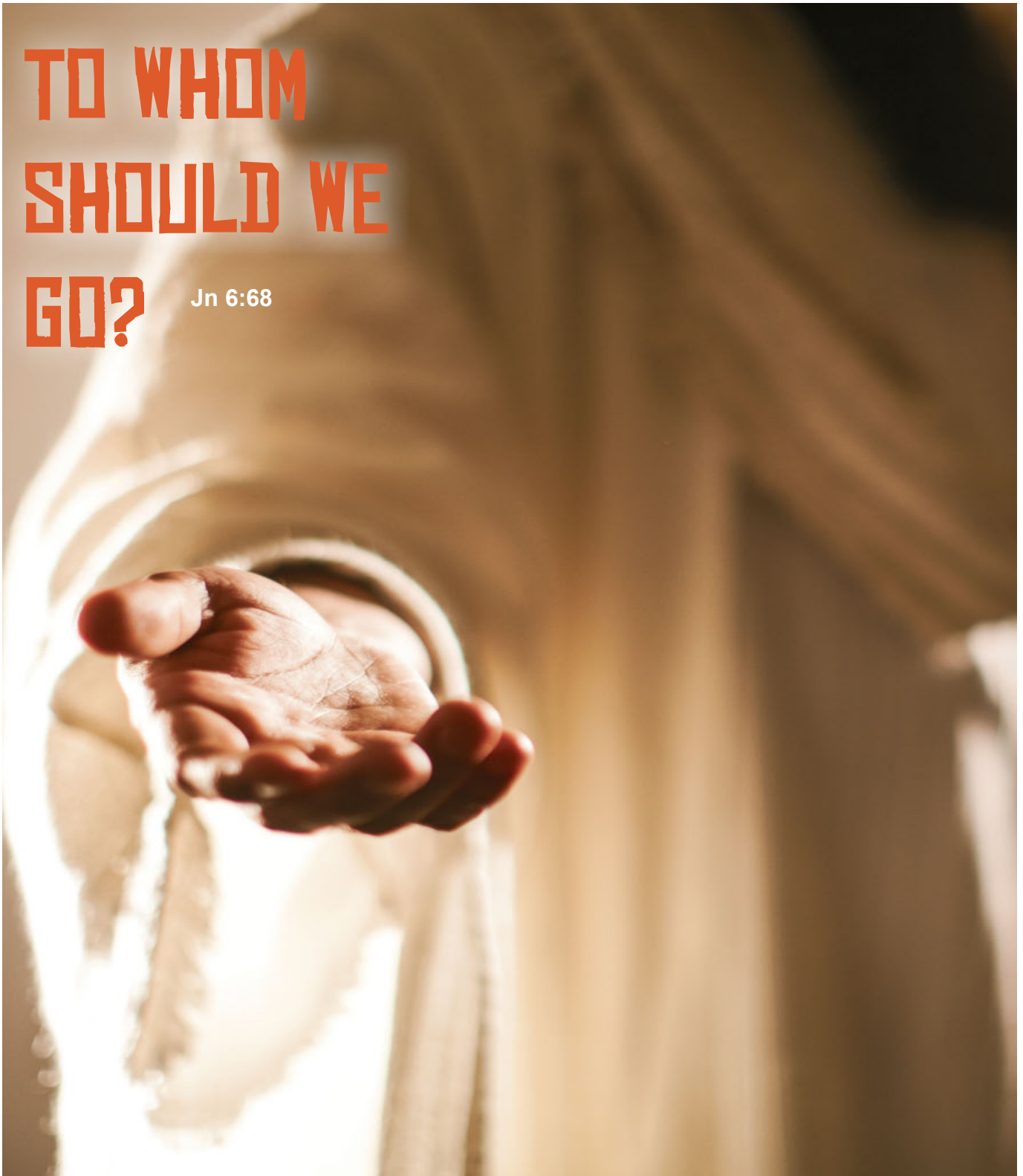

## seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...

Dear Parishioners,

*"To whom should we go?"*

One of the great intellects of the 20th century was the German psychologist, **Eric Fromm**. He was a towering influence on the study of human development and behavior.

He identified crucial thresholds that must be passed to be a healthy, vital person. One of these thresholds was to develop a sense of belonging. In infancy and early childhood, we have a sense that we

are at the center of the universe, we cry, and we get fed, we throw a tantrum until we get what want. Eventually we begin to see we are part of the universe, not the only part of the universe.

We begin to see that we belong to a family, to a community, to God. Well developed, effective human beings have a deep sense of belonging. During the pandemic, many people suffered emotionally because they were isolated and disconnected.

During these weeks we have been reflecting on the "Bread of Life Discourse" from the sixth chapter of John's Gospel. Crucial to understanding the deeper meaning of the Eucharist is this sense that we belong, we belong to a community, we belong to the community of believers who embrace the teachings of Jesus Christ.

This week's gospel describes a crucial moment when the apostles realize that in order to belong to Christ, they must embrace his teachings, even the ones that are difficult to completely understand or accept. As Jesus speaks of being the bread come from heaven, that one must eat his flesh, that he has the words of eternal life, many could not accept these teachings and left being his disciples.

To belong demands a degree of sacrifice for the greater good. In a family, we must be able to comprise and forgive. To belong to a community of faith we need to be open to the Spirit and grow spiritually.

Going to Mass is all about belonging. It really is important that we worship together, that we pray with and for a community. As we together hear God's word and participate in the Eucharist we are nourished in many ways. Belonging matters! Your presence, involvement and support of our parish is critical. A parish cultivates friendships, sacrifices for the good of all and invites us to grow closer to Christ.

I feel this personally as we are in the early days of a new program year. Our school, religious education program, parish pastoral council are all launching a new year of hopes and dreams. All our parish ministries at their core

are about belonging. We cannot accomplish anything if no one wants to serve, attend, connect and grow.

Our school begins with an enrollment of 817 students making us the largest school in the archdiocese. With about five hundred students our religious education program may be one of the largest. We still need a few more catechists.

This coming Saturday we will celebrate our annual observance of the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. We will be joining Sts. Peter and Paul Greek Orthodox Church. It will be this Saturday at Sts. Peter and Paul Church on Lake Ave. at 7:00pm. We have taken turns hosting this Holy Day for the Orthodox and commemorating the efforts of Pope Francis and the Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew on fostering a deeper commitment on behalf of all of us to care for the gift of creation.

Pope Francis' encyclical, **Laudato Si** has become one of the most influential papal documents ever. The Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew has been a global leader on environmental concerns. This prayer service reminds us that we all belong and have a responsibility to protect the environment. I am honored to be the official representative of the Archdiocese of Chicago for this celebration.

Congratulations to **Danny McDonnell** and the Men's Club for the Golf Tournament this week. It was a sell-out and brought so many people together, cannot wait for the Block Party on September 7.

One of the great speakers on spiritual renewal is **Fr. John Riccardo**, a priest of the Archdiocese of Detroit. The Archdiocese of Chicago is sponsoring a day of renewal led by Fr. Riccardo on Oct. 12 from 8:30am to 5:30pm at the South Ballroom of the Rosemont Convention Center. Meg has appeared at numerous events in the area. Recently, she and two other women shared how life experiences shaped their faith.

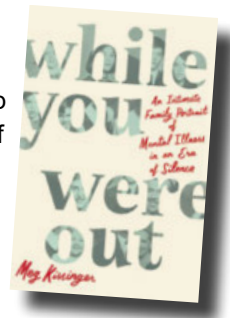

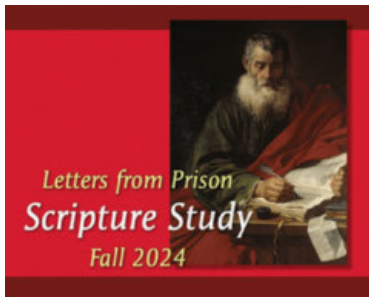

## The Real Presence: Eucharistic Union

Weekly 3-Minute Reflections on the Eucharist using excerpts from *30 Day Eucharistic Revival* by Fr. Don Calloway, MIC

*“Jesus gave me the greatest proof of his love when he went to his death in order to make the Eucharist possible and give it to me. How many people think of this price paid for by the Eucharist? And yet Jesus is there to remind us of it. But like ungrateful children we are bent only on using and enjoying our riches without ever thinking of the one who acquired them for us at the cost of his life.*

*Communion prepares us for heaven. What a great grace to die after having received Holy Viaticum! I know that perfect contrition justifies us and gives us a right to heaven; but how much better to go in company with Jesus and to be judged by his Love!*

*It is for this reason that the Church wishes her priests to administer Holy Viaticum, even at the last moment to a well-disposed penitent. Let us often beg the grace of receiving Holy Viaticum before dying. It will be the pledge of our eternal happiness.”*

### Reflection

The Mass is preparation for heaven, and the Holy Eucharist will get you there. Pray for the grace to receive Viaticum before you die. Viaticum literally means “with you on the way” and is when Holy Communion is given to a soul one last time before they die. What better way to die than to pass from this life having received Holy Communion one last time.

As a fruit of this retreat, hopefully you have grown closer in your desire to live a more Eucharistic-centered life, no longer taking the Eucharist for granted but experiencing a Eucharistic revival in your soul. Be devoted, reverent, and pray about many of the things you learned in this

book, even the things that challenged you. The Eucharist is your greatest treasure. Do not let life pass you by without maintaining a loving relationship with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and always giving thanks for the gift of Holy Communion.

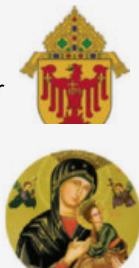

### Legacy Planning

Please consider making a gift from your individual retirement plan (IRA) that benefits you and our parish. A qualified charitable distribution (QCD) allows individuals age 70½ or older to authorize their IRA administrator to make a direct transfer of funds from their IRA to qualified charities, tax-free.



There are three main benefits of giving with a QCD:

- (1) If you are 73 years old or older, the amount you transfer can satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution.
- (2) The amount transferred directly to charity does not generate taxable income, which may reduce your annual income level. This may help lower your Medicare premiums and decrease the amount of Social Security that is subject to tax.
- (3) Your gift will be immediately used, allowing you to see the impact of your gift now.
