Dear Parishioners,

"Give thanks to God unceasingly."

The beginning of November brings to the season of gratitude. We are getting closer to Thanksgiving, one of our great celebrations of the year. We have significant feast days that set the tone as we approach the holiday.

We begin this month remembrance by calling to mind

the great heroes of our faith, the community of saints. Whether they are people who have been formally canonized by the Church or canonized in our hearts, we praise God for these witnesses of his love in our lives.

If you have the chance, look at the saints featured in the display cabinet in the South Vestibule. Fr. Larry wanted to focus on the recent generation of new saints. They are a remarkable testimony to the many ways God places people in our lives who call us to holiness.

I am always moved each year by last week's Bulletin cover. It calls to mind the names of those in our parish that have passed away. It is important that we recall their memory and pray for all the

This coming Saturday is Veteran's Day. My father was a veteran of World War II and I have also had a special place in my heart of gratitude for those who have served our nation. I am grateful to Geof Lutz who maintains our list of all those in our parish currently serving in the military. We have several parishioners serving in very dangerous places. May they be safe!

Last week's Annual Parish Summit certainly helped me echo the sentiment in this weekend's second reading, "Give thanks to God unceasingly!" **Tom O'Brien** reviewed the results of our parish survey; Fr. Pat McGrath SJ gave us an insightful overview of the challenging environment the Church finds itself in. We had a wonderful panel of Bill Lynch, Kate Ludden, Mike Wycklendt, and Katie King who shared such great reflections of who has influenced them in their faith journey. Special thanks to Sara Carston and her subcommittee of the PPC that organized a powerful morning. I really felt afterwards that we were afforded a glimpse into the Synodal Church that Pope Francis is calling us to.

Thanks to the Women's Club for the great celebration of Trunk or Treat! What a great celebration.

Thank you for your thoughtful consideration of the Intentional Offertory Initiative. I am so grateful for your generous support of OLPH. I know you have many claims on your "treasure". Again, your stewardship is a powerful way of "giving thanks to God unceasingly".





All donations will go toward Thanksgiving Turkeys for Needy Families, **Sr. Paulanne's** outreach and the OLPH Sharing effort.







Tenor Theodore Chletsos has garnering praise in the U.S. and

abroad for his powerful voice and dynamic stage presence. Theodore has performed to much acclaim throughout the Netherlands and Belgium, performing in tours of *Madama Butterfly, La bohème, and Rigoletto*, where he was universally praised for his "ringing high notes" and dramatic talents.
