I am pleased to share with you that we have been awarded the maximum grant of \$150,000. I am deeply committed to doing whatever is needed to make sure our campus of 10 buildings is as safe as possible. We have in recent years invested in our security system and protocols. This grant will help us expand our security cameras, enhance lighting of the external spaces on campus, upgrade some of our entrances and address some other needs. I was recently interviewed for a segment of the show, "Sanctuary", produced by the Council of Religious Leaders of Metropolitan Chicago. The conversation focused on ways to protect faith communities. We are honored as a parish to host this year's Ecumenical and Interfaith Thanksgiving Service. A Thanksgiving Message from Sister Paulanne

Thanksgiving is a time to reflect on the great things God has provided us in our lives. We are very grateful for the Blessings we have received!

This year of unrest and violence continues in our world. Your support is amazing and has done so much good in our communities. Know that my prayers are with you.

People struggle every day. They live in fear and feel helpless. Rents keep rising and job opportunities become less. People begin with full employment and find themselves cut to part time, which means they are not able to cover all of their bills.

Mothers from our community continue to come in need of food, warm clothing for their children, hygiene products, gas in the car, and more. Seniors who have worked hard all of their lives live on a limited budget and frequently go without important items such as medication. Some families do not have enough food for their evening meal.

God needs to be the center of our lives each day. We need to give hope to those who have none. We need to go to Mass as family. Eucharist must be key in our faith. We cannot empower others if God is not first in our lives.

Family is key in giving children the security and confidence they need. Children do much better when they are motivated and challenged. They do not function when they lack the necessities of food, clothing, and shelter, when they live in the car or on the street. We wonder why there is so much violence in our communities; why children pick up guns and kill; why they belong to gangs and are on drugs. We have turned our back on homelessness.

We must work together to change our society, our government, our communities. We need to build strong family values and respect for one another. We need to educate and motivate our children in strong educational environments. When we create sufficient job opportunities and provide necessities for one another, we know this is the answer to building strong communities, which in turn, build a great nation!

We need to live the message of the Gospel by feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, housing the homeless. Christ told us: "what you do to the least of my people, you do to ME."

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Illinois legislature abandoned nearly 10,000 children attending Catholic and other non-public schools this week by failing to renew the Invest in Kids scholarship program. Since 2017, Invest in Kids has empowered low-income families to choose the school that best meets their child's needs, providing them the same options more affluent families have.

For more than 175 years, Catholic schools in the Archdiocese of Chicago have provided students a high-quality, faith-based education that prepares them to lead, not just within our Church but in the broader, global community. Catholic schools have educated millions of Chicago area children of all faiths and none during that time.

During the past few years, thanks in large part to the Invest in Kids scholarship program and thousands of generous donors who contributed to the program, we were able to educate even more students who flourished academically. During the pandemic, because our schools made the bold choice to reopen safely, our students continued to grow academically. Many other schools were closed to in-person instruction and students in them through no fault of their own, lost ground academically. How have Illinois' elected officials now responded to our students' academic success and to our schools' leadership and service during the pandemic? By pulling the rug from underneath thousands of needy families.

Unfortunately, Illinois' lawmakers ignored both the wishes of their constituents and their responsibilities to the struggling families of this state. Their failure now puts thousands of children at risk of losing the ability to stay in the school that best meets their needs.

This is a cruel and devastating outcome that will have far-reaching repercussions. Students will lose the scholarships that allowed them to attend our schools, those nearing graduation may not be able to graduate with classmates who have befriended them in these years, and families may no longer be able to choose the school that is best for their child.

I share my shock and disappointment at this situation with thousands of students, parents, educators, and other caring citizens throughout Illinois. However, our Catholic Schools, our other partner schools and the broader Catholic community will not be deterred by our elected officials' inaction and will continue to advocate on behalf of families in need. Over our 175 year history we have supported, to the best of our abilities, families in need who want to enroll their children in the school that best fits their needs. We will continue to walk with these families, regardless of their faith tradition, trusting in the support of our families and our generous donors. We take pride in the excellent Catholic schools in our archdiocese, and in our solid record of giving students, particularly those living in poverty, a chance to succeed in the future.

One of the most important decision parents make for their children is where they are going to send their children to school. Making that decision should not be denied to families in need. I ask all people of good will, particularly those who have been educated in our schools, to join me in the fight to provide the life-long advantage of a Catholic education to every family in need. Together we can make a difference.
