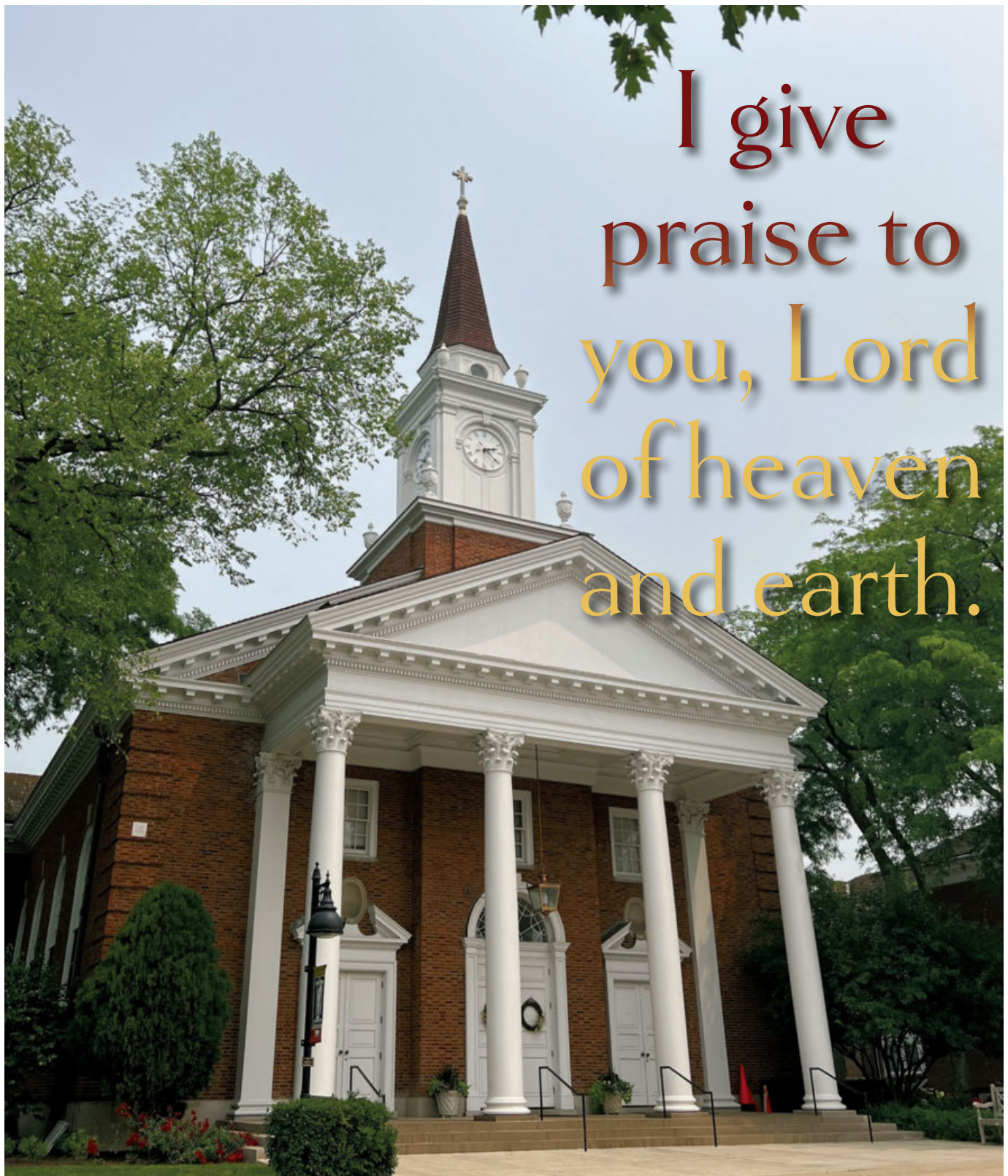

Dear Parishioners,

"I give praise to you, Lord of heaven and earth."

This week's scriptures are filled with hope and assurance. So great is God's love for us that we are compelled to praise Him.

A by-product of being a grateful person is the desire to praise God for the blessings he has

bestowed upon us. Gratitude calls us to an awareness that life and creation are about us and not me! Praise to the God of life, the author of all that is.

We liturgically often do not focus on the psalms even though the psalms are recited at every Mass and are the foundation of the Divine Office. This weekend's psalm is exultant, "I will praise your name forever!" When was the last time I explicitly offered praise to God in my prayer life? Praising God reminds us that we are the beneficiary of God's love. Even when we are in the deepest valley, we are not alone! The Lord is with us.

As we enter this year of Eucharistic Revival, I pray that we will open our hearts to the praise and thanksgiving dimension of our celebration of our liturgy. We stand together around the Lord's table in community to acknowledge God's majesty and graciousness. The power of people coming together counters a selfish notion that I do not have to go to Mass, and I can go for a walk in the woods to pray. I love to pray in my walks in the woods but that is solitary in its context. Important but it lacks the experience of community and the extraordinary gift of receiving Our Lord's Body and Blood.

Thank you for taking the time this past year to complete the Disciple Maker Index Survey. About seven hundred parishioners, which accounts for about 43% of the parish, shared their input on a number of aspects of faith and community life here at Our Lady of Perpetual Help. As you will recall, the survey asked questions about each parishioner's own journey of discipleship and how the parish and the pastor are doing to support you along the way.

Our Parish Pastoral Council, our Finance Council and our Parish Staff and I will take the next few months

to review and interpret the results and develop a comprehensive report on what was collectively shared. Following that initial assessment, we will then identify actions to address specific areas of growth—whether it be across the parish or for me personally as your pastor. The steering committee for this project will be myself, **Mary Lynne Januszewski, Karen Daniels, Fr. Patrick, Fr. Larry, Terry Luc, Bridget Baumstark, and Tom O'Brien**. There will be many levels to the sharing of the data and its interpretation, there will be frequent communication with you as the process proceeds.

I am grateful for everyone in our parish for what you have contributed through this survey. It is clear to me that we, as a community of faith, are hungry to grow closer to our Lord and to assist one another as sisters and brothers in Christ. I look forward to sharing more in the coming months and working with all of you to continue renewing our local Church and our beloved OLPH!

I am still in the afterglow of the graduation season. So many of our young people were recognized for their achievements and accomplishments. I have been thinking of our Grammar School, High School, and College graduates. The High Schools and some Colleges share these accomplishments with us regarding OLPH graduates but we have no way of knowing the accomplishments of many OLPH students who did not attend our school. I want to give you the right to share your pride in the recognition your student might have made. Please forward me this good news! I would love to share with the whole parish the contributions academically, athletically, and personally. Just email me.

I am grateful to **Mike and Maggie Wycklendt** and **Steve and Sheree Kodros** who have accepted the responsibility of our baptismal preparation program. They will be terrific. Reaching out to new parents is critical in establishing a deeper relationship with them as they begin their faith journey as parents. We owe a debt of gratitude to **Deacon Jim and Pat Revord** for their years of ministry in our baptismal preparation program.

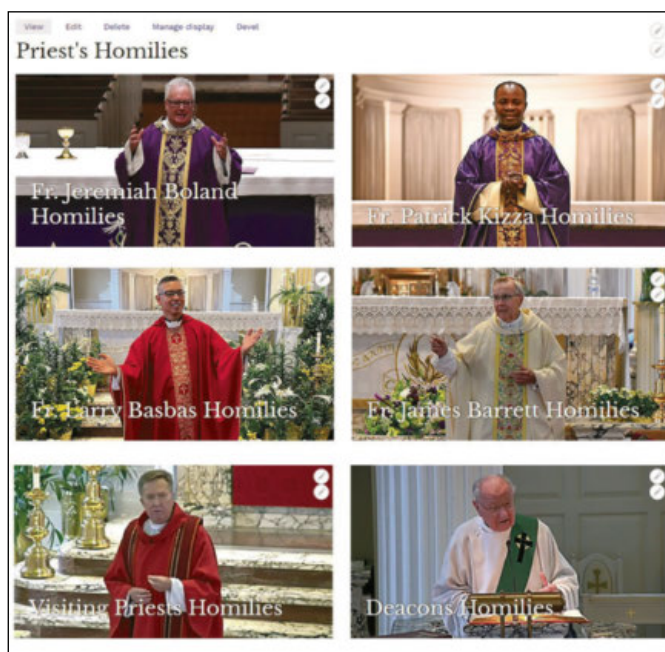

There is so much great content here for anyone to access and we are adding more all the time. Best of all, it is available "on demand." So any time you miss a special event, if we livestreamed it, you will find it here and you can watch it whenever you want.

The Most Recent 12 Homilies

One of the most popular video items that parishioners have requested is the ability to view priest's homilies from prior Masses. We livestream our 8:30am Mass Monday through Friday and our 9:00am Sunday Mass. Homilies of these Masses are then made available for viewing at any time. To make them more easy to find, in our Video Library we have the 12 most recent homilies from each priest or deacon, including visiting priests. This allows anyone to easily view approximately the last 60+ days of homilies.

To find these homilies, go to olphglenview.org, click Video Library on the top menu bar and then the Priest's Homilies window. That will open a screen that looks like this:



Click on the appropriate window to access the most recent videos from each priest or deacon.

Over 900 Homilies recorded!

We created the Video Library on our website so the our most recent and most popular video content can be easily accessed by anyone. However we have an even more extensive library on our Vimeo website.

In fact last week, we reached a milestone with our Digital Ministry. We now have recorded over 900 homilies from all of our priests since began livestreaming our Masses at the start of COVID. All of these homilies can be found on our Vimeo website.

2023 Missionary Cooperation Plan

The Congregation of the Sisters of St. Therese is a Diocesan Congregation of religious women, in Cameroon, Africa, founded on the 25th of June 1963 to serve the needs of the church and to raise the dignity of women. The Sisters are involved in education, health care, and socio-pastoral activities, as well as engaged in social justice and work with marginalized persons in prisons, street children, battered women, and internally displaced persons.

Following a 7-year ongoing political upheaval in the country, whole villages have been raised to dust, many people killed, hundreds of thousands have been displaced and schools have been shut down in the affected areas. Many girls, women, and children are stranded in the streets and forced into prostitution. In response to this new reality, the sisters have opened a shelter in a nearby city that is safe, where they provide a haven for some of the victims (women and children).

We provide rehabilitation, safety, security, mental health care, education, and skills training. We house the girls in a rented apartment which is now very small. We have bought land to construct a bigger shelter and staff house, where we would carry out poultry, and fish farming, agriculture, and soap making to support and provide sustainable skills for the displaced women and children.

We need your support to continue these programs and continue to support the girls, women, and children. With 266 one child returns to school and is taken care of for a whole year. The cost of the construction of a shelter is \$155348.

Catholic Charities' New Hope Apartments Program Fighting Homelessness, One Family at a Time

We have had quite a busy first half of the year. One family has graduated to self-sufficiency, one is continuing to progress, and three families have moved into the program. Great news for those working to reduce the numbers of families experiencing homelessness.

With your support we can help more families transition out of homelessness and into independence. In the Fall, we will be working on establishing a notification system to allow supporters to provide "in-kind" donations to our families with a specific need.

We will keep you updated on how to join our quick response support team. Here is the summer update:

Family code names are used to protect our families' privacy. "**Caregiver**" is a 40-year-old single African American mother with 5 children, 2 of them now living with her. This client was able to secure a full-time position at higher pay and has settle into a routine that works well for her family. Her savings have been robust after receiving one of her tax refunds and she is anticipating another refund. This savings has put her in a good financial position to work towards her goal of homeownership using first time home buyers' programs available in Illinois. Her children will be visiting family some weeks this summer. "Caregiver" thanks all who have helped her and her children with love and support through the New Hope Program.

"**Fatherhood**" is a 36-year-old single African American, the father of 9 children. Four of his children live with him. One of his sons under his care has significant medical issues and is receiving appropriate care to stabilize and manage his needs. The father is doing well and is receiving additional training to obtain a CDL License. "Fatherhood" has begun saving and was able to secure a personal vehicle. The landlord and client have submitted all the necessary paperwork related to a housing voucher which may help the transition from New Hope earlier than expected. All his children are doing well and involved in extra-curricular activities. Fatherhood expresses much gratitude for the continued generosity.

"**Fighter**" is a 32-year-old single Asian female with an 18-month-old daughter who fled a domestic violence. She has secured a new job closer to home at a higher rate of pay and has applied for child support. Fighter is one course shy of graduation with a Bachelor's Degree and plans to pursue a Master's degree in psychology. This client also trains for and participates in paid boxing matches. Debt is still an issue, but strides have been made in both budgeting and debt reduction. "Fighter" is actively participating in therapy to help manage her personal and family issues. The goal is to reduce debt and improve credit so she can work to purchase a home.

"**Celestial**" is a 26-year-old single African American female with a 2-year-old daughter who left a domestic violence environment. This client has been strongly motivated since entering the program and has done extremely well. She has obtained a full-time remote position which allows her to work from with her child. She is receiving help from her family. The client is currently working with a credit repair agency to improve her credit score to assist in purchasing a home in the future. She is also learning to drive and plans to use some of her savings to purchase a car eventually.

"**Transition**" is a 30-year-old single African American female who has experience domestic violence and has 4 children aged 4-12. This mother is working full time and plans to obtain a second job for increased income to maximize their time in the program. The client has a side business occasionally cleaning homes and is receiving certain state benefits. The family is dealing with various issues and have emotional supports in place to help them address these issues. "Transition" is expected to graduate with a G.E.D. working hard to achieve this degree. The client is working on establishing a savings plan and improving their credit score.

The more we work together the more families we can move from homelessness to independence.
