

Dear Parishioners,

"Upon this rock I will build my church."

At the base of the dome of St. Peter's Basilica is inscribed the verse from this weekend's gospel, *Tu Es Petrus*... "You are Peter and upon this rock I will build my church". The dome is built over the tomb of St Peter and the Main Altar.

I am always moved by this gospel because it gets to the heart of

who we are as believers. We build upon the foundation the Lord has laid. Each generation from St. Peter on has had the responsibility to build on the foundation of the Church the Lord has entrusted to us.

This foundation has endured many trials and challenges; from heresies to armed conflicts, to deep divisions within, to heartbreaking scandals.

This foundation has also been the rock from which the poor have been fed, the vulnerable protected, the faith handed on, the vision of the Kingdom of God proclaimed.

I love this meditation by St. Teresa of Avila:



Christ has no body but yours, No hands, no feet on earth but yours, Yours are the eyes with which he looks, Yours are the feet with which he walks to do good.

Yours are the hands with which he blesses the world.


Christ has no body now but yours.

We are crucial to the process of building on the foundation of faith. Parish is crucial to this. It is in our church, within the walls of our campus that Christ is worshipped and glorified, his teachings studied and taught. It is the day in and day out of parish life that we are formed in our faith.

As we embark on a new program year, we renew our desire to grow closer to Christ, to be more generous in our sharing of the gifts he has bestowed, more committed to being a faithful disciple.

Our major summer projects are completed. The extensive renovation of the Playdium has been for the most part completed. Our new carpet in the Church has been installed. Two projects on the horizon will be the installation and upgrade of our bells and tower clock. We also will begin a long-awaited project of renovating McDonnell Hall. Thank you for your faithful stewardship of the parish.

Lots of activities on the horizon. As I write this column. I am looking forward to the Annual Men's Club Golf tournament on August 25 at the Glenview Golf Club, on August 29 will be an information meeting on the upcoming parish trip to Norway and Sweden next June, and on August 30 a conversation on the rectory porch on the upcoming Synod of Bishops on Synodality which will involve an unprecedented number of non-ordained people as voting delegates. The process of digesting the results of the diocesan survey is underway. I am so grateful to **Tom O'Brien** and **Bridget Baumstark** for their analysis and input in helping us assess what the survey can say to us about who we are and where we would like to go. They have made presentations to the Steering Committee and the Parish Pastoral Council. In coming weeks presentations will be given to the Finance Council and Parish Staff. There will also be a presentation to the parish at large. In the coming weeks there will be information of the findings in our parish Bulletin.

Instrumentalists and Singers of All Ages Needed

Anytime is a great time to join one of the choirs and help continue to build the Music Ministry at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church.

This is a wonderful opportunity to serve God and the Parish through sharing your

gifts of music and song. And it promises to be a lot of fun as well!

The following groups are all directed by our music director, **Russell Stern**. New members are always welcome and encouraged to join throughout the year.

The Adult Festival Choir

- We sing at the 9:00am Mass on Sunday (and sometimes other Masses) until the first week of June. We also sing for Holidays and special occasions. All singers are welcome.
- Rehearses on Tuesday evenings from 7:30-9:00pm in the church. First rehearsal: Sept. 12.

The 10:30 Mass Ensemble

- Sings at the 10:30 AM Mass throughout the year.
- All singers are welcome and instrumentalists are encouraged to audition.
- The singers rehearse in the church on Tuesdays from 7:45-9:15pm in the music office. First rehearsal: Sept. 12.
- · Instrumentalists rehearse prior to the Mass or as needed.



The Teen/Young Adult Ensemble

• Sings approximately once a month either at the Saturday 5:00pm Mass or the Sunday 10:30am Mass (depending on the teen's availability), and for Christmas, Easter and other special occasions, until early June.

- Students 7th grade through young adult are welcome.
- No audition required for singers. Instrumentalists are encouraged to audition.
- Rehearses in the church periodically on Saturdays at 4:15pm or Tuesdays, 6:45pm (depending on the teen's availability). First rehearsal:Sept. 23.

The Children's Choir

- Sings once a month, usually at the 9:00 or 10:30am Mass from October through Mothers Day. They also sing at the Christmas Eve 3:00pm Mass, and on Easter.
- 1st thru 7th grade children are welcome.
- Rehearses in the church on Tuesdays, starting, Sept. 19, from 5:45-6:30pm.

Cantors

 Cantors are auditioned from the choir and are then trained. They are scheduled to sing for 1-3 Masses a month depending upon the church's need and the cantor's availability. A Schola Cantorum made up of our cantors sings periodically at the Saturday 5:00pm Mass.
