Dear Parishioners,

"You know neither the day nor the hour."

The words from this weekend's gospel are rather foreboding. We are called to be vigilant and awake to anticipate the coming of the Lord. The Lord comes to us in many ways and in many different moments. The presence of the Lord can come to us at the most ordinary of moments as well as

the most extraordinary. As we enter the final weeks of the liturgical year there is a tone of urgency to get things in order, do resist the lure of distractions in our quest to be a more authentic disciple.

As we experience the reality of the impending season of winter, the days are crisper, the leaves are falling from the trees, daytime sunshine diminishes. Dark at 5:00, I hate it! This change of seasons can offer a new vantage point, a new perspective as we evaluate our priorities and choices.

The month of November always sets a tone of remembrance for me. We remember the communion of saints, our beloved dead, our veterans and toward the end of the month we are invited to remember our blessings in a spirit of thanksgiving.

As we challenge ourselves to take action to enhance our openness to the urgings of the Lord, there are opportunities all around us. The Coat Drive and the Food Drive are ways we can make a big difference for families in need. The Sharing Room does a remarkable job of connecting the needs of folks with resources. I think of the great work **Sr. Anna** does in connecting people with counseling, housing and helpful advice as people try to navigate challenges and difficulties. **Sr. Paulanne's** Needy Family Fund has helped so many.

I invite the men of our parish to join us for our Men's Spirituality Group that meets the second Saturday of the month at 7:30am, in the lower level of the Rectory. Bring a cup of coffee and join the conversation. We are always out the door by 9:00am. I am so grateful to **Bill Harlan** who organizes our monthly meetings. It is always a great conversation. We are meeting this Saturday, Nov. 11.

The Eucharist and the Sacrament of Reconciliation are

also great ways to feel the power of God's grace at work.

We had quite an eventful end of autumn athletic accomplishments. Glenbrook South and Loyola have

made it to the football playoffs. The Warriors here at OLPH have had so much going on. Several of our Track and Field athletes made it to state competitions. Our 8th grade girls' volleyball team lost the championship game in a nail biter to St. Catherine's and our 8th grade boys are the champions defeating Queen of All Saints. Congratulations to all these athletes. They are a credit to their parents, and we take such pride as a parish for all they have achieved.





I am so proud of our Dussman Council of the Knights of Columbus. They raised money to purchase an ultrasound machine for the Women's Center. This is deeply appreciated by the Women's Center and enhances their outreach to women who are pregnant. Thank you!

Every October we count everyone who attends weekly liturgies. This gives an annual baseline of how attendance numbers match up from year to year. Weekly attendance at Mass has been on a decline since the 1990's but most faith communities experienced a precipitous decline in the aftermath of COVID.

## I am so excited to report that our October attendance was up 27% from last October.

We just must keep reaching out and inviting folks to join us at worship. It always gets the week off to a great start gathering to worship the Lord and receive the Eucharist. We are in the midst of the national observance of the Eucharistic Revival. Hopefully as our parishes continue to heal from the worst of COVID we will continue to grow as a parish gathered around the Lord's table.

Last Saturday we had our monthly Family Catechesis program which brings together our students with their families to explore their faith formation. Under the direction of our DRE, **Erin Bretts** this is really an exciting






