

Dear Parishioners,

"Lord it is good we are here!"

There are certain moments when we have an overriding sense that it is good to be where we are.

I remember the birth of my oldest niece many years ago and just how struck I was about the power of the moment. Maggie would be the first of a new generation of Boland's. I was thrilled for my brother Rich and sister-in-law Barb.

I remember Nov. 2, 2016, when the longest drought in major league baseball ended when the Cubs won the World series. I was standing under the red marquee sign at Wrigley as it proclaimed the Cubs World Series Champions.

I remember opening my mail on Monday, May 13, 2014, and seeing I had just been appointed pastor to OLPH. I was overwhelmed with such a sense of gratitude.

We all could list moments in our life when we felt this overpowering sense of how good it is to be here! Peter, James, and John were overwhelmed as they experienced the Transfiguration of Our Lord and the appearance of Moses and Elijah. Peter was so happy to be there, he wanted the moment to last as long as it could.

We are faced many times with periods of struggle or challenge, we need to remember those moments of grace, accomplishment, and glory.

I take leave this weekend to lead our pilgrimage group to the Holy Land. One of our visits will be to the Mount of the Transfiguration. Please pray for me and my fellow pilgrims as we visit several of the holy places. We have mass scheduled next week at the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher in Jerusalem, the holiest place in Christendom.

With **Fr. Patrick** away and me leading his pilgrimage we are a bit stretched with priest presiders. We have a line up of celebrity presiders to help! I am grateful for these generous priests so willing to assist. We will have Masses led by my friend **Msgr. Ken Velo** who many of you know. Our wonderful Vicar, **Bishop Bartosic** and our great Dean, **Fr. Ron Kalas** will celebrate a few Masses. We also will have **Fr. Greg Ostdiek SJ**, President of Loyola Academy and former associate, **Fr. Dennis Zalecki** presiding. Thanks to **Fr. Patrick Mugisho SJ** who has helped cover many Masses. The email blasts and Bulletins will indicate at which masses they are presiding.

We are still on schedule to complete our major construction project on the Playdium. The roof replacement involved more infrastructure attention than we had anticipated but we are moving forward. We will now be installing the mechanicals for the HVAC system. The new floor is "curing."

I am grateful for your financial commitment to OL. We can maintain our beautiful campus because of your support. So many parishes get way behind and resort to deferred maintenance. Problems only get worse.

In a few weeks we begin the replacement of the carpet in the Church. This will take about 10 days. We are finalizing the plan of action. We will try to work around the installation process, but we may need to reschedule some services or move them to other locations on campus. I always dread the word August! Well, here we are! We have an ambitious program of preparing for all the activities that will be commencing in the next few

weeks. We are upgrading the electrical systems in two of the buildings, floors are waxed, windows being washed and new security camaras being installed.

Special thanks to **Emmitt King** who offered to repair the cornerstone of the school that had been damaged over the years and some other concrete repairs.

PLANNED GIVING CORNER **AUGUST 2023**

"This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." (Matthew 17:5)

Every day, we can listen to Jesus and give back the gifts he has provided to us. Please consider making a gift from your individual retirement plan (IRA) that benefits you and our parish. A qualified charitable distribution (QCD) allows individuals age $70\frac{1}{2}$ or older to authorize their IRA administrator to make a direct transfer of funds from their IRA to qualified charities, tax-free.

There are three main benefits of giving with a QCD:

(1) If you are 72 years old or older, the amount you transfer can satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution.

(2) The amount transferred directly to charity does not generate taxable income, which may reduce your annual income level. This may help lower your Medicare premiums and decrease the amount of Social Security that is subject to tax.

(3) Your gift will be immediately used, allowing you to see the impact of your gift now.

Summer Renovations

OLPH Campus renvovations, repairs, and maintenance are proceeding on schedule. So much is happening right now and more about to commence. Please be aware of the following updates as you visit our campus during the month of August.

Church Carpeting Removal and New Installation

We are very excited about our new carpeting to be installed in August. The pattern will be the same as is currently in place however the color will be a deep dark blue to match the color of Mary's cloak in the OLPH Icon.

The carpet installation will require us to adjust our church schedule. There may be days that we will not be able to livestream Mass. We appreciate your patience and understanding during this process. Here are the key dates with comments:

- Aug. 14 Aug. 18 The main Church will be the focus of the first week's operations (Aug. 14 Aug.18). Both the 6:30am and 8:30am Masses between Monday and Friday of this first week will be moved from the Church to McDonnell Hall. We cannot use Lady Chapel due to its occupancy capacity, concerns of people with breathing issues, as well as possible noise carrying into the Lady Chapel from the work taking place in the Church.
- Aug. 19 Aug. 20 Weekend Masses on Aug. 19 Aug. 20 should not be affected, presuming everything goes according to schedule. Current plan is for these Masses to be held in the Church according to our normal schedule.
- Aug. 21 Aug. 25 The second week's work (Aug. 21 Aug. 25) will include Lady Chapel, stairs to the choir loft, and south vestibule. The Church should be available for weekday Masses. However, we will make a decision regarding where these Masses will be held, depending on the level of dust, noise, etc., experienced in the first week. If needed, we will move these weekday Masses to McDonnell Hall up through Thursday, Aug. 24.


