Dear Parishioners,

"The Spirit came to rest on them."

Powerful stuff happens when the "Spirit" rests upon us. The weight of deep wounds, long term resentments, lingering regret for poor choices we made in the past can give way to a new beginning.

We can easily be held captive by the realities of sin and evil in the world. On the international stage,

generational conflicts between Palestinians and Jews, between Russians and Ukrainians became so challenging to reconcile.

On the personal front we can feel helpless in navigating some of the deeper conflicts and difficulties that we have encountered. God's spirit is generous! The First Reading speaks of the generous spirit of the Lord that had rested upon the seventy elders. God's blessing came upon all of them. Jesus teaches in the Gospel, "Whoever is not against us is for us!"

In the world of religion, a lot of energy can be spent on those who cannot belong or should not belong. This is so contrary to the message of love proclaimed by the Lord. His love is beyond our wildest expectations.

As we enter the month of October, we celebrate some of the saints who were the great advocates of power of God's spirit to compel us to be messengers of his love. In the coming days, we will celebrate St. Therese of Lisieux, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Theresa of Avila, and St. Faustina, to name just a few. It was St. Therese who said, "I am so overwhelmed by God's love for me. I wonder how He would have any love left for anyone else."

Embracing God's love and Spirit can change us!

Last week's Youth Ministry service night was fantastic. Thanks to all the teens for the brown bags they prepared and for their reflections on the ministry of greeting and ushering and the work of the Sharing Room.

The McDonnell Hall renovation continues to move forward all be it slowly. The three contractors are preparing bids,

they will be reviewed and a decision on who gets the job will be made. Once we have a timeline established, I will let you know. Many groups use McDonnell Hall so we will be working with groups to consider other options as the construction begins.

One of our great ministries is the Ministry of Care. Every week homebound and hospitalized parishioners receive the Eucharist by our deeply committed Care Ministers.

We are facing a challenge in reaching out to hospitalized parishioners. HIPAA regulations have strict procedures in place to protect the privacy of patients. There was a time when a Minister of Care, or a priest could easily get a list of Catholic patients hospitalized to see if they would like to receive communion. For the most part this is no longer possible. Most hospitals cannot acknowledge a patient is in their care without clear permission. If you are being hospitalized and would like to receive communion please contact the parish office. If you would like to have a visit by a priest or receive the Sacrament of the Sick, please contact the office. You can also speak to the hospital chaplain for assistance.

At the parish we also need to be sensitive to parishioners' personal wishes. We can only put a person's name on a prayer list if they request it or the nearest of kin requests it. We often get calls from parishioners who are well intentioned but ask to put someone's name on the list without asking them. People are rightfully upset if they hear their name being mentioned when they did not want their health situation being made public.

Praying for the sick is a grace. Feeling the power of prayer as one encounters illness is a tremendous source of strength. We will never cease praying for those who are facing the uncertainty of illness. We will keep reviewing our procedures to be as present as we can be to the sick, the recovering, the homebound. I hear repeatedly the gratitude a person feels because of the strength they received when they knew people were holding them in prayer.

May the Spirit rest upon you!

Saturday mornings Sept. 28 & Oct. 5 Hickey Hall

Ministers of Care bring Holy Communion to parishioners who are homebound, living in nursing homes, or in the hospital. They share with them the word of God in scripture, pray with them for the Church and the world, and offer them companionship.

The work of the Ministry of Care is open to all members of our parish community, and a basic training course for new Ministers of Care will take place on two successive Saturday

mornings, Sept. 28 and Oct. 5. Both sessions will help you develop the skills and confidence needed to be a source of comfort to those who are in need.

These sessions will be facilitated by **Rick Nash** and **Jim Vlazny**, Coordinators of the Ministry of Care at OLPH. Completion of this course qualifies you to receive the Archdiocesan mandate to bring Communion to the sick, homebound and hospitalized of our parish.



You can help to support our parish and cover our increased operating costs by making a qualified charitable distribution ("QCD") gift from your individual retirement account.


A QCD gift (a.k.a. IRA charitable rollover) allows individuals age 70½ or older to authorize their IRA administrator to make a direct transfer of funds from their IRA to qualified charities, tax-free.

This way of giving does not generate taxable income, which may lower your annual income level. If you are age 73 or older, the amount you transfer may count towards your required minimum distribution.
