Dear Parishioners,

"Give your servant an understanding heart."

You have heard the great saying, "May you have the wisdom of Solomon!" That sentiment is reflected from our first reading this weekend taken from the First Book of Kings. As Solomon is preparing to succeed his father, David as king of Israel, the Lord asks him what he wants. He could ask for anything.

Of all the things he could have asked for, wealth, power, and a long life, he asks for an understanding heart. The Lord assures him he will have a heart of wisdom and understanding.

In our prayer life it can be helpful from time to time to reflect on what it is we are asking of the Lord. How other centered is my prayer? How often is my prayer rooted in gratefulness? How often do I seek the ability to accept certain situations rather than the hope that some problems will just vanish?

I remember many years ago when my dad was suffering from pancreatic cancer, and I was with him one day when he was receiving chemotherapy. The doctor came in and as he was examining, he asked my dad if he prayed. My Dad said of course he did. The doctor then said, "sometimes we need to think about what we are praying for." This wise doctor helped my dad begin to come to terms with the reality of his terminal illness. My father found a sense of comfort and peace that was so helpful to him as he moved into the final stage of his life. He died a few weeks after that conversation, but his focus moved to a sense of acceptance and gratitude for his life. The wisdom of Solomon! I suppose he was at a point where the gift of his prayer was God's closeness to him as his earthly journey was ending.

Summertime can invite us to seek an understanding heart. Days where we have more opportunities to rest and recharge our batteries that can better help us to appreciate what we have rather than what we want.

Monday is the Feast of St. Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Jesuits. We are blessed to have two "sons" of St Ignatius who serve us, **Fr. Paul Kalenzi SJ** and **Fr. Patrick Mugisho SJ**. May God bless them and all Jesuits of this feast day.

Please remember **Sr. Joan** who is recovering from a fractured hip. She is anticipating surgery and rehab in the coming days.

Thank you for your prayers and thoughts for **Fr. Patrick Kizza**. He is spending some time in a period of spiritual and physical renewal. He is grateful for all your support.

Fr. Patrick was going to be leading our parish pilgrimage to the Holy Land in a few weeks. I will be taking his place. We have about twenty people going.

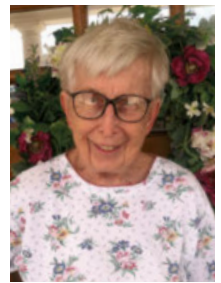

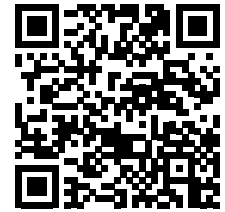
