Dear Parishioners,

"All good gifts around us."

One of my all-time favorite musicals was "Godspell." I performed in it when I was in college. I was in the orchestra and was just so taken by the music.

The most popular song from that musical is entitled, "All Good Gifts". It is a sweeping anthem of gratitude for all the good gifts that

are sent from heaven above. The lyrics were originally a German poem written by Matthias Claudius in 1782.

I often remember this beautiful hymn this time of year as the season of harvest is upon us and the world of nature is revealing its autumn beauty.

No artist could completely replicate the stunning beauty of the forests which radiate such a glorious array of color.

This weekend we wrap up our Intentional Offertory Initiative. As I have moved through this process, I have come to appreciate that a parish really benefits by a deeper sense of all the "good gifts around us".

As I was listening to the beautiful reflections last weekend by the lay witnesses, I was struck by the many ways OLPH, has been blessed by many gifts, the generous stewardship of God's blessings of time, talent and treasure. Each reflection was grounded in gratitude to God and gratitude for this parish. Conversations about stewardship can get very lofty and theoretical. We can sometimes feel we aren't doing our part, but last weekend was a testimony that each of us in our own way can respond in gratitude for all the blessings the Lord has entrusted to us. God keeps challenging us to be more generous, more giving, more committed to our journey of faith.

Stewardship is the fruit and outgrowth of growing closer

to Our Lord as His disciple. One of the major investments we make in our parish has to do with this deepening of our faith life from childhood through adulthood. 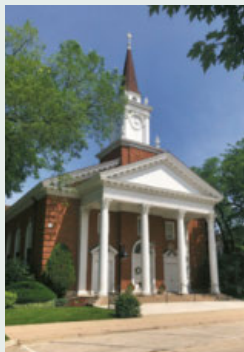

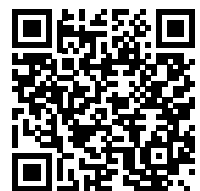

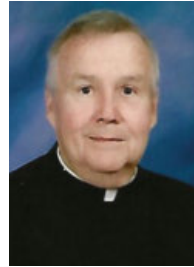

At the first meeting at 7:00pm on Wed., Nov. 1, we will cover the first three chapters.

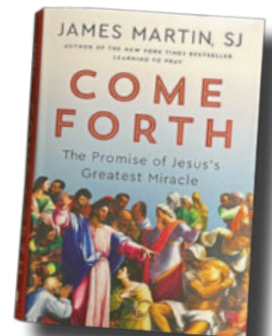

Russell's Next Concert

You are warmly invited to attend Russell Stern's next concert. This amazing free event will feature the return of Russell's good friend from New Jersey, tenor extraordinaire, **Theodore Chletsos**.

Tenor Theodore Chletsos has garnering praise in the U.S. and abroad for his powerful voice and dynamic stage presence. Theodore has performed to much acclaim throughout the Netherlands and Belgium, performing in tours of *Madama Butterfly*, *La bohème*, and *Rigoletto*, where he was universally praised for his "ringing high notes" and dramatic talents.

Theodore made his Carnegie Hall and New York City Opera debut in Samuel Barber's *Antony and Cleopatra*, conducted by George Manahan. Chletsos has performed with Minnesota Opera, Pittsburgh Opera, Central City Opera, Indianapolis Opera, Utah Opera, Opera New Jersey,

Baltimore Concert Opera, Chautauqua Opera, the Minnesota Orchestra, New Jersey Symphony Orchestra, and the Oregon Symphony, among others, and performed in the world premiere (and can be heard on the original cast recording, singing nine roles!) of Ricky Ian Gordon's *The Grapes of Wrath* with Minnesota Opera, Utah Opera, and Pittsburgh Opera.

In addition to performing solo works, Russell will accompany Theodore on opera classics, art songs, neapolitan songs, religious selections and musical theatre favorites.

Composers will include Bach, Handel, Schumann, Faure, Debussy, Bizet, Gounod, Mascagni, Rossini, Verdi, Puccini and Stern.

There will be no charge for admission.

How witnessing Domestic Violence affects Children.

The trauma of domestic violence is enough to cause dangerous changes in the developing brains of children, including nightmares, changes in sleep patterns, anger, irritability, difficulty concentrating.

School-aged children can develop anti-social traits, struggle with guilt over the abuse witnessed and take on the blame for the abuse their parent deals with. Domestic violence has ability to cause post-traumatic stress disorder in children that are raised around it.

Routinely witnessing domestic violence places children at a high risk of developing depression, sadness, concentration issues into adulthood. In some instances, children that live in abusive households are also likely to fall victim to this treatment themselves.
