Dear Parishioners,

"Take courage, do not be afraid."

Jerusalem

I feel like I am a foreign correspondent. I am writing this letter while on a pilgrimage with a group of parishioners in the Holy Land.

We are blessed in the Catholic tradition to have many places of religious pilgrimage: from the great Marian Shrine of Lourdes to the tomb of St. James in Santiago di Compostela to Assisi to St. Peter's. At center of the Christian world sits Jerusalem. The place of so many of Our Lord's teachings, miracles, his passion, death, and resurrection. As I join our parish pilgrimage here, I hold all of you in prayer.



Jerusalem is the epicenter of the monotheistic world. Christians, Jews, and Islamic people venerate this city with many central teachings and traditions traced to here.

We prayed the other day in the place tradition holds as the Upper Room where the Last Supper and Pentecost took place. As we enter this year of Eucharistic Revival, I pray for a deepening of eucharistic practice and participation in our parish and the larger Church. The Scriptures this weekend are a case statement of the power the Eucharist can hold in facing the challenges and anxieties that we all must contend with.

Central to many of St. John Paul II's writings and homilies was the exhortation, "do not be afraid"! As our faith is nurtured by the proclamation of God's Word and we are fed by the Eucharist, we can face what we must face.

The other day, we were on the Sea of Galilee and this incident of the disciples being terrified by the turbulent

waters became very real to me. Our faith can be such a source of strength that reveals the peace only Christ can give.

This coming week has much in store at OLPH!

Our faculty return for a series of meetings to prepare for the coming year. These meetings are so important, and I hold all teachers in such high regard. Teachers have such an impact on a young person's life. I pray that this coming year will be a great one for all teachers.

This week we begin a 10-day process of installing our new carpet. We will do everything to minimize the disruption this process will take. Morning Masses will be celebrated in McDonnell Hall. Next weekend we should be able to have weekend liturgies in the Church. There will be sections of carpeting that will yet to be installed. We can later in the process have services in the Lady Chapel. I am so grateful for everyone's patience as we get this installation accomplished. It will be beautiful when completed. *(Please see page 4 for more information.)*

Many have been asking about the bells, they are coming! We have some remaining issues regarding the bell tower that must be addressed.

I am grateful to a group of parishioners who recently gave the church a thorough cleaning. The pandemic took a toll on the pews with all the spraying that was required to protect us from the virus. One of our projects down the road will be to refinish the pews.

Congratulations to our Communications Director, **Terry Luc**! His coverage of our 40th Anniversary of our Sharing Program earned us a nomination for the coveted Golden Trumpet Award by the journalism community.

The information meeting for our parish trip to Norway and Sweden is scheduled for Tuesday, Aug. 29 at 6:30pm in Hickey Hall.

Please mark your calendars for our annual observance of the Solemn Vespers for the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation here at OLPH. 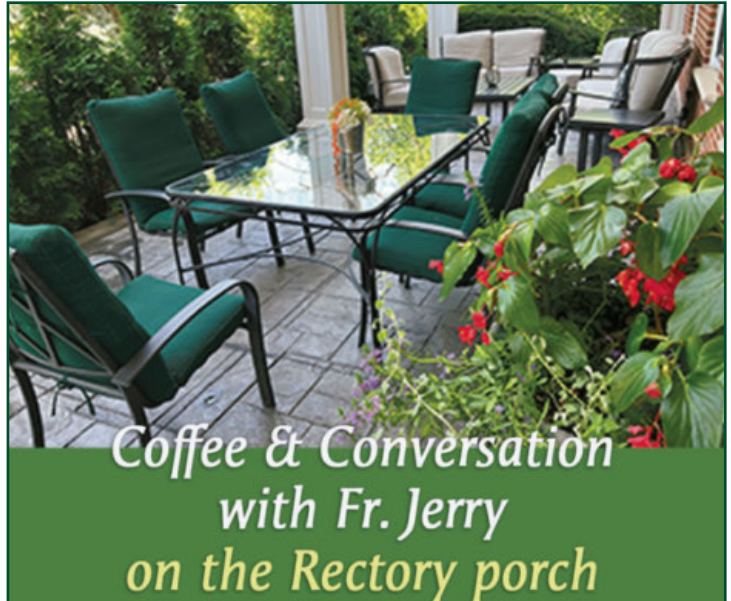

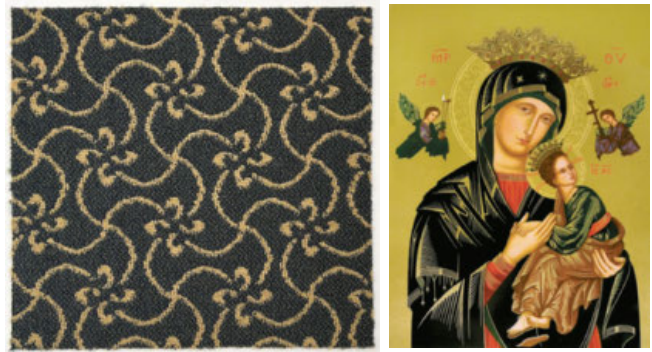

Summer Renovations

OLPH Campus renovations, repairs, and maintenance are proceeding on schedule. Please be aware of the following updates as you visit our campus during the month of August.

Church Carpeting Removal and New Installation

We are very excited about our new carpeting to be installed in August. The pattern will be the same as is currently in place however the color will be a deep dark blue to match the color of Mary's cloak in the OLPH icon.



The deep blue of our new carpet (left) was selected to match Mary's blue cloak in the OLPH icon (right).

The carpet installation will require us to adjust our church schedule. We appreciate your patience and understanding during this process. Here are the key dates with comments:

- **Aug. 14 - Aug. 18 The main Church carpet installation.** Both the 6:30am and 8:30am Masses between Monday and Friday of this first week will be moved from the Church to McDonnell Hall. There will be no livestreaming of the Masses this week.
- **Aug. 19 - Aug. 20 Weekend Masses.** Current plan is for these Masses to be held in the Church according to our normal schedule. We should be able to livestream the Sunday 9:00am Mass. However, if there are any delays or problems with the installation, we will need to adjust. Watch for the Daily eblasts for any updates.
- **Aug. 21 - Aug. 25 Week 2 carpet installation.** The second week's work will include Lady Chapel, stairs to the choir loft, and south vestibule. The Church should be available for weekday Masses. However, we will make a decision regarding where these Masses will be held, depending on the level of dust, noise, etc., experienced in the first week. If needed, we will move these weekday Masses to McDonnell Hall up through Thursday, Aug. 24. Again there will be no livestreaming of the weekday Masses.

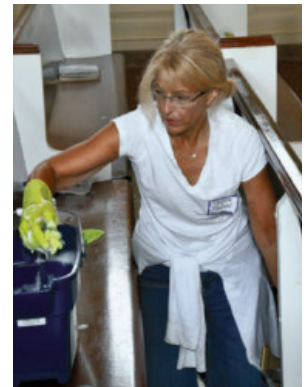
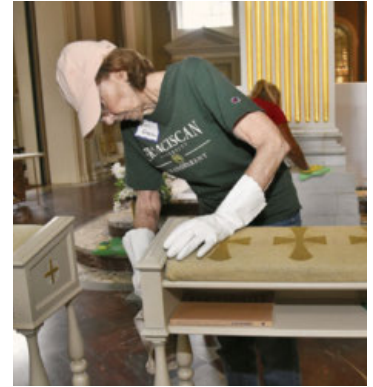

Music Ministry

Instrumentalists and Singers of All Ages Needed

Anytime is a great time to join one of the choirs and help continue to build the Music Ministry at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church. This is a wonderful opportunity to serve God and the Parish through sharing your gifts of music and song. And it promises to be a lot of fun as well!



The following groups are all directed by our music director, **Russell Stern**. New members are always welcome and encouraged to join throughout the year.

The Adult Festival Choir

- We sing at the 9:00am Mass on Sunday (and sometimes other Masses) until the first week of June. We also sing for Holidays and special occasions. All singers are welcome.
- Rehearses in the church on Tuesday evenings from 7:30-9:00pm in the church. The first rehearsal is on Sept. 12.

The 10:30 Mass Ensemble

- Sings at the 10:30 AM Mass throughout the year.
- All singers are welcome and instrumentalists are encouraged to audition.
- The singers rehearse in the church on Tuesdays from 7:45-9:15pm in the music office. The first rehearsal is on Sept. 12.
- Instrumentalists rehearse prior to the Mass or as needed.

The Teen/Young Adult Ensemble

- Sings approximately once a month either at the Saturday 5:00pm Mass or the Sunday 10:30am Mass on Sunday (depending on the teen's availability), and for Christmas, Easter and other special occasions, until early June.
- Students 7th grade through young adult are welcome.
- No audition required for singers. Instrumentalists are encouraged to audition.
- Rehearses in the church periodically on Saturdays at 4:15pm or Tuesdays, 6:45pm (depending on the teen's availability). Our first rehearsal will be on Sept. 23 in the church.

The Children's Choir

- Sings once a month, usually at the 9:00 or 10:30am Mass from October through Mothers Day. They also sing at the Christmas Eve 3:00pm Mass, and on Easter.
- 1st thru 7th grade children are welcome.
- Rehearses in the church on Tuesdays, starting, Sept. 19, from 5:45-6:30pm.

Cantors

- Cantors are auditioned from the choir and are then trained. They are scheduled to sing for 1-3 Masses a month depending upon the church's need and the cantor's availability. A Schola Cantorum made up of our cantors sings periodically at the Saturday 5:00pm Mass.
