Dear Parishioners,

"The love of Christ impels us."

My favorite chapel at the seminary had emblazoned in the sanctuary, the Latin phrase, "Caritas Christi urget nos" which is Latin for the words of Paul in this weekend's second reading taken from his Letter to the Corinthians.

Once we have embraced our faith in Jesus Christ as our savior,

we are impelled to be a vessel of His love for others. We embrace the commandment of the Gospels, "Love one another as I have loved you." Our faith is not simply passive acceptance, it is a summons to act on the Lord's behalf. No matter what the length of time of our earthly journey, by being claimed by Christ in baptism, we have become a new creation.

In honor of the Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in July, **Fr. Larry Basbas** has put together a wonderful display in the South Vestibule on some of the saints who are distinguished by their love of the Eucharist.

One of those featured is **Blessed Carlo Acutis** who will be declared a saint by Pope Francis on July 1 in Rome. There is universal excitement and anticipation as the Pope announces the declaration of his sainthood and the validity of the miracles attributed to his intercession. The actual date of the canonization will be announced soon.

Carlo was born on May 3, 1991, in London where his father was working, they soon moved back to Italy to Milan. Carlo was a typical teenager, he was a gamer, a computer programmer and loved soccer. Carlo also loved the Eucharist, prayed the rosary daily, he convinced his mom to join him in attending Daily Mass.


His parents were not devout but Carlo's deep love of the Eucharist changed them. Usually, parents need to drag their teenager to Mass, in this case it was the other way around! He used to say, "everyone lines up to go to a concert, or a soccer match, where are the lines for the Eucharist?"

He believed in the sanctity of life, and defending anyone who was being bullied. He also loved playing video games like Nintendo, Game Boy, PlayStation, and Xbox. He used those moments to share his faith with his pals.

Carlo was diagnosed with Leukemia, fought valiantly, and succumbed to the illness in 2006. He offered his suffering for all those who suffer.

He wished to be buried in Assisi to be close to the tomb of St. Francis. Carlo's deep and convincing faith made his life a source of inspiration, especially to young people. The Bishop of Assisi declared his body was incorrupt when he

was declared a blessed. Since then, thousands and thousands of pilgrims visit his glass tomb to see the remains of this young man about to become a canonized saint in blue jeans, Nike shoes and a soccer jersey. I am sure his canonization will draw hundreds of thousands of people to St. Peter's Square.

Carlo was impelled by

the love of Christ! How fitting that during this time of Eucharistic Revival in the United States we will cap things off by the canonization of this saint who teaches all of us about the power of the Eucharist.

Last week was the funeral of **Ed Krupa**, a founding member of our Sharing Program. He was a retired baker who was formed by the beatitude, 'Blessed are the hungry for they shall have their fill." He devoted hours and hours bringing bread to the poor and helping struggling families. He was motivated by this because, like Blessed Carlo, he was a Daily Mass attendee. Fed by the Eucharist, the love of Christ impelled him to love others. May he rest in peace!

The bells are ringing! Grateful to all those who have helped make the bells and new clock tower possible! People really have appreciated this blessed gift. We are still getting to know the system and its features. We are planning an inauguration and blessing of the bells later in the summer, details to follow!

The Real Presence: Eucharistic Adoration

Weekly 3-Minute Reflections on the Eucharist using excerpts from 30 Day Eucharistic Revival by Fr. Don Calloway, MIC

"The object of Eucharistic adoration is the divine Person of our Lord Jesus Christ, present in the Blessed Sacrament. There is nothing greater or holier we can do on earth than this adoration (during Mass or in an adoration chapel). To adore is to share the life of Mary on earth when she

adored the Word Incarnate in her virginal womb, when she adored Him in the crib, on Calvary, and in the Divine Eucharist. Adoration is a dialogue. It is made at the feet of our Lord living and present. The adorer must speak to Jesus, question him, listen, and respond."

Reflection

Sitting in silence before the Blessed Sacrament reading the Bible or the lives of the saints, praying the Rosary, or just gazing upon the miracle of the Holy Eucharist is never pointless or a waste of time. Adoration is always spiritually fruitful. It unites you with God, gives peace, and makes the world a better place.

You can enter an adoration chapel with a thousand worries, concerns, and problems, but after spending time with the Blessed Sacrament you can leave with an inner tranquility that the world can't take away. There really is nothing like it. The presence of Jesus blesses you every single time. Your problems and hardships will be waiting for you when you leave, but *you* will be different.

Adoration changes *you*...because you have opened yourself up to the transforming power of

Jesus' love.







Father Tim and the Vocation Office want to share some information on our work to grow the number of future priests:

I. Strengths (Good News)

- a. Quality candidates, stability with numbers of new seminarians over the past seven years, retention is strong
- b. Growth with Hispanic vocations 32% of seminarians
- c. Projected new seminarians for 2024: one for St. John Vianney College Seminary, and 3 for the Spirituality Year
- d. Growth in lay supporters
- e. One candidate from Asian/Pacific Islander community and one candidate from the Black Catholic community

II. Weaknesses (areas for growth)

- a. Overall number remains low: 31 seminarians
- b. No candidates in 2024 from the Polish communities

III. Opportunities

a. Growth with candidates for college seminary

IV. Threats

- a. Pace of life for priests and discerners






