seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...

Dear Parishioners,

"Invite to the feast whomever you find."

One of the buzz words in church circles these days is the word evangelization. The Church has been challenged by the forces of secularization, the increasing numbers of people who identify as "Nones" those who have no religious affiliation.

Over the years the Catholic church, as well as most mainline churches, have seen a decline in weekly attendance. The pandemic accelerated this decline. For some their choice to disconnect has been due to several factors, disagreement with church teaching, scandals, being too busy on Sunday, or just a feeling of ambivalence about public worship.

Here at OLPH we have been exploring ways to re-engage the disengaged, to continue to welcome people to participate to whatever degree they are comfortable. I hear the challenge in the Gospel this weekend, "invite to the feast whomever you find."

There have been many sociological studies pre-Covid and post-Covid about the decline in our society of people belonging to groups beyond their inner circle. Some years ago, this trend was identified in the book, "Bowling Alone: America's Declining Social Capital." The irony is that person-to-person socializing has been so influenced by the meteoric rise in social media. This physically isolates a person to communication via their phone or computer.

We are at our best when we live in community! The isolation of the pandemic has resulted in a tidal wave of mental health issues. We need each other.

All of this makes the point that a parish can be a vital part of our spiritual and emotional well-being. A parish can be a place where we form friendships, attend to our spiritual life, participate in ways to make the world a better place.

I often dream of creating a book that I would entitle, "A Day in the Life of OLPH." Such a book would be a case statement of the difference this parish makes 365 days a year. The Lord is worshipped, children are educated, the sick are visited, the poor are fed, we celebrate, we grow, we reach out to one another in love.

We are participating in a process of reflecting on our stewardship as members of this wonderful parish. We must embrace the challenge of this week's gospel, "invite to the feast anyone you find". Not a week goes by that I don't hear from several people sharing with me how significant their belonging to OLPH means to them.

It is very important that from time to time, we as a parish family reflect on the mission of our parish and reflect on how we are in fact using our time, talent and treasure to ensure its vitality and life.

In discussions about the mission of our parish, it can easily drift into the world of the theoretical. I draw your attention to this week's bulletin which shows you how your financial support of the parish is essential to our mission. Look at the investments we make during the fiscal year to support our sacramental life, our children and youth, our staff and the maintenance of our parish, our outreach to others, the support of our 80 ministries and the support we give to the Archdiocese and the larger church. It is more than amazing.

I know there are many requests you receive every week to support many important causes. Thank you for your support of OLPH. We have so much to offer because of your generous stewardship.

The cost of running such a parish, expanding our outreach, responding to the challenges in our midst keeps increasing. My hope is that this process of reviewing our financial needs will result in your confidence that your sacrifices make all the difference. For some this can be an occasion to review and possibly increase their financial support of the offertory.

I am aware that the financial support of the parish is very personal and there is no way I can appreciate the personal circumstances of every parishioner. Many of you are on fixed incomes, many have mortgages, car payments and tuition bills that limit your ability to contribute to what you would like. Others have family financial challenges that are real and affect what they can contribute. The whole purpose of this process is to better realize what I can do or could do in supporting the parish with my time, talent and treasure.

I mentioned last week that I hope we can center our reflections on the question, "how am I a faithful steward?"

We want to thank you for your support of OLPH. We strive to be good stewards of your gifts. Below is a summary of the needs of our parish and how offertory funds are used to cover those.

FY22-23 Total Offertory

\$3,047,000

Year to Date 09/30/23 Offertory

\$660,000



Our Sacramental Life - \$800,000

OLPH is blessed to have a pastor, 2 active priests and 1 retired priest available to administer and celebrate the sacraments. A Sacristan allows the church to be open all day, most days. Having electricity, gas and needed supplies is essential to us providing the sacraments. Music and Arts and Environment enhance our celebrations. The availability of our maintenance team assures a plowed and safe parking lot as we come to worship. Our Digital Ministry team provides our sacramental and other celebrations to those who cannot be present. In Fiscal year 2023, we had 160 Baptisms, 150 First Communions, 139 Confirmations, 27 Marriages and 86 Funerals. We offer 6 Sunday Masses and 2 Daily Masses, most weekdays.



Our Children & Youth - \$1 million

Our children and youth are our Church of the future! To that end, and to encourage their growth in our Catholic faith, the parish is committed to supporting our school, faith formation and youth activities, above and beyond what tuition and fundraising income cover. Current enrollment is 780 students in the school and 440 in Religious Education. The Youth Ministry program has provided activities for at least 50 youth in this fiscal year thus far.



Building Repairs & Maintenance & Staff - \$645,000

A campus of 11 buildings requires on-going repairs, maintenance, and insurance, and continued attention from the maintenance team. Only a small amount of funds is available for unexpected events. While we would like to be pro-active in handling these projects, rather than operating with a deferred maintenance attitude, we can only do as much as the budget allows, which, of course, is dependent upon the revenue available. Capital projects are funded from prior years' reserves, so it is important to fund operations expenses with operating revenue and not resort to dipping into savings.

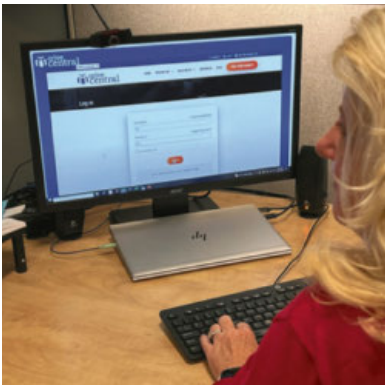

Outreach to Others - \$350,000

From every Sunday Offertory and Holyday collection, OLPH sets aside 6% for our First Fruits Program. Four Sharing Parishes and five second collections benefit from this are set aside. The ability to maintain and grow this support is realized only as our Offertory collection grows. The office staff at OLPH is available to channel calls and drop-ins as clients request assistance from Sr. Paulanne's Needy Family Fund. The finance staff keeps the records of the Fund, including tracking donors' gifts, making deposits, and processing and mailing approved requests for client assistance. Space is set aside on our campus for The Sharing Ministry so that they can gather, sort, and distribute food, clothing, and other essentials to those in need. The maintenance team is available to lend a hand whenever needed.



Support of Other Ministries & Activities - \$325,000

Our parishioners can take part in 80 different ministries over the course of a year. The parish budget helps to support these ministries and activities by providing administrative and maintenance assistance for event and room scheduling, access to space, set-up, take down, and cleaning. Our Communications team helps to publicize events and activities, and the Finance team assists with tracking funds received, providing payments for related costs of the programs and assistance with the use of GiveCentral to accept program fees.



Archdiocesan Support - \$450,000

We provide support to the Archdiocese to help with their efforts to provide service and opportunities to all parishes within the Archdiocese. These services and opportunities come in the form of professional HR and benefits administration, maintenance of our payroll, accounting technology and reporting environment, legal, fundraising and tax advice as well as trainings for various ministries and activities. OLPH uses these services on a regular basis. Each parish is also asked to support the Archdiocesan Priests Health and Retirement Fund.

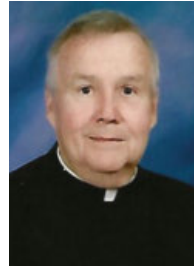

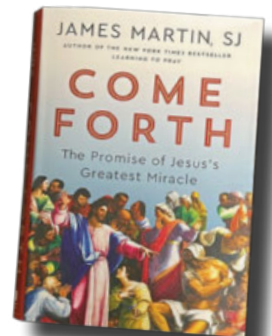
The sessions will be three consecutive Wednesdays in November: 11/1, 11/8 and 11/15 at 7:00pm.

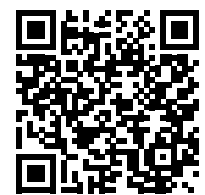

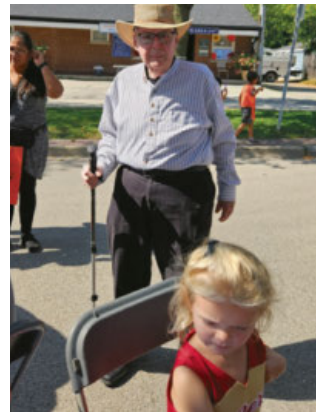

Russell's Next Concert



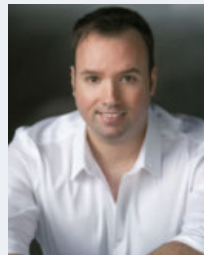
Mark your Calendars: Russell's next concert will be on Sunday, November 19, 2023 at 2:00pm.
