

Dear Parishioners,

"The winding roads shall be made straight."

Pope Francis has a personal devotion to a painting of the Blessed Mother called "Mary, Undoer of Knots". The original painting hangs in a church in Augsburg Germany. A friend sent him a copy at Christmas time, and he became quite taken with devotions surrounding the image of Mary as a problem solver, Mary the Undoer of Knots. People make pilgrimages to this church with special prayers on the eighth day of each month.

If you are like me, I contend with a lot of knots, problems that need to be solved personally and as a pastor. Life is complicated, from the mundane to the profound. Life confronts us with many dilemmas that yearn to be resolved.

I suppose the line from the Gospel that strikes

me is in this vein, "the winding roads shall be made straight." From trying to straighten out a string of Christmas' lights to sorting out what direction I should take with my career, to what college should I attend, to complicated family issues, to issues regarding our emotional well being, there are a lot of "knots that must be undone."

Advent invites us to make room for the healing and illuminous love of Jesus Christ. When people seek the intercession of Mary as they seek resolution to any host of problems(knots), we open our hearts for a sense of direction.

In the process of seeking a sense of direction we pray that the winding roads of our lives will be made straight, that the path will be clear with no roadblocks, no detours, no obstacles.

The reality was that there were many winding roads in history that eventually led us to Bethlehem from the Garden of Eden. There were challenges, knots. Confusion persisted before people recognized the Star had settled over the birthplace of the Messiah.

"It's a long and winding road" the Beatles sang! Eventually the winding road was made straight, the knots of disbelief undone. May we persevere with the winding roads of our lives. With the help of the Lord, we will make straight the way of the Lord. We will find the wisdom and courage to solve the problems and the issues that are real and present in our lives.

If we look around, we can see those who are making a difference. I always look forward this time of year to the annual Optimist Club of Glenview's recognition of High School juniors and seniors. This year the club honored fifteen outstanding young people in the Glenview community that are extraordinary. Six of them are our OLPH



Retirement Fund for Religious

OLPH supports the Retirement Fund for Religious by contributing to the Archdiocesan collection for this purpose, which will take place the weekend of December 7th-8th. We do this as part of our parish First Fruits Program, in lieu of taking up a second collection.

As a reminder, the first 6% of each weekly and holyday offertory collection is set aside for our First Fruits Program. Instead of taking up certain second collections, OLPH splits this 6% among our four sharing parishes and five named Archdiocesan second collections over the course of the year.

This Archdiocesan second collection for our retired Religious priests, brothers, and sisters, is one of the second collections funded through our First Fruits Program.



DECREE OF CONFERRAL OF FACULTIES

Ever conscious of the need to care for those entrusted to my pastoral office in the Archdiocese of Chicago, I have entrusted the Reverend Jeremiah Boland, Interim Episcopal Vicar of Vicariate I, with the task of also assisting me in the governance of this particular Church according to the norms of the general law of the Church.

In order that he may effectively fulfill his ecclesiastical responsibilities, I hereby grant him the habitual faculties belonging to the Vicar General by universal law (c.479, §1). These faculties are to be exercised only in cooperation with the Vicar General, Bishop Robert Casey, and in harmony with my efforts and intentions (cc. 407, §3 and 480).

Through the exercise of these responsibilities, may Father Boland assist this particular Church in manifesting itself to the world as a "sign of intimate union with God, and of the unity of all the human race." (Lumen Gentium, n. 1)

You let her share beforehand in the salvation Christ would bring by his death, and kept her sinless from the first moment of her conception.



Brief background of Paula Kowalkowski


