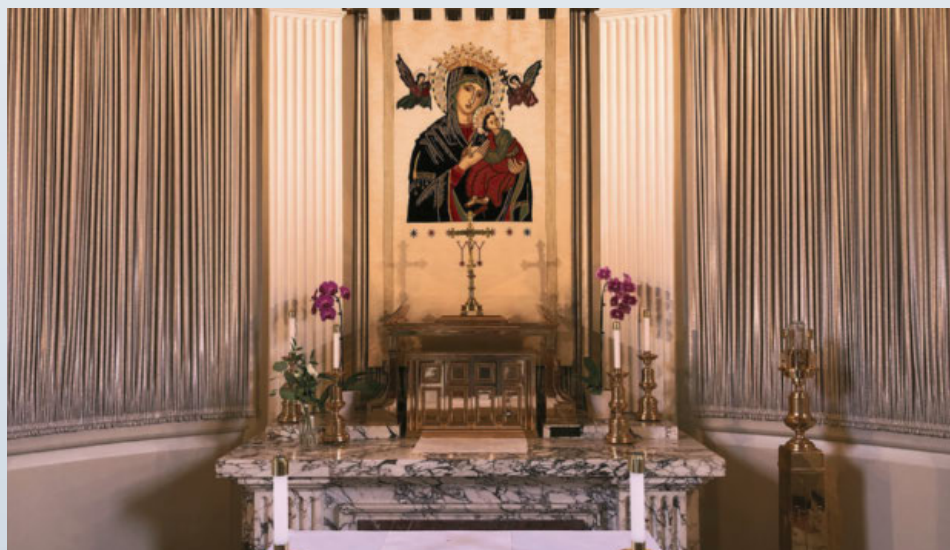
