Greetings, brothers and sisters in Christ!

Fr. Larry here, filling in for Fr. Jerry who's away on a parish trip to **Scandinavia!** We wish him and his group a great and memorable time as they journey to fabulous destinations such as Stockholm, Oslo, Lillehammer, Sognefjord, and Bergen!

LOTS of "extraordinary" things to talk about in this "Ordinary" time! For starters, our Gospel passage from Mark tells of Jesus healing a woman who had been suffering for twelve years and raising a young girl from the dead. It's a reminder that faith in Jesus is crucial and that His power and compassion can bring healing and restoration, regardless of the situation. So, next time you're stuck in traffic or dealing with a stubborn problem, remember to keep your spirits up... because you never know when a little **faith** might turn things around!

Hard to believe that four years have gone by since I was ordained a priest. We were in the grip of a pandemic that resulted in the "indefinite" postponement of the Priesthood Ordination (originally scheduled in May). But with the grace of God, a new date and a different location were determined. On **June 29, 2020**, the **Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul**, I and six of my Chicago brothers were **ordained to the priesthood** at Saint John Brebeuf Parish in Niles.

I look back at my Ordination with tremendous gratitude and relief, as we all faced uncertainty, anxiety, and unpredictability during those early Covid days. Never in a million years would I have imagined the headline of my ordination to read "Cardinal Ordains Seven Masked Men." I feel especially **BLESSED** to have been assigned to this wonderful parish where I have grown immensely as a priest and have found renewed strength and inspiration in my calling. The incredible faith and dedication of the people of OLPH have been a guiding light in my journey! My heartfelt gratitude to each and every one of you! I look forward to new and exciting challenges ahead!

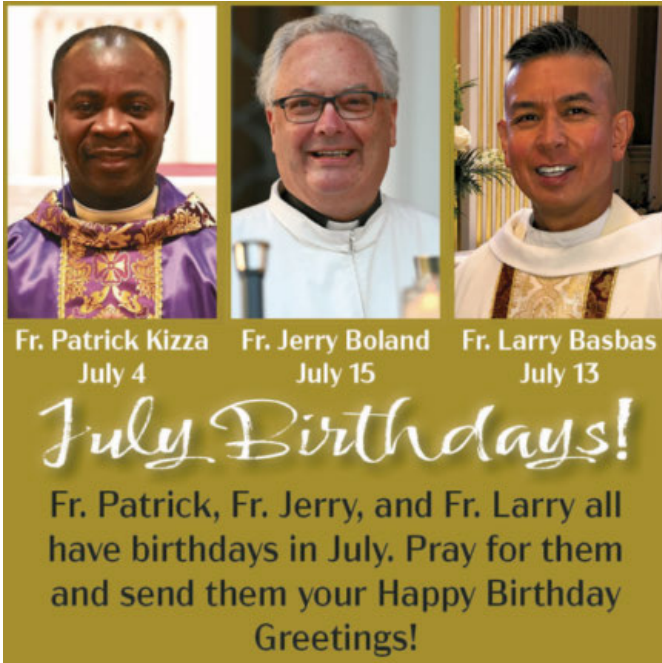

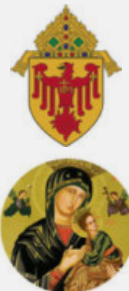

The Real Presence: Mary's Eucharistic Life

Weekly 3-Minute Reflections on the Eucharist
using excerpts from *30 Day Eucharistic Revival*
by Fr. Don Calloway, MIC

“Jesus leads a hidden life in the Most Blessed Sacrament. He honors therein silence and solitude, these two essential conditions of life in God. Such was the life of Mary after the Ascension of her divine Son. She wrapped herself up in obscurity and oblivion. The Evangelists will no longer record her wonderful sayings; neither will they report for our edification her actions so sacred, or her virtues so flawless; they have left her at the foot of the adorable Eucharist in the habitual exercise of a humble and self-effacing adoration.

Living in the center of love, she was henceforth dead to the world with her divine Son. The Divine Host was Mary's only possession, her only glory, her only joy. Was not the Eucharist her Jesus in His entirety?”

– St. Peter Julian Eymard, the Apostle of the Eucharist 1811-1868

Reflection

After the Ascension of Jesus into Heaven, Mary lived an entirely Eucharistic life. She received Holy Communion from the priests just as all Catholics do. She submitted to their leadership and guidance because she knew they represented her Divine Son.



Mary was not a priest. She did not desire to be a priest. To the modern world this may seem like an injustice. Men and women are equal in dignity before God, but their functions and roles are different. The mission dearest to Mary's heart was that of constant prayer for the success of the preaching and the missionary labors of the apostles and of all the members of Jesus Christ's priesthood. She, who was overshadowed by the Holy Spirit at the Annunciation and filled with the same Spirit at Pentecost, wanted to remain overshadowed by the Spirit of God forever and promote Jesus.

Mary's maternal heart is broken when she sees her Eucharistic Son treated poorly, mocked, blasphemed, received unworthily, or neglected in His tabernacles. As a mother, she longs to feed her children with the Bread

that gives Eternal Life. She wants her children to be happy and blessed. She knows that this only happens through the Eucharistic Jesus.

A mother cannot give what a mother does not have. Mary has the Eucharist, and her greatest desire is that everyone know and love Him. She wants us to receive this gift, treasure this gift, and adore this gift. Mary's Eucharistic life is an inspiration to all of us to live a Eucharistic life as she did. Her example shows us that you do not have to be a priest or a deacon to do it. All Christians are called to it.

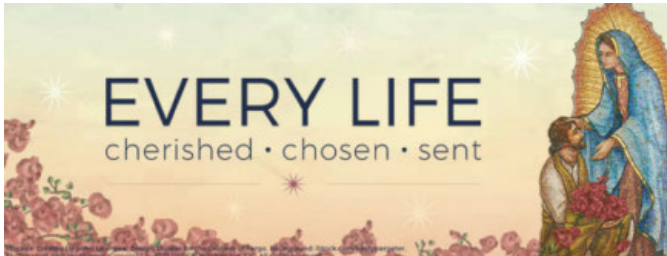

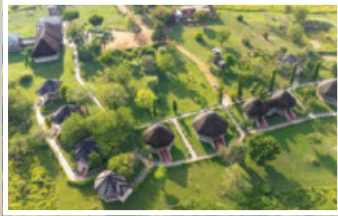
